The athlete was hit in the **testicle** during the game and had to be removed.



#### unintended

adj. not planned or meant

synonym: accidental, unconsenting, involuntary

(1) **unintended** bias, (2) **unintended** misunderstanding Excessive human interference in the global environment may bring **unintended** consequences.

#### reversible

adj. capable of being turned or done in the opposite direction or way; capable of being reversed or undone

synonym: invertible, changeable, undoable

(1) reversible decision, (2) reversible fabrics

The jacket is **reversible** so that you can wear it with the fur lining on the outside or the inside.

### contraception

- n. the use of methods or devices to prevent pregnancy, typically by blocking fertilization or implantation of a fertilized egg, which options include contraceptives, condoms, intrauterine devices (IUDs), and sterilization procedures
- (1) hormonal **contraception**, (2) **contraception** pills Condoms are a common method of **contraception** that both men and women can use.

#### sponge

- a soft material with many microscopic pores that can absorb a large amount of liquid and is used for washing and cleaning
- (1) sea sponge, (2) metallic spongeThe tiny marine sponge has existed for more than 500

#### condom

 a thin rubber or plastic sheath worn over the penis during sexual intercourse to prevent pregnancy or the transmission of sexually transmitted infections (STIs) between partners

*synonym*: prophylactic, rubber, sheath

Using a **condom** during sexual activity is one of the most effective ways to prevent unwanted pregnancies and sexually

#### transmitted infections.

#### vasectomy

 a surgical procedure involves cutting or blocking the vas deferens (= the tubes that carry sperm from the testicles to the urethra), which is a form of male birth control, resulting in permanent sterilization

synonym: sterilization, sterilizing operation, vas opera

(1) **vasectomy** procedure, (2) reversible **vasectomy**Many couples choose **vasectomy** as a permanent form of contraception.

#### drawback

 a disadvantage or inconvenience that makes something less attractive

synonym: disadvantage, defect, weakness

(1) the **drawback** of his method, (2) one of the main **drawbacks** 

He pointed out all the drawbacks to our plan.

#### clot

 a thick mass or lump of coagulated liquid, especially blood; a group of people or things that form an obstructive, unsympathetic, or resistant force

synonym: clump, coagulation, thrombus

(1) blood clot, (2) clot prevention

The **clot** in the blood vessel required immediate medical attention.

## progesterone

 a hormone mainly produced in the ovaries of females that helps regulate the menstrual cycle and plays a crucial role in pregnancy

synonym: progestin, gestagen, luteal hormone

(1) **progesterone** receptor, (2) synthetic **progesterone**During pregnancy, **progesterone** levels rise to support the growth of the fetus.

regimen

*n.* a prescribed course of medical treatment, diet, or exercise for the promotion or restoration of health

synonym: routine, program, schedule

# (1) fitness **regimen**, (2) **regimen** of chemotherapy My doctor prescribed a strict **regimen** of exercise and healthy eating to help me lose weight.

#### deprive

- to take away something from someone synonym: deny, take away, divest
- (1) **deprive** others of profit, (2) **deprive** him of his status He was **deprived** of his freedom when sentenced to life in prison.

#### reintroduce

to bring back something that has been previously abolished or discontinued

synonym: bring back, restore, reestablish

(1) reintroduce species, (2) reintroduce capital punishment

The government is planning to **reintroduce** wolves to the national park to restore the balance of the ecosystem.

### ingest

to take food or drink into the body, often through the mouth; to absorb or assimilate something, often used to describe the intake of information or knowledge

synonym: swallow, consume, devour

(1) ingest food, (2) ingest medication

People who compulsively **ingest** non-food items, such as dirt or chalk, suffer from a condition called pica.

#### blockade

a barrier or obstacle designed to prevent the movement n. or flow of people, goods, or resources; a military tactic that aims to isolate a specific area or territory by preventing it from receiving supplies or reinforcements

*synonym*: embargo, siege, encirclement

- (1) embargo blockade, (2) military blockade The country implemented a **blockade** during the war to prevent goods and supplies from entering or leaving.
- speculate

### to form a theory or conjecture or guess about a subject without solid evidence

synonym: assume, conjecture, infer

(1) **speculate** about the reason, (2) **speculate** on the outcome

He **speculated** that this investment would lead to success.

### smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

#### stubborn

adj. refusing to change one's mind or behavior despite persuasion or evidence to the contrary; unyielding; difficult to move or change

synonym: persistent, obstinate, determined

(1) **stubborn** attitude, (2) **stubborn** stains

He was so **stubborn** about his beliefs that he refused to listen to any other points of view.
