crawl

recruit

v. to move forward slowly, as people or animals with their bodies near the ground

synonym: creep, drag

- (1) **crawl** across the floor, (2) **crawl** away from a car Along the gravel roads, sizeable yellow school buses **crawl**.
- v. to persuade someone to work for a company; to find new members for an organization, the armed forces, etc.synonym: raise, enroll, enlist
- recruit a good worker, (2) recruit a new hire
   The colonial government recruited militia support when civil war broke out.

# attempt

 an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

(1) the **attempt** to rescue the hostages, (2) a reckless **attempt** 

The third **attempt** was far more successful.

jean

 a sturdy cotton twill fabric, typically blue, used for jeans and other clothing

synonym: denim, cotton, pants

(1) a **jean** skirt, (2) **jean** denim

She wore her favorite pair of **jeans** to the party.

denim

 a sturdy cotton fabric, typically blue or black, used for making jeans or other clothing

synonym: jeans, dungarees, chambray

(1) **denim** shorts, (2) **denim** jacket

She loved the feel of her new **denim** jeans against her skin.

#### chafe

v. to rub or graze against something, causing irritation, soreness, or annoyance; to become irritated or annoyed due to frustration or impatience

synonym: irritate, rub, abrade

(1) **chafed** against my shoulders, (2) **chafe** under pressure The new shoes are starting to **chafe** my feet after walking for hours.

#### chew

v. to crush or grind something, especially food, with the teeth and then swallow it

synonym: masticate, crush, grind

(1) chew each word, (2) chew a stick of gumMy dog loves to chew on bones.

### hallucinate

- v. to experience a seemingly real perception of something that does not actually exist, usually as a result of a mental illness or drug use

# monotony

# undergo

to go through something unpleasant or that involves a change

synonym: experience, suffer, endure

# abject

 adj. extremely unpleasant and degrading; physically or emotionally impoverished; miserable, wretched, and hopeless

synonym: wretched, miserable, pitiful

(1) abject failure, (2) abject despair

The **abject** poverty in the slums is a concern for the government.

# comfort

a state of physical ease and freedom from pain or constraint

synonym: ease, solace, coziness

(1) words of comfort, (2) comfort level

He found **comfort** in the warm embrace of his loved ones.

#### zone

 a specific area, region, or section that is marked off or defined in some way

synonym: area, region, territory

(1) time **zone**, (2) **zone** defense

He was reluctant to leave his comfort **zone** and try something new.

#### resilient

adj. able to withstand or recover quickly from difficult conditions

synonym: robust, sturdy, tough

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(1) a hard and **resilient** steel, (2) **resilient** population

She is a **resilient** person and has always bounced back from setbacks.

#### confidence

- the feeling or attitude that one can trust or rely on the abilities or good qualities of someone or something
   synonym: self-trust, certainty, belief

#### decision

 n. the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

## attribute

v. to say or regard that something is the result of a particular thing; (noun) a quality or feature that someone or something possesses;

# bravery

n. courage in the face of danger

*synonym*: courage, valor, heroism

# firefighter

- n. a person whose job is to extinguish fires

# depart

# doubt

# collegiate

adj. relating to or characteristic of a college or university;

synonym: collegial, university, academic

The campus had a lively, **collegiate** atmosphere with many student activities and events.

row

- n. an arrangement of objects or people side by side in a line; (verb) to propel a boat through the water using oarssynonym: line, sequence, layer
- (1) criminal on death **row**, (2) a **row** of cherry trees He was the leader of the demonstrators and spoke out against the war in the front **row**.

sear

v. to char, scorch, or burn the surface of something with intense heat; (of pain or experience) to be deeply felt or remembered over a long time

synonym: scorch, cook, burn

(1) **sear** tissue using a hot iron, (2) **sear** the memory into your mind

Be careful not to **sear** the meat too long, as it can become tough and chewy.

