meditation

sight

ritual

ancestor

blueprint

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

tactics

 the methods or strategies used to achieve a specific goal or outcome, particularly in the context of military, business, or sports

synonym: strategy, maneuvers, plan

healing

 the process of becoming or making somebody or something well again

synonym: recovery, recuperation, convalescence

natural healing ability, (2) part of the healing process
 Each ancient tribe has its healing traditions.

navigate

to plan and direct the way that a ship, plane, etc. will travel, often by using a map

synonym: guide, helm, voyage

institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

slavery

footstep

lace

 a delicate fabric made of interlacing thread or other material; a cord used to fasten or adorn clothing, often with a pattern of holes or spaces; a decorative netting or interlaced design

She wore a beautiful dress with delicate lace detailing.

sneak

v. to go somewhere, or take someone or something somewhere secretly or stealthily; to steal or do something secretly or stealthily

transformation

 a complete change in form, nature, or appearance of someone or something

communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals;for common use

crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

synonym: concern, problem, emergency

The Chinese word for **crisis** comprises two characters, one for danger and the other for opportunity.

pajama

 a pair of loose pants with a matching top, worn for sleeping or lounging

synonym: nightgown, nightdress

invite

v. to ask someone to come or join; to offer an opportunity or possibility for something to happen or take place

spam

 unwanted email, usually of advertising material sent out in bulk

inspire

 synonym: boost, encourage, enlighten

decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering optionssynonym: choose, determine, settle

obesity

 the condition of being significantly overweight, typically defined as having a body mass index (BMI) of 30 or greater.

relate

v. to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

laden

adj. heavily loaded or burdened

synonym: loaded, weighed down, heavy

represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

conversation

n. an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

stove

n. a kitchen appliance consisting of a flat top, usually with heating elements, used for cooking food

precision

grandchild

grade

graduate

 a person who has a first degree from university or college; (verb) to complete the first course of university or college and get a degree

synonym: alumna, alum, grad

beloved

adj. loved very much

synonym: adored, cherished, dear

chronic

adj. being long-lasting and recurrent or characterized by long suffering; habitual

synonym: established, regular, constant

(1) risk of **chronic** disease, (2) **chronic** alcohol consumption

calculate

v. to judge or find out the amount or number of something by using mathematics

synonym: compute, figure, estimate

stare

v. to gaze or look fixedly and intently at someone or something, often in a questioning, curious, or suspicious manner; (noun) a fixed, intense, and prolonged gaze or look

synonym: gaze, look, gawk

(1) **stare** blankly, (2) give a menacing **stare**He couldn't help but **stare** at the beautiful sunset over the ocean.

statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

alarming

adj. causing concern or apprehension; causing a feeling of danger, harm, or emergency; unsettling or disturbingsynonym: forbidding, concerning, disturbing

diabetes

- a medical condition in which the body cannot produce enough insulin to control the glucose levels in the blood

diet

hike

dial

rally

enthusiasm

a public meeting of a group of people intended to arouse

synonym: gathering, meetup, demonstration

rally.

obese

adj. excessively overweight, particularly to the point of being a serious health risk; having a body mass index (BMI) of 30 or more

synonym: overweight, corpulent, plump

(1) obese individuals, (2) obese children

The doctor warned him that his **obese** condition put him at risk for numerous health problems.

violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

cigarette

 a small cylindrical roll of finely cut tobacco leaves wrapped in paper for smoking

synonym: smoke, cigar, tobacco

(1) a mild **cigarette**, (2) a **cigarette** case He lit a **cigarette** and leaned against the wall.

combine

- v. to join or merge to form a single thing or group synonym: coalesce, cohere, blend
- (1) combine chemically with another substance,
- (2) combine augmented reality

Hydrogen and oxygen **combine** to form water.

roughly

adv. approximately but not precisely; with a violent manner synonym: approximately, more or less, around

(1) **roughly** explain my idea, (2) **roughly** speaking Five miles is **roughly** similar to eight kilometers.

jersey

 a knitted garment typically made of wool or cotton, worn as a shirt or pullover

synonym: shirt, sweater, top

(1) **jersey** material, (2) fabric of the **jersey** I always wear my favorite basketball player's **jersey** to the games.

government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

intervention

- n. the action or process of being done to improve or help a circumstance, often they have not been asked to do sosynonym: interference, intercession, treatment

skinny

adj. having a very thin or slim body; referring to clothing that is tightly fitting and reveals the shape of the body; referring to information or details that are kept secret or confidential

His mom was always concerned about his **skinny** frame and encouraged him to eat more

jean

 a sturdy cotton twill fabric, typically blue, used for jeans and other clothing

synonym: denim, cotton, pants

(1) a jean skirt, (2) jean denim

She wore her favorite pair of jeans to the party.

