picturesque

adj. visually attractive or charming, often in an idealized or rustic way; having qualities that make it pleasing or suitable for being pictured or photographed

synonym: scenic, charming, vivid

(1) **picturesque** scenery, (2) **picturesque** countryside We took a scenic drive through the countryside and stumbled upon a **picturesque** village.

vibrate

v. to move or cause anything to move fast and in small increments from side to side

synonym: oscillate, convulse, jerk

(1) **vibrate** at a regular frequency, (2) **vibrate** with anger During the flight, the wings of the plane **vibrate**.

harmonious

adj. characterized by harmony or agreement; free from conflict or disagreement; pleasing or soothing in sound or tone

synonym: concordant, consistent, melodious

- (1) **harmonious** relationship, (2) **harmonious** blend The painting's **harmonious** composition and balance of colors made it a masterpiece.
- a mark that remains on the skin after a wound has healed

scar

synonym: blemish, imperfection, blotch

(1) burn scar, (2) carry a scar

Even after the wound has healed, a **scar** remains.

erode

obsess

whisper

unseen