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# strength

 the quality or state of being physically, or sometimes mentally, strong

synonym: resilience, power, muscles

- a machine that converts thermal energy to mechanical work; something that has an important role used to achieve a purpose

synonym: motor, locomotive, driver

- a steam engine,
   an air-cooled engine
   the policies he announces can be the engine of economic growth in the country.
- v. to surge or rise in a large, swelling mass, especially of smoke or water; (noun) a large wave or swell of something, especially water or smoke

synonym: wave, swell, surge

(1) billow cloud, (2) billow like a sail

The smoke **billowed** out of the chimney and into the sky.

 a narrow lane or way between buildings, often used as a passage or a shortcut; a small street that runs between two other streets

synonym: lane, passage, pathway

(1) back alley, (2) alley cat

They played basketball in the **alley** behind their house.

 to move along lightly and quickly, making a step from one foot to the other with a hop or bounce; to intentionally fail to do something which would normally do

*synonym*: bounce, spring, neglect

#### nozzle

# typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

synonym: characteristic, usual, distinctive

(1) **typical** leader, (2) fairly **typical** symptoms

This artwork is **typical** of her work.

#### backward

adv. at, to, or toward the direction or place that is behind or rear

*synonym*: back, rearward, in reverse

(1) walk backward, (2) backward angle

She falls over **backward** when she sees her mother-in-law.

#### mask

v. to conceal something; (noun) a covering that you wear over your face to hide it

*synonym*: disguise, camouflage, conceal

(1) mask body odor, (2) an oxygen mask

The politician tried to **mask** the corruption.

# sideways

adv. towards or from the side; with one side forward or to the front; (adjective, of movement) at an angle

*synonym*: to the edge, obliquely, sidelong

(1) fall sideways, (2) a sideways market

She glanced **sideways** at the conversation of the boy she was interested in.

#### confusion

 the state of being mixed up or unclear, or the state of disorder or uncertainty

*synonym*: disorder, disarray, chaos

(1) administrative confusion, (2) in great confusion

The sudden policy change has caused **confusion** among employees.

## grope

v. to feel one's way by touching, typically because one cannot see

*synonym*: fumble, feel, pat

(1) **grope** after the truth, (2) **grope** for an answer He was forced to **grope** in the dark for the light switch.

# suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

# lung

- either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing
- (1) **lung** capacity, (2) do **lung** transplantation He has terminal **lung** cancer.

#### tackle

- v. to try to deal with a complex problem or situation synonym: deal with, dive into, work on
- (1) **tackle** the issue, (2) help **tackle** climate change The government is determined to **tackle** sharp inflation.

#### ultimate

- adj. furthest or highest in degree or ordersynonym: highest, maximum, foremost
- (1) the **ultimate** goal in life, (2) the **ultimate** luxury Management must take **ultimate** responsibility for the accident.

#### confuse

v. to mistake one thing for another; to make somebody hard to understand

*synonym*: confound, obscure, disorient

(1) **confuse** the listener, (2) **confuse** fantasy with reality Her remarks **confused** the debate.

# physically

adv. in a way related to a person's body or appearance rather than their mind

(1) **physically** and mentally, (2) stay **physically** fit Having a **physically** healthy physique is essential for a great

life.

#### astonishment

n. a feeling of very great surprise

synonym: wonder, surprise, amazement

(1) blink in astonishment, (2) struck with astonishment

They stood rooted in **astonishment** for a while.

#### brave

adj. showing courage or fearlessness in the face of danger, difficulty, or adversity

synonym: courageous, valiant, heroic

(1) brave soldier, (2) brave decision

The **brave** firefighter rescued the family from the burning building.

# acquaintance

n. a person one knows but who is not a close friend

synonym: friend, associate, contact

(1) acquaintance with a language, (2) business

acquaintance

I met him at a party, and we quickly became acquaintances.

#### scared

adj. afraid or frightened

synonym: frightened, fearful, dreading

(1) scared all the time, (2) scared dog

I'm scared of insects.

#### anxious

adj. worried and nervous

synonym: nervous, uneasy, afraid

(1) anxious about his health, (2) an anxious look

He cast **anxious** glances behind her.

#### caution

 great care and attention that you take to avoid danger or mistakes; a warning against certain acts

synonym:

carefulness, warming, notice

(1) extreme caution, (2) act with caution

He gave a stern **caution** to the naughty student.

#### involve

v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

synonym: implicate, include, engage

(1) **involve** a lot of paperwork, (2) **involve** a high degree of risk

The investigation **involves** several government agencies and is expected to take several months.

# playground

 an area where many people go for recreation, especially at a school or in a park

synonym: park, garden, sandbox

(1) a well-equipped **playground**, (2) a **playground** on the roof

There is a woods with a creek near the school playground.

