### transphobia

 prejudice, discrimination, or hostility towards transgender people or people who do not conform to traditional gender roles or expectations

#### statistics

### brutality

the quality or state of being cruel or savage synonym: cruelty, ferocity, savagery

### masculinity

the qualities or attributes traditionally associated with n. men, such as physical strength, courage, assertiveness, and so on; the state of being male or manly

mist

#### meme
