#### zone

# sunlight

- n. the light emitted by the sun; the rays of the sun synonym: daylight, rays, sunshine

# glimmer

 a flash of light especially unsteady or reflected light; a slight sign of something

synonym: gleam, dazzle, gleam

# particle

n. a small piece of something; a word or piece of a term with grammatical function but little or no significance

#### swirl

to move in a circular or spiral pattern

#### bioluminescence

- the production and emission of light by living creatures, such as glowworms, fireflies, etc.

#### clue

 an object, a piece of evidence, or some information that helps someone to find the answer to a problem, question, or mystery

#### teem

#### microbe

 a tiny living thing that can only be seen with a microscope and that may cause disease

synonym: germ, microorganism, bacterium

# plankton

- tiny forms of plant and animal life that live in water or air on which other animals feed
- (1) plankton blooms, (2) plankton community

# **Plankton** is generally the foundation of the ocean food chain.

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

# adaptation

 the action or process of changing to suit different conditions

#### extreme

adj. very great in amount or degreesynonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

(1) extreme sports, (2) extreme weather eventsSolar gravity creates extreme pressures and temperatures.

#### environment

n. the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

environment affairs, (2) chaotic environment

# predator

- n. an animal whose natural behavior is to prey on otherssynonym: vulture, bloodsucker

#### biomass

- the total quantity of living matter in a given unit of environment, including plants, animals, and microorganisms

#### combine

- v. to join or merge to form a single thing or group synonym: coalesce, cohere, blend

#### countless

# virtually

adv. almost completely

synonym: almost, basically, nearly

(1) **virtually** all countries, (2) **virtually** identical **Virtually** all the parties signed the contract.

# unexplored

adj. not yet examined, investigated, or studied; lacking in knowledge or information; unknown or undiscoveredsynonym: uncharted, undiscovered, untapped

(1) unexplored ideas, (2) unexplored cave

There are many **unexplored** regions of the ocean that scientists hope to study soon.

# oceanography

n. the scientific study of oceans and other bodies of saltwater, including their physical, chemical, and biological characteristics, as well as their interactions with the atmosphere and land

synonym: marine science, oceanology, oceanic research

# (1) **oceanography** data, (2) **oceanography** expedition The **oceanography** research center is dedicated to studying the impacts of climate change on the ocean's ecosystem.

#### represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

#### intersection

a point where two or more roads, lines, etc., cross each other

*synonym*: crossroad, junction, hub

(1) busy **intersection**, (2) the **intersection** of coordinate axes

Take a right turn at the next intersection.

# spark

v. to start something or make it grow, especially suddenly; to emit a tiny piece of fire or electricity

synonym: start, inspire, provoke

(1) **spark** his interest, (2) **spark** a chain reaction

The bankruptcy of the giant conglomerate **sparked** turmoil in the stock market.

# breakthrough

 a sudden, dramatic, and important discovery or development that helps to improve a situation or provide an answer to a problem

synonym: advance, progress, innovation

A technique called deep learning has led to **breakthroughs** in AI.

#### discovery

# planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

synonym: earth, world, globe

# expedition

- n. a journey or voyage for a specific purposesynonym: journey, trip, voyage

#### **Atlantic**

- adj. relating to or located near the Atlantic Ocean, which is the second-largest ocean on Earth, located between the continents of North and South America to the west and Europe and Africa to the east

The **Atlantic** hurricane season runs from June to November each year.

#### laser

 a device that emits powerful and narrow light that can be used as a tool to cut metal through a process of optical amplification

synonym: beam, bar, ray

# microscopic

adj. tiny; exceedingly precise and detail-oriented; of or used in microscopy

synonym: infinitesimal, tiny, atomic

(1) **microscopic** inquiry, (2) **microscopic** analysis Inspectors noticed **microscopic** cracks in the submarine's hull.

# algae

- A simple plant that grows in or near water and lacks typical leaves and roots
- (1) algae biofuel, (2) blue algae

Algae has jammed the inlet to the water turbine.

# photosynthesis

- n. the process through which plants and other organisms transform light energy into chemical energy, which is then released through cellular respiration to power the organism's activities.
- (1) oxygenic **photosynthesis**, (2) process of **photosynthesis**

In **photosynthesis**, plants use carbon dioxide to feed themselves.

#### abundant

adj. present in great quantity

## exceedingly

adv. to an extreme degree

#### span

 the entire length of something, such as time or space from beginning to end; the amount of space that something covers

#### arctic

adj. of or relating to the region around the North Pole or the Arctic Ocean; very cold

synonym: cold, frozen, polar

#### globe

the earth or world, mainly used to emphasize its vastness

synonym: Earth, world, sphere

#### enormous

# fascinating

adj. extremely interesting

#### monster

an imaginary creature that is large and has various human and animal parts; someone or something large and powerful

synonym: giant, freak, behemoth

#### lurk

- to wait somewhere secretly, especially because you are about to attack someone or do something bad or illegal synonym: hide, creep, stalk

#### lantern

a portable source of lighting, typically featuring a protective enclosure for the light source

fierce

- adj. severe and violent in a way that is frightening synonym: ferocious, convulsive, forceful

#### bristle

a stiff, short hair on a mammal's skin or a natural or artificial brush; a stiff, sharp point on a plant such as a thorn or a prickle; (verb) to react defensively to something; to stand up stiffly and be rigid

#### vertebrate

adj. relating to animals that have a backbone or spinal column, such as mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, and fish

#### tube

# penetrating

#### dense

# migration

n. the movement of animals to a new location, frequently as the seasons change

synonym: exodus

# sweeping

adj. extensive, broad, or far-reaching in scope or impact;
 characterized by a vigorous or forceful movement, often involving wide motions or gestures

#### massive

adj. enormous amount; very heavy and solidsynonym: enormous, giant, immense

#### inhabitant

- n. a person or an animal that lives in a particular placesynonym: dweller, occupant, resident

#### relative

adj. considered and evaluated through comparison with something else

synonym: comparative, proximate, congeneric

#### movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

#### carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
- (1) carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emissionTrees absorb carbon dioxide and give off oxygen.

#### isolate

v. to physically or socially separate someone or something from other people or things

synonym: separate, sequester, insulate

# atmosphere

- n. the mass of air that surrounds the Earth; the pervading tone or mood of a place, situation, or creative worksynonym: air, ambiance, circumstances

# migrate

 to move from one country or region to another and settle there; to move from one place to another periodically or seasonally

synonym: relocate, emigrate, roam

#### transport

- n. a system for moving people or products from one location to another using automobiles, roads, and so on synonym: shipment, transit, conveyance

# curiosity

- n. a strong desire to know or learn about somethingsynonym: interest, inquisitiveness, novelty

#### vacuum

# shrimp

 a small, freshwater or saltwater creature with a slender body and long legs

 a small, shrimp-like crustacean that is a major food source for many marine animals

# aquaculture

 n. the cultivation of aquatic organisms such as fish, seaweed, and shellfish for human consumption, as well as for environmental conservation and research purposes

#### nutraceutical

# fishery

nation

# regulation

#### launch

v. to send or propel something into the air or space using a device such as a rocket, missile, or spacecraft; to make something available or on sale for the first time

synonym: start, initiate, begin

# large-scale

adj. involving many people or things and involving a lot of change or activity

synonym: big, massive, grand
