#### panhandle

v. to ask for money or donations on the street by holding out a container or sign; to beg for money or support; (noun) a narrow strip of land projecting from a larger territory, typically with a shape resembling the handle of a pan

synonym: beg, solicit, plead

(1) panhandle for food, (2) the Texas panhandleI must panhandle for money if I can't find a job soon.

#### compassionate

adj. feeling or showing sympathy and concern for the suffering or bad luck of others

synonym: empathetic, sympathetic, merciful

(1) a **compassionate** heart, (2) **compassionate** leave My father has a serious and **compassionate** personality.

#### fiesta

 a festive celebration or party, often involving music, dancing, and abundant food and drink; a public or community celebration held for a special occasion or event

synonym: fete, celebration, festival

(1) fiesta decorations, (2) fiesta music

The neighborhood was alive with music and laughter during the annual **fiesta** celebration.

#### punitive

adj. relating to or involving punishment or inflicting punishment; aimed at punishing or disciplining

synonym: punishing, retributive, disciplinary

(1) **punitive** response, (2) **punitive** damages

His coworkers deemed the **punitive** measures taken against the employee too harsh.

#### hustle

to cause someone to move quickly by pushing them in a rough, aggressive way

synonym: bustle, rush, haste

(1) **hustle** on business, (2) **hustle** up money

You must **hustle** and struggle on the court to win an acquittal.

#### agility

the ability to move quickly and easily, often in a way that is graceful and controlled

synonym: nimbleness, quickness, dexterity

(1) ninja-like agility, (2) agility training

The coach had the team run through the agility ladder to improve their coordination.

#### onboard

to become or make part of a team, group, or system; to install, activate, or begin using a piece of equipment or software; (adjective) included or integrated into a particular system, machine, or device

synonym: embark, aboard, on-load

(1) **onboard** the new employees, (2) **onboard** computer The passengers were instructed to **onboard** the aircraft as quickly as possible so that the flight could depart on time.

#### tumbleweed

- a type of plant, often a type of weed that has a spherical n. or cylindrical shape and breaks off from its roots and rolls in the wind, dispersing its seeds as it moves; a situation or place that is desolate, deserted, or lacking activity or inhabitants
- (1) lonely tumbleweed, (2) tumbleweed rolling The barren landscape was filled with **tumbleweeds**, blown

around by the strong desert winds.

#### medically

- adv. in a way that relates to the practice of medicine and the treatment of illness and injury
- (1) **medically** endorsed method, (2) in a **medically** effective manner

A decade ago, it was **medically** impossible to cure this disease completely.

#### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

#### pantry

n. a small room, closet, or cupboard used for the storage of food, particularly non-perishable items such as canned goods, dry goods, and spices; a supply of food stored in this manner

synonym: larder, store, cupboard

(1) pantry items, (2) kitchen pantry

I need to clean out the **pantry** and throw away any expired food.

#### teamwork

n. the combined action of a group of people working together towards a common goal

synonym: collaboration, cooperation, coordination

(1) poor **teamwork**, (2) **teamwork** in business

Harmonious **teamwork** is essential to the success of this project.

#### stubborn

adj. refusing to change one's mind or behavior despite persuasion or evidence to the contrary; unyielding; difficult to move or change

synonym: persistent, obstinate, determined

(1) **stubborn** attitude, (2) **stubborn** stains

He was so **stubborn** about his beliefs that he refused to

listen to any other points of view.

#### sheltered

adj. protected or shielded from danger or harmful influences; inexperienced or innocent of certain unpleasantness or harsh realities of life

synonym: protected, secure, guarded

(1) sheltered life, (2) sheltered housing

The birds found **sheltered** spots in the trees to avoid the rain.

#### commend

v. to praise or express approval of someone or something; to recommend someone for a job or position; to entrust or hand over something to someone else

*synonym*: praise, applaud, compliment

(1) **commend** a job well done, (2) **commend** him for his bravery

The coach **commended** the team for fighting until the end and never giving up.

#### profoundly

adv. to a great or complete degree; deeply

synonym: deeply, greatly, completely

(1) profoundly insightful, (2) sleep profoundly

The novel affected her **profoundly**, causing her to question her beliefs and values.