# pole

one of two antipodal points where the Earth's axis of rotation intersects the Earth's surface; a long, slender, rounded rod, typically of wood or metal, used as a support or to hang something

synonym: rod, staff, shaft

(1) a fishing pole, (2) the plus pole

The North **Pole** is the northernmost point on Earth.

#### warn

v. to make someone aware of potential danger or difficulty, particularly one that may occur in the future

synonym: alert, caution, admonish

#### assist

v. to help someone in doing anything

synonym: help, support, aid

## encourage

v. to give someone support, confidence, or hope; to persuade someone to do or continue to do something by making it easier for them and making them believe it is a good thing to do

synonym: facilitate, persuade, stimulate

(1) **encourage** a sense of affinity, (2) **encourage** antisocial behavior

They **encouraged** customers with a premium for loyal patronage.

# trepidation

 a feeling of fear, anxiety, or apprehension about something uncertain or unknown; a state of alarm or nervousness that results from anticipating something frightening or dangerous

synonym: fear, anxiety, apprehension

(1) trembling with **trepidation**, (2) sense of **trepidation**She felt **trepidation** as she approached the podium to give her speech.

# guidance

advice or instructions given to help direct someone's behavior or decision-making

*synonym*: advice, direction, support

(1) vocational **guidance**, (2) **guidance** counselor The mentor provided **guidance** to the young entrepreneur, helping her navigate the business world.

# fragile

adj. delicate or easily broken or damagedsynonym: delicate, brittle, breakable

(1) politically **fragile** nation, (2) **fragile** ecosystem

The vase was made of **fragile** ceramic and easily broke when it was dropped.

# gutsy

adj. displaying courage, determination, or boldness;
 characterized by a willingness to take risks or face challenges

synonym: courageous, brave, daring

(1) gutsy move, (2) gutsy performance

It was **gutsy** to quit her job and start her own business.

# irony

 the expression of one's meaning by using language that usually signifies the opposite, typically for humorous or rhetorical effect

synonym: sarcasm, cynicism, wit

(1) bitter irony, (2) irony humor

The **irony** of the situation is that he won the lottery on the day he lost his job.

#### alike

*adv.* similar or identical in nature or appearance *synonym*: similar, identical, comparable

(1) young and old alike, (2) alike in nature

The two paintings looked **alike** as if the same artist had done them.

# puberty

 the process of a person's physical changes through which their sexual organs develop and become capable of reproduction

synonym: adolescence, young adulthood

(1) at the height of **puberty** ., (2) the onset of **puberty** In this culture, men are initiated when they reach **puberty**.

## handle

- v. to deal with a situation, problem, or strong emotion synonym: control, manage, deal with
- (1) **handle** a precious object, (2) **handled** the incident We all should learn how to **handle** stress.

#### absorb

- v. to take in a fluid or other substance gradually synonym: consume, soak, ingest
- (1) **absorb** energy, (2) **absorb** a shock The sponge **absorbs** water well.

## permanent

adj. lasting for a long time without essential change synonym: lasting, ceaseless, endless

(1) literature of **permanent** value, (2) **permanent** life insurance

She is searching for a **permanent** residence.

### emotion

n. a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with otherssynonym: feeling, sentiment, passion

(1) control my **emotion**, (2) afraid to show **emotion**Some **emotions** are common across cultures and backgrounds.

# primary

adj. first or highest in rank, order, or importance; most fundamental or essential; pertaining to the initial or introductory stage of something, such as a school year or election cycle

synonym: chief, main, fundamental

(1) primary school, (2) primary education

The **primary** cause of the accident was due to the icy road conditions.

#### reaction

a response that reveals a person's feelings or attitude;
 (in chemistry) a process in which one or more substances are changed into others

*synonym*: response, reply, answer

(1) chemical **reaction**, (2) trigger a **reaction**There was a chemical **reaction** of the lime with the groundwater.

