**Vulcan's** Forge is a nickname for the island of Hawaii due to its active volcanoes.

#### emit

*synonym*: rectifier, valve, semiconductor

(1) light-emitting **diode**, (2) semiconductor **diode**The **diode** in the circuit prevented the current from flowing in the wrong direction.

#### smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

#### physicist

- n. a scientist who specializes in the field of physics
- (1) talented **physicist**, (2) theoretical **physicist**Einstein was an outstanding and famous **physicist** of the 20th century.

#### discontinue

 to cease or stop doing something; to interrupt or terminate something that is already ongoing or in progress

synonym: halt, end, cease

#### restructure

#### commercialize

synonym: monetize, capitalize, marketize

- to ruin the taste, appearance, or quality of something; to become or cause something to become rotten or bad
   synonym: rot, decay, deteriorate
- (1) **spoil** a person's sport, (2) **spoil** the surprise

#### determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

#### saga

 a long, detailed story or account of heroic deeds, family history, or notable events, often consisting of a series of connected episodes

synonym: epic, tale, chronicle

The epic **saga** of the family's journey through time captivated readers worldwide.

### storyline

 the central narrative or plot of a story, often involving a series of events or conflicts that move the story forward; the overall structure or arc of a story

*synonym*: plot, narrative

seize

 to catch or take hold of someone or something suddenly and forcibly; to capture the attention or imagination of something

synonym: grab, grasp, capture

- dedicate

*synonym*: consecrate, devote, commit
