### quarter

### graduate

### degree

### graduated

adj. having received a degree from a school, college, or university; marked with or divided into levels or degrees

### biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things

### dismay

 a feeling of discouragement, distress, or anxiety caused by something unexpected or unwelcome; a sudden loss of courage or confidence

synonym: distress, discouragement, consternation

### photosynthesis

- n. the process through which plants and other organisms transform light energy into chemical energy, which is then released through cellular respiration to power the organism's activities.

### strategy

#### frustrate

### valley

 a long depression on the surface of the land, which typically contains a river

#### launch

### employer

 a person or organization that pays workers to work for them

 a short written message or communication intended for internal use within an organization or company

### impulsive

#### span

 the entire length of something, such as time or space from beginning to end; the amount of space that something covers synonym: interval, period, length

### curiosity

- n. a strong desire to know or learn about somethingsynonym: interest, inquisitiveness, novelty
