#### conversation

n. an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

#### mosque

- a Muslim place of worship that usually has a minaret (= slender tower with balconies)

#### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) opportune occasion, (2) an opportune remark

The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

#### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) statistics for cancer, (2) official statistics The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

# delegate

a person sent or authorized to represent others, in particular, an elected representative sent to a conference; (verb) to transfer power to someone

synonym: representative, envoy, agent

- (1) **delegate** a routine task, (2) send a **delegate** The **delegate** from the small country was not allowed to speak at the meeting.
- a large area inside the entrance of a public building where people can meet and wait; a group of people who try to persuade a politician, the government, or an official group to influence legislation

synonym: entrance, hall, anteroom

(1) lobby for legislation, (2) a hotel lobby That **lobby** group actively advocated environmental protection to the government.

# religion

lobby

a deep conviction in a supernatural power that controls human destiny

synonym: faith, creed, belief

(1) **religion** sociology, (2) freedom of **religion** Their **religion** strictly prohibits them from drinking or gambling.

span

the entire length of something, such as time or space from beginning to end; the amount of space that something covers

synonym: interval, period, length

(1) the **span** of a bird's wings, (2) the average life **span** He slightly modified the **span** of training because it was just before a match.

#### spectrum

 an ordered array of colors into which a light beam can be split

synonym: range, scale, spread

(1) a broad **spectrum** of opinion, (2) infrared **spectrum** This device displayed the speech **spectrum** spectrographically.

# perk

 an advantage or something extra, such as money or goods, you receive as well as your wages for doing a particular job

synonym: extra, bonus, benefit

(1) **perks** for repeat guests, (2) worker **perk** A yacht cruise is our company's ultimate **perk**.

# dangle

v. to hang or swing loosely, especially in a way that suggests instability or lack of support; to tempt or tantalize by holding out the prospect of something desirable but uncertain

synonym: swing, hang, drape

(1) dangle a carrot, (2) dangle a pendant

The earring on her earlobe would **dangle** as she moved her head.

# absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly synonym: completely, utterly, definitely

(1) **absolutely** against, (2) **absolutely** obsessed with the girl

I am **absolutely** opposed to his idea because of morality.

# reprehensible

adj. deserving of criticism or condemnation due to being morally wrong, shameful, or improper

synonym: blameworthy, objectionable, shameful

(1) **reprehensible** behavior, (2) **reprehensible** act It is **reprehensible** to discriminate against someone based on their race or gender.

# struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

#### confirm

 to support or establish the truth or certainty of something previously believed or suspected to be the case

synonym: affirm, verify, assure

(1) **confirm** the diagnosis, (2) **confirm** a transaction Please write to **confirm** your reservation.

# definitely

adv. without any question and beyond doubt; clearlysynonym: absolutely, certainly, indeed

(1) **definitely** become a problem, (2) say **definitely** The paper is **definitely** worth reading thoroughly.

nerd

 a person who is very interested in and knowledgeable about a particular subject such as computers, mathematics, chess, etc.

synonym: geek, techie, wonk

(1) a computer **nerd**, (2) **nerd** neck He was, by nature, a cyber **nerd**.

# compete

v. to strive to achieve more success than someone or something

synonym: contend, contest, vie

(1) **compete** against a friend, (2) **compete** fiercely You must **compete** with others to obtain this position.

selfie

 a photograph that one has taken of oneself, typically one taken with a smartphone or webcam to share on social media

synonym: self-portrait, self-photo, self-snap

(1) selfie stick, (2) pose for a selfie

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She took a **selfie** in front of the famous tower and shared it on the app.

vest

n. a sleeveless garment that is usually worn over a shirt and serves either as a protective layer or as an article of clothing for extra warmth; (verb) to give or confer a right, power, or authority

synonym: jacket, waistcoat, garment

cocktail

 a drink, usually an alcoholic one, made by mixing one or more spirits (= strong alcoholic drinks) and fruit juice; an appetizer served as a first course at a meal

amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

jolly

adj. happy and lively

synonym: cheerful, happy, merry

(1) a jolly laugh, (2) jolly evening

itinerary

n. a detailed plan or route of a journey or trip, including the sequence of destinations, the dates and times of travel, and any other pertinent information such as hotel reservations or transportation arrangements

synonym: agenda, schedule, plan

(1) itinerary planning, (2) detailed itinerary

I need to finalize my travel **itinerary** for the upcoming business trip.