# glider

 a light aircraft or small, unpowered plane that is designed to glide and soar through the air using natural winds and or thermal currents

synonym: sailplane, soaring bird

(1) glider club, (2) paper- glider

The hang- **glider** enthusiast looked at the clear skies, anticipating a perfect day to take flight.

pilot

 a person who flies an aircraft, especially as a job; a person qualified to guide ships through a difficult area of water

synonym: aviator, flyer, chief

(1) a test **pilot**, (2) **pilot** production

The **pilot** exercised great care in landing.

parachute

- n. a device used to slow the motion of people or objects through an atmosphere consisting of a large piece of thin cloth that is attached to them and opens out in the air
- (1) **parachute** troops, (2) golden **parachute**This training includes emergency escape drills with **parachutes**.

string

 long, thin material used for tying things together, composed of several twisted threads

synonym: line, wire, rope

(1) retie the **string** and make it strong, (2) tense piano **strings** 

She wore a **string** of pearls around her neck.

attach

- v. to fasten, join, or connect one thing to another synonym: fix, fasten, bind
- (1) **attach** firmly, (2) **attach** a file to an e-mail He does not **attach** importance to these rumors.

inflate

v. to fill something with air or gas so that it becomes bigger and rounder

synonym: blow up, expand, puff up

(1) **inflate** a tire, (2) **inflate** expense reports She **inflated** the balloons for the party.

exhilarate

v. to make someone feel very happy, animated, or excited; to fill with energy or a sense of euphoria

synonym: excite, stimulate, invigorate

(1) **exhilarate** the crowd, (2) **exhilarate** the audience

The sense of accomplishment from completing a challenging hike can **exhilarate** those who love the great outdoors

#### relevance

 the state or degree of being closely connected or appropriate to the matter at hand

*synonym*: pertinence, applicability, connection

(1) have no **relevance**, (2) **relevance** category

The **relevance** of this information to the current situation needs to be investigated.

# belong

v. to be the property of someone or something; to be a member or part of a group; to be in the proper or appropriate place

*synonym*: fit, be appropriate, be suitable

(1) **belong** to different species, (2) **belong** to a group All the books in this section **belong** to the library's rare collection and must be handled carefully.

# anticipation

- n. the action of expecting that something might happen in the future and perhaps doing something about it now synonym: expectation, prediction, prospect
- (1) **anticipation** of her arrival, (2) hazard **anticipation** She waited in eager **anticipation** for his arrival.

# timid

adj. showing a lack of courage or confidence; easily frightened, shy, or hesitant in the face of danger or potential risk

synonym: shy, bashful, nervous

(1) timid tone, (2) timid handshake

The **timid** dog cowered in fear when approached by a stranger.

# helpless

adj. unable to take care of oneself or to do things without help

synonym: defenseless, powerless, susceptible

(1) **helpless** baby, (2) **helpless** victims

I feel so **helpless** without you.

# morph

v. to change or cause to change something or someone smoothly and gradually from one thing to another

synonym: alter, modify, transform

(1) **morph** into a different shape, (2) **morph** into something entirely different

This company **morphed** into an enterprise company.

#### hesitation

 n. the act of pausing or being slow before saying or doing something, especially because you feel uncertain or nervous

synonym: unwillingness, indecision, uncertainty

(1) perform without **hesitation**, (2) after some **hesitation** There was a **hesitation** in her speech.

#### deference

 respectful or polite submission or yielding to the judgment, opinion, or wishes of another person or group; a show of respect or honor

synonym: respect, obedience, submission

(1) deference to authority, (2) pay deference

The student showed **deference** to their teacher by always being respectful in class.

#### breath

the air that is taken into and expelled from your lungs;
 the process of taking into and expelling air from your lungs

synonym: air, puff, whiff

(1) hold your breath, (2) breath of wind

He bated his **breath** when talking about this affair.

#### skate

n. a type of footwear that has a blade attached to its sole for skating on ice or other hard surfaces; an activity or sport that involves gliding on skates on ice or other hard surfaces

synonym: blade, runner, sled

She has been practicing an ice **skate** routine for months

#### clamber

to climb or move in an awkward, laborious, or ungraceful way, often using one's hands and feet

synonym: climb, scramble, crawl

# risky

adj. involving the possibility of danger, failure, or loss synonym: dangerous, perilous, scary

# delay

to cause something to happen at a later time than originally intended or expected

# gratification

- the feeling of being pleased or satisfied as a result of n. achieving something or having something you want synonym: satisfaction, pleasure, contentment

# willy-nilly

adv. haphazardly or without a plan; in a disorganized,
 random, or chaotic manner; (adjective) of or relating to
 something that is done without thought, order, or
 planning
