#### determinant

synonym: cause, factor, element

#### quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

He was labeled as a **quitter** after he abandoned the project halfway.

#### transfusion

 the transfer of blood or blood products from one person or animal to another, often to replace blood lost due to injury or surgery

synonym: transfer, graft, infusion

red blood cell transfusion, (2) plasma transfusion
 The patient received a blood transfusion during the surgery to replenish her supply.

### biopsy

n. the process of removing and examining tissue from the body of the sick person to determine the existence or cause of a disease

synonym: examination, autopsy

biopsy of bone marrow, (2) liquid biopsy

#### oncology

 the branch of medicine that deals with the study and treatment of tumors, especially malignancies

synonym: cancer treatment, study of tumors

#### sial

 the uppermost layer of the Earth's crust, consisting largely of rocks rich in silica and alumina

synonym: rock, stone, crust

#### bloodstream

- *n.* the blood flowing through the body

### potentiate

v. to increase the effect, likelihood, or power of something, such as a drug or a physiological or biochemical phenomenon

synonym: increase, boost, enhance

#### melanoma

 a type of skin cancer that originates in the cells that produce pigment, usually occurring on sun-exposed skin

#### areas

*synonym*: skin cancer, melanocarcinoma, pigmented tumor

#### metastasize

#### remission

- a period of time when a disease or condition is no longer present or active; a lessening or reduction of symptoms or intensity; forgiveness or pardon for sins or debts
- synonym: forgiveness, amnesty, absolution
- (1) complete **remission**, (2) clinical **remission**The cancer patient was delighted to hear that their disease was in **remission**.

### provocative

- adj. arousing anger, interest, or another strong reaction, especially deliberately
- synonym: instigating, provoking, inciting
- provocative questions, (2) a provocative smile

### penicillin

- n. an antibiotic drug derived from mold and used to treat bacterial infections
- synonym: antibiotic, bacitracin

#### snuggle