hell

n. the place thought to be where bad people go and are punished after death, often depicted as being located

beneath the earth; an extraordinarily unpleasant or difficult place

synonym: inferno, agony, misery

(1) run like hell, (2) hell broke loose

The battlefield became **hell** on earth.

chief

adj. most important or primary; (noun) a person who is in charge

synonym: essential, primary, leading

orangutan

- a large long-armed ape with red-brown hair that lives in Borneo and Sumatra and has arboreal habits
- (1) orangutan arm, (2) female orangutan

trump

- a playing card with a picture of a trumpeter on it, used in certain card games
- (1) trump card, (2) choose trump

The **trump** suit in the game of bridge is determined at the beginning of each hand.

fake

adj. not genuine; fraudulent or counterfeit synonym: affected, bogus, counterfeit

(1) fake police officer, (2) spread of fake news

The prime minister was not well prepared for the debate and **faked** it

tan

- v. to become brown as a result of exposure to the sun synonym: brown, sunburn
- (1) tan after sun exposure, (2) tan poorly

She spent the whole summer **tanning** on the beach.

#### redeem

v. to compensate for the faults or bad aspects of something; to regain possession or assume ownership of something by paying a sum of money or fulfilling a condition; to rescue or save someone from a difficult or hopeless situation

synonym: rescue, save, recover

(1) **redeem** a coupon, (2) **redeem** a government bond He tried to **redeem** himself by volunteering at the local charity after his mistakes.

#### conscience

- a person's inner sense of what is right or wrong in their conduct or motives, viewed as a guide to their behavior

#### protest

a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

alley

 a narrow lane or way between buildings, often used as a passage or a shortcut; a small street that runs between two other streets

synonym: lane, passage, pathway

#### fantastic

adj. extremely good; excellent synonym: incredible, unbelievable, marvelous

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

rifle

 a long-barreled firearm designed to be fired from the shoulder, typically with a rifled bore for accuracy

synonym: gun, firearm, weapon

#### association

 a people or groups of people who have joined in a single organization together for a particular purpose; a social or business connection or relationship

synonym: affiliation, collaboration, society

- mass n. a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or

synonym: abundance, crowd, mob

crowded together

defend

v. to protect someone or something from attack, criticism, danger, etc.

*synonym*: protect, guard, support

(1) **defend** my country, (2) **defend** against a threat International law allows each nation to **defend** itself when its rights and interests are illegally violated.

# exchange

v. to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

*synonym*: trade, swap, interchange

(1) **exchange** rate, (2) **exchange** a few friendly words My sister and I frequently **exchange** books, as we love reading.

gay

adj. homosexual; happy, carefree synonym: cheerful, lively, joyful

(1) gay couple, (2) gay rights

The **gay** pride parade was a celebration of diversity and acceptance.

intrigue

v. to make someone interested, especially by being strange, unusual, or mysterious; to make a secret plan with other people to harm someone

synonym: attract, captivate, charm

(1) **intrigue** him, (2) **intrigue** against his rival The artist's innovative style of work **intrigues** me.

slaughter

 the killing of a large number of animals or people brutally and indiscriminately; a violent and bloody event that results in the death of many individuals

synonym: thrashing, massacre, carnage

slaughter of animals, (2) senseless slaughter
 The slaughter of endangered animals must be stopped.

nightclub

a venue that typically operates late into the night,
 offering music, dancing, and drinks

synonym: discotheque, club, dance hall

(1) **nightclub** entertainment, (2) **nightclub** music They decided to go to the **nightclub** to dance the night away.

#### pulse

n. the regular heartbeat as it sends blood around the body, especially when it is felt at the wrist or side of the neck; a solid regular vibration of sound, electric current, light, or other waves

# tragedy

#### victim

 a person who has been harmed, injured, or otherwise negatively affected by a particular action, circumstance, or event

synonym: prey, target, sufferer

The **victim** of the crime deserves justice and support to recover from the trauma.

