#### medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

### gorilla

 a large, powerful, and intelligent primate found in the forests of central Africa, with coarse black or brown fur and a distinctive face

*synonym*: ape, chimpanzee, orangutan

The **gorilla** at the zoo impressed visitors with its size and strength.

suit

 a set of clothes that are made from the same material; a claim or complaint that a person or organization can file in court against another party; (verb) to be fit or acceptable for

synonym: clothes, lawsuit, (verb) fit

(1) suit and tie restaurant, (2) suit at law

Six **suits** are awaiting trial or verdict.

#### trunk

- n. the main stem or body of a tree which its branches grow synonym: body, chest, torso
- (1) the **trunk** of the tree, (2) the **trunk** of the body
  Destructive fungi thrive in moist environments, such as those seen in wounds on the **trunk**.

#### emergency

 a sudden unforeseen crisis usually involving danger that requires immediate action

synonym: crisis, trouble, difficulty

### patient

 a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic

### technicality

#### cease

v. to stop an action or event

*synonym*: stop, end, terminate

#### suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

#### intern

v. to put someone in prison, especially for political or military reasons; (noun) a student or trainee who works, sometimes for free, to get work experience or to fulfill qualification criteria

*synonym*: apprentice, trainee, student

(1) intern civilians, (2) medical intern

The navy **interned** ships of defeated nations.

#### neurosurgeon

 a medical doctor who specializes in the surgical treatment of conditions affecting the nervous system, including the brain, spinal cord, and peripheral nerves

synonym: brain surgeon, neurologist, surgical specialist

(1) skilled **neurosurgeon**, (2) leading **neurosurgeon**The hospital recruited experienced **neurosurgeons**worldwide to treat complex neurological disorders
comprehensively.

### develop

 to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

### excruciating

 adj. extremely painful, intense, or distressing; causing great physical or emotional suffering

synonym: agonizing, unbearable, torturous

- (1) **excruciating** ordeal, (2) **excruciating** embarrassment The **excruciating** pain in his ankle made it difficult to walk.
- to expel air from the lungs suddenly and noisily, often as a reaction to irritation, illness, or some other physical condition; (noun) a sudden, forceful expulsion of air from the lungs, often accompanied by a distinctive sound

*synonym*: hack, clear throat, wheeze

- (1) cough several times, (2) persistent coughI can't stop coughing and think I might have caught a cold.

### mortality

n. the quality or state of being subject to death

synonym: fatality

(1) mortality due to cancer, (2) lower infant mortality

This disease has a high mortality.

### struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

#### decision

 the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

synonym: choice, determination, judgment

(1) decision authority, (2) a selfish decision

She was struggling to make a **decision** between two job offers.

#### brave

adj. showing courage or fearlessness in the face of danger, difficulty, or adversity

synonym: courageous, valiant, heroic

#### ventilate

v. to supply fresh air to a room, building, etc.; to remove stale air from it

synonym: air out, circulate, freshen

### caregiving

the act of providing care and support for someone who is ill, disabled, or elderly

synonym: nurturing, caring, assisting

### physician

n. a medical doctor who practices medicine

synonym: doctor, practitioner, medic

### reshape

### identity

#### witness

a person who sees something happen, especially a crime or an accident

#### resilient

adj. able to withstand or recover quickly from difficult conditions

synonym: robust, sturdy, tough

#### bounce

### pretension

#### messy

#### decide

### shocking

#### heartbreak

#### comfort

a state of physical ease and freedom from pain or constraint

#### stark

- *adj.* empty, simple, or apparent; devoid of any qualifications *synonym*: crude, blunt, desolate

### honesty

*n.* the quality of being truthful, sincere, and morally upright; adherence to moral and ethical principles

### daunting

#### pact

- a formal agreement between two or more parties synonym: agreement, treaty, covenant

### paperwork

administrative tasks that involve writing or typing n. documents

synonym: documentation, filing, office work

### tangible

 adj. real and concrete; able to be perceived, especially able to be touched; (of business assets) having physical substance and intrinsic monetary value

#### uncertain

#### stride

v. to walk with long steps in a particular direction; (noun) an important and positive progress

#### transition

 the process or period of changing from one state or circumstance to another

synonym: change, growth, shift

### suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

#### crossroad

### footstep

 a step, or the sound generated by a person walking when their foot hits the ground

#### harsh

adj. not occupied or in use; empty; showing no indication of thought or life, lacking expression or animation

### gleam

v. to reflect light in a way that creates a shining or bright and attractive appearance; to become visible or apparent

synonym: glitter, shimmer, shine

(1) **gleam** in eyes, (2) **gleam** like honey

The diamond ring **gleamed** in the sunlight, catching everyone's eye.

#### desert

- arid land with little or no vegetation often covered with sand or rocks

#### sandstorm

 a severe, and often violent, windstorm in which a cloud of sand and dust is blown over a wide area, reducing visibility and causing damage to structures and equipment

synonym: dust storm, haboob

### erase

- v. to remove something completely, especially by rubbing it synonym: wipe out, delete, obliterate

### oncology

 the branch of medicine that deals with the study and treatment of tumors, especially malignancies

#### clinician

a practitioner, especially of medicine or psychology, who has direct contact with patients

alone may cause mental disorders.

### appreciation

 the act of recognizing and valuing the worth or importance of something or someone; gratitude or thankfulness; an increase in value over time

synonym: recognition, admiration, esteem

(1) express my **appreciation**, (2) **appreciation** for diversity The artist received a lot of **appreciation** for his latest work.

### colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

### responsible

adj. answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management

synonym: accountable, answerable, liable

(1) **responsible** action, (2) **responsible** for a customer service

She's a **responsible** pet owner who ensures her dog gets enough exercise and a healthy diet.

### clarity

 the quality of being coherent and understandable; the quality of transparency or purity

*synonym*: clearness, translucence, brightness

(1) lack of clarity, (2) sake of clarity

The publisher will proofread most of this manuscript for clarity.

### prognosis

n. the likely outcome or course of a disease or illness based on medical analysis and examination of the patient; a forecast or prediction of future events or developments

synonym: prospect, forecast, diagnosis

(1) prognosis of cancer, (2) poor prognosis

The doctor gave a positive prognosis for her recovery from

the illness.

#### terminal

 a building or place where buses, trains, or airplanes stop and where passengers or goods can be picked up or dropped off; (adjective) of or situated at the ends of a delivery route

*synonym*: endpoint, final, concluding

(1) terminal disease, (2) a terminal syllable

The **terminal** at the airport is where passengers catch their flights.

#### substitute

 a person or thing acting or serving instead of another one; (verb) to act as a something or someone instead of another one

synonym: alternate, replacement, reserve

(1) **substitute** coffee, (2) **substitute** teacher

I **substitute** skim milk for regular milk because we are on a strict diet.

### emphasize

- v. to give or show particular importance to something synonym: highlight, accentuate, stress
- (1) **emphasize** her words, (2) **emphasize** a direct relationship

Use italics or capitals to **emphasize** a word in a piece of writing.

#### scenario

a description of possible actions or events in the future;
 a written outline of a play, film, or literary work

*synonym*: plan, scheme, procedure

(1) the worst case **scenario**, (2) number of different **scenarios** 

The president prepared several possible **scenarios** for an enemy attack.

### survey

 an investigation of the opinions, behavior, etc. of a particular group of people, made by asking people questions synonym: study, examination, poll

(1) a comprehensive **survey**, (2) recent **survey**That **survey** shows that people are accepting the tax increase to some extent.

#### instinct

 an inborn behavioral pattern that is often responsive to specific stimuli; an innate feeling that causes you to act or believe that something is true

synonym: intuition, aptitude, feeling

(1) **instinct** for self-preservation, (2) aggressive **instinct** When faced with a dangerous situation, his initial **instinct** was to flee.

#### outcome

n. the result or effect of an action, event, etc.

synonym: result, consequence, effect

(1) improved student **outcomes**, (2) a desirable **outcome** They awaited news of the **outcome** of the election.

### anxiety

 a feeling of worry, nervousness, or unease about something that is happening or might happen in the future

synonym: concern, dread, agita

#### trauma

 an emotional wound or shock often has long-lasting effects caused by a highly upsetting or shocking experience

synonym: agony, injury, ordeal

#### conversation

*n.* an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

adj. extremely large or great

synonym: enormous, giant, huge

#### astound

synonym: amaze, astonish, surprise

(1) astound everyone, (2) astound the viewer

The final result was nothing short of **astounding**.

### spite

n. feelings of anger and resentment; (in spite of, also despite) a phrase that is used to indicate that something happened or exists even though there is a particular obstacle or difficulty

synonym: malice, ill will, vindictiveness

(1) bear **spite** against him, (2) die in **spite** of intensive care He did it out of **spite**, to annoy me.

#### chemo

n. short for chemotherapy, a treatment for cancer that uses drugs to destroy cancer cells

synonym: chemotherapy, antineoplastic

(1) chemo patient, (2) chemo-radiotherapy

The side effects of **chemo**, such as nausea and hair loss, were a major concern for the patient.

### initially

adv. at the beginning; at first

*synonym*: originally, primarily, firstly

(1) **initially** anticipated, (2) diagnosed **initially** as a tumor This train departed later than **initially** scheduled.

shift

n. a slight transition in position, direction, or trend

synonym: transition, change, modification

(1) Doppler **shift**, (2) major paradigm **shift** 

Could you help me **shift** some furniture?

#### surgery

 medical treatment of injuries or diseases involving an incision with instruments and often removing or replacing some parts of the body; the branch of medical science that treats disease or injury by operative procedures

*synonym*: operation, (medical) procedure

- (1) cardiac **surgery**, (2) the professor of **surgery** He had undergone heart **surgery** years before.
- to make a disease, condition, or symptom appear less severe or intense than it actually is; to alleviate or ease symptoms without curing the underlying cause

synonym: extenuate, soothe, relieve

#### stimulant

#### revisit

- v. to go to a place again, especially after a long period synonym: reexplore, review, reexamine

#### grateful

*adj.* feeling or showing an appreciation of kindness; thankful *synonym*: thankful, appreciative, indebted

#### counsel

 advice or guidance given by a person with specialized knowledge or experience, particularly in a professional or legal context; the act of providing advice or guidance

### bouquet

 a bunch of flowers, especially one presented as a gift or carried at a ceremony

### weigh

v. to have a particular weight; to carefully evaluate things before making a conclusion

#### clinic

 a building or hospital department where people can go for medical care or advice, especially of a particular condition

#### chronic

adj. being long-lasting and recurrent or characterized by long suffering; habitual

synonym: established, regular, constant

**Chronic** hyperglycemia is a trigger for a variety of serious diseases.

#### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

### compassion

 a strong feeling of sympathy and sadness for another's suffering or bad luck