acknowledge

v. to accept or admit the existence, reality, or truth of something; to accept that someone or something has a particular authority or quality; to express obligation, thanks, or gratitude for someone's help, commitment,

etc.;

synonym: accept, agree, declare

(1) **acknowledge** the deed, (2) **acknowledge** his help He never **acknowledged** his fault.

trauma

 an emotional wound or shock often has long-lasting effects caused by a highly upsetting or shocking experience

synonym: agony, injury, ordeal

(1) psychic trauma, (2) trauma care

Many civilians have suffered **trauma** as a result of the war.

belly

n. the front part of the body below the chest, containing the stomach and bowels; the rounded or curved part of an object, such as a ship or aircraft

synonym: stomach, abdomen, gut

embedded

adj. fixed firmly into the surface of something synonym: ingrained, implanted, inserted

medication

 a drug or other form of medicine that treats, prevents, or alleviates the symptoms of the disease

synonym: cure, drug, medicine

(1) antibiotic **medication**, (2) **medication** by mouth The pharmacist not only prescribes the **medication** but also guides its proper use.

pharmaceutical

adj. relating to the production and selling of the medical drugs

synonym: drug, medication, prescription

(1) major pharmaceutical companies, (2) commercial

pharmaceutical products

She gave money to help set up a **pharmaceutical** laboratory.

congest

- v. to make something blocked or crowded so as to hinder or prevent freedom of movement or flow of liquidsynonym: clog, choke, crowd
- (1) **congest** in a vein, (2) **congest** a highway The roads to the airport were heavily **congested**.

systemic

- adj. affecting or related to the whole of something, especially the human body or a society
- (1) the **systemic** arteries, (2) **systemic** reforms of the organization

This vaccine causes mild systemic side effects.

racism

prejudice, discrimination, or antagonism directed against a person or people based on their membership in a particular ethnic group, typically one that is a minority or marginalized

synonym: prejudice, discrimination, bias

(1) systemic **racism**, (2) research on anti- **racism**The school's lack of diversity was a clear indication of the **racism** present in the community.

divest

- v. to strip or rid oneself of something; to deprive or dispossess someone of a possession, title, or rightsynonym: divestiture, strip, rid
- (1) **divest** assets, (2) **divest** from fossil fuels

 The company decided to **divest** its holdings in the fossil fuel industry.

predatory

adj. living by eating other animals, especially by catching prey that is still alive

synonym: raptorial, hunting, greedy

(1) a **predatory** bird, (2) **predatory** warfare

The domesticated cat still has its **predatory** instincts.

crack

v. to break or cause to break without dividing into separate parts; (noun) a line on the surface of something along which it has separated without breaking

synonym: snap, burst, break

(1) **crack** an eggshell, (2) a **crack** in a board He that would eat the kernel must **crack** the nut.

cocaine

n. a highly addictive stimulant drug that is derived from the leaves of the coca plant, often used recreationally for its euphoric effects but also used in medicine as a local anesthetic and vasoconstrictor

synonym: narcotic, coke, snow

The drug dealer was arrested for possession of **cocaine**.

epidemic

 the widespread outbreak of a particular disease in a large number of people at the same time

mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

incarceration

- n. the state of being confined in prison or jailsynonym: confinement, imprisonment, detention

buckle

to bend out of shape, as under pressure or from heat;
 (noun) a device used for fastening two loose ends of a belt or strap

synonym: bend, crumple, contort

lifeline

 a line, rope, or cable used to support or rescue a person in danger or distress; vital or necessary support, connection, or source of help

synonym: savior, support, safety net

My best friend has been my **lifeline** throughout all of my hardships.

Norman

adj. relating to or characteristic of the Normans, a people who originally came from Normandy, France, and who had a significant impact on the history and culture of Britain and other European countries; the term can also refer to a style of architecture or art that developed during the Norman period

synonym: medieval, antique, archaic

(1) **norman** cathedral, (2) **norman** invasion

The **Norman** architecture in the old city was a sight to behold.

grief

- n. a very great sadness, especially when somebody diessynonym: anguish, desperation, dismay

overcome

v. to succeed in controlling or dealing with something, such as a problem or difficulty; to defeat or overwhelm someone

immobilize

v. to render someone or something unable to move or function normally; to restrain, inhibit, or stopsynonym: incapacitate, paralyze, disable

norm

- n. something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standard synonym: criterion, mean, standard
- (1) norm of action, (2) cultural norm
 The systems we have developed has accepted as industry norms.

desegregation

 the action or process of eliminating segregation, typically of races or ethnic groups, in educational, social, or other institutions

synonym: integration, assimilation


