probabilistic

synonym: probable, statistical, likely

stern

adj. serious, unyielding, or strict in manner or attitude *synonym*: severe, harsh, strict

collide

synonym: clash, slam, contradict

(1) **collide** head-on, (2) **collide** in midair

The interests of the two countries **collide**.

inaccessible

adj. unable to travel to or reach; not availablesynonym: inapproachable, unreachable, remote

(1) **inaccessible** to an unauthorized user, (2) **inaccessible** areas

Heavy snow made it **inaccessible** to go to the mountain village.

cosmology

 the scientific study of the nature and origin of the universe

synonym: cosmogony

physical cosmology, (2) modern cosmology
 Cosmology evolved from people's philosophical questions about the natural world.

volcano

n. a mountain or hill, typically conical, having a crater or vent through which lava, rock fragments, hot vapor, and gas are or have been erupted from the earth's crust.

synonym: mount, peak, crater

clarinet

dolphin

Newtonian

thermodynamics
