## **Session 1: Word List**

#### subtraction

 the process or action of removing one number from another; the mathematical operation of finding the difference between two numbers or quantities

synonym: deduction, minus, withdrawal

(1) **subtraction** equation, (2) double-digit **subtraction**The **subtraction** of expenses from revenue resulted in a net profit for the company.

#### choreograph

- v. to compose a sequence of dance steps, often to music
- (1) **choreograph** a stage performance, (2) exquisitely **choreographed**

He had **choreographed** the dance in this play himself.

### parabola

a symmetrical curve formed by the intersection of a cone with a plane parallel to its side; (of mathematics) a curve described by a quadratic equation (a type of polynomial equation of the second degree denoted as ax^2 + bx + c = 0)

*synonym*: curve, arch

(1) parabola shape, (2) parabola equation

The trajectory of the cannonball followed a **parabola** in the air.

#### visualize

to form a mental image or concept of something; to make something visible

synonym: imagine, picture, envision

(1) **visualize** data, (2) **visualize** flying through space She tried to **visualize** the layout of the new house in her mind.

#### rectangle

a four-sided geometric shape with four right angles, where opposite sides are parallel and of equal length synonym: oblong, square, quadrangle

(1) orthogonal **rectangle**, (2) **rectangle** box The living room had a rectangle-shaped coffee table in the center of it.

#### beep

to make a short, high-pitched sound, typically as a signal or warning

synonym: bleep, honk, buzz

(1) **beep** out a warning, (2) **beep** the horn

The timer **beeped**, reminding me that the cake was ready to come out of the oven.

#### octave

a musical interval encompassing eight diatonic scale degrees, such as the interval from C to the next C in a C major scale

synonym: eighth, interval, range

(1) octave key, (2) octave range

The singer's range was impressive, covering three octaves with ease.

#### drumbeat

a regular, steady beat or rhythm, often used to accompany music or to mark the passage of time synonym: rhythm, cadence, pulse

(1) steady **drumbeat**, (2) thundering **drumbeat** 

The ceremonial **drumbeat** echoed through the temple during the ritual.

#### clank

v. to produce a loud, echoing, metallic sound, often caused by the collision of metal objects or machinery; to move or operate with a heavy, clanging sound; (noun) a sharp, metallic sound that is typically produced when two hard objects strike or collide with each other

synonym: clang, clatter, jangle

(1) **clank** my spoon against the glass, (2) **clank** of metal He dropped the empty can, and it **clanked** loudly as it hit the garage's concrete floor.

#### cymbal

 a musical instrument consisting of a concave round metal plate that produces a ringing or clashing sound when struck, typically by a drumstick or another cymbal

synonym: drum, percussion, gong

(1) loud cymbal, (2) hi-hat cymbal

The drummer played a loud crash on the **cymbal** to end the song.

#### undervalue

- v. to assign too low a value to something synonym: underrate, underestimate, devalue
- (1) **undervalue** his contribution, (2) **undervalue** the potential

He **undervalued** the importance of teamwork and struggled to succeed.

#### octahedron

 a geometrical solid or three-dimensional shape with eight equally sized and shaped sides, each forming an equilateral triangle

synonym: eight-sided figure, polyhedron

(1) **octahedron** crystal, (2) interconnected **octahedrons** The building's design featured an **octahedron-shaped** atrium.

#### platonic

adj. (of relationship or emotion) friendly or affectionate but not sexual

synonym: nonphysical, nonsexual, spiritual

(1) platonic relationship, (2) platonic love

His relationship with her was completely **platonic**.

ax

 a tool with a metal blade that is usually attached to a wooden handle and is used for chopping wood or other materials

synonym: hatchet, chopper, tomahawk

(1) chop wood with an **ax**, (2) an **ax** in the toolbox He used an **ax** to chop the firewood for the campfire.

## imaginative

*adj.* having or showing new and creative ideas *synonym*: creative, innovative, inventive

(1) capable of **imaginative** creation, (2) **imaginative** as a child

She is a hard worker but not very **imaginative**.

#### empathy

n. the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation

synonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

(1) full of **empathy**, (2) **empathy** for patients **Empathy** is also necessary to understand history.