# stick

to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

synonym: pierce, adhere, stay

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

#### unleash

v. to suddenly release a strong force, emotion, etc. that cannot be controlled

*synonym*: discharge, free, release

#### **bullet**

n. a metal projectile that is shot from a gun

*synonym*: projectile, slug, shot

#### survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options
   synonym: choose, determine, settle

# eventually

- adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on
- *synonym*: finally, someday, ultimately
- (1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

#### thorny

- adj. full of or covered with thorns; prickly; (of a problem) difficult to deal with
- synonym: prickly, spiky, bristly
- (1) the **thorny** path of life, (2) **thorny** problem The rose bush had **thorny** branches.

# pleasant

- adj. enjoyable, attractive, friendly, or agreeablesynonym: agreeable, delightful, pleasing
- (1) pleasant news, (2) pleasant odor

The hotel's staff is very **pleasant** and efficient.

#### commit

- v. to do something illegal or wrong synonym: engage, carry out, execute
- (1) **commit** suicide, (2) **commit** mistakes

The military has **committed** an abuse of human rights.

#### suicide

n. the act of killing yourself intentionallysynonym: self-destruction, self-annihilation, felo-de-se

(1) commit suicide, (2) suicide attack

In an economically prosperous country, most male **suicide** is due to child support problems.

# mourning

n. the act or expression of sorrow or grief for someone who has died; a period of time set aside for such grievingsynonym: grieving, sorrow, lamentation

#### swear

v. to make a solemn promise or vow; to use rude or offensive language

## faith

# evil

adj. profoundly immoral, cruel, and wicked; having or exerting a harmful effect on people

synonym: malign, corruption, immorality

#### bible

 the sacred writings of the Christian religions, consisting of the Old and New Testaments; a book regarded as authoritative in its field

synonym: authoritative book, holy book, doctrine

(1) a passage from the **Bible**, (2) believe **Bible** prophecy Students have loved this textbook for many years as a biology **bible**.

# bargain

n. an agreement between two parties regarding the terms of a purchase or a transaction; a deal or a negotiation that results in a product or a service being acquired for a lower price than usual or expected

synonym: deal, agreement, pact

(1) bargain deal, (2) bargain hunting

The price for the used car was a **bargain** compared to the market value.

#### convinced

- adj. completely certain about something; having a strong belief or conviction in a particular religionsynonym: confident, positive, indoctrinated

# salvation

- n. preservation or deliverance from harm, ruin, or losssynonym: rescue, deliverance, redemption

# percentage

the number, amount, or rate of something, which is usually the amount per hundred

synonym: rate, ratio, portion

#### attempt

an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

(1) the **attempt** to rescue the hostages, (2) a reckless **attempt** 

The third **attempt** was far more successful.

#### homosexual

adj. sexually attracted to people of one's own sex synonym: gay, same-sex attracted

(1) **homosexual** rights, (2) **homosexual** marriage

The law was repealed to protect the rights of **homosexual** citizens.

#### berate

v. to scold or criticize harshly, often in a loud or angry manner; to rebuke or chastise severely

synonym: rebuke, scold, criticize

# oppose

v. to be against or in conflict with something or someone; to resist or to try to prevent something from happening

synonym: match, resist, confront

#### Nazi

n. a member or supporter of the National Socialist German Workers' Party, which controlled Germany from 1933 to 1945 and carried out a genocidal campaign against Jews and other marginalized groups; someone who subscribes to similar racist or authoritarian beliefs

synonym: fascist, authoritarian, dictator

(1) Nazi regime, (2) neo- Nazi movement

The **Nazi** party was responsible for atrocities committed during World War II.

#### extreme

adj. very great in amount or degree synonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

extreme sports, (2) extreme weather events

#### abandon

- v. to leave a place, thing, or person with no intention of returning; (noun) a feeling of extreme emotional intensitysynonym: relinquish, leave behind, disregard

# opposed

 adj. being completely different from something or disagreeing strongly with something

synonym: anti, averse, hostile

#### strike

- v. to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact upon synonym: hit, impact, influence

mad

- adj. insane, especially due to a mental illness; very angry synonym: crazy, insane, furious

#### county

 an administrative division of a country or state, typically one of several comprising a larger division

synonym:

district, region, territory

 a person who learns from another, especially one who then teaches others

# homophobia
