### aggressive

methyl

- n. a type of organic compound that is characterized by the presence of a methyl group, which is a single carbon atom attached to three hydrogen atoms, and methyl compounds are commonly used as solvents, fuels, and in the production of a wide range of chemical products
- (1) **methyl** alcohol, (2) **methyl** paraben

  The plant biology research team identified the specific types of **methyl** groups present in the plant's DNA.

### nucleotide

n. a basic structural unit or building block of nucleic acids (DNA and RNA) consisting of a sugar molecule, a phosphate group, and a nitrogenous base (adenine, cytosine, guanine, thymine, or uracil), which combine to form the genetic code and carry information within cells

synonym: base pair, DNA building block

#### resolve

- the complete set or sequence of genes of a human, animal, plant, or other living things

#### visual

adj. relating to seeing or sightsynonym: optical, graphical, visible

The building makes a remarkable **visual** impact.

### placenta

- a temporary organ that feeds a fetus (= unborn and developing baby) inside its mother's womb
- (1) placenta blood, (2) fetal placenta

The **placenta** produces various hormones that help maintain the pregnancy.

#### rank

 a position in a hierarchy of status or authority; (verb) to take or have a position relative to others

synonym: position, status, standing

(1) rank amateur, (2) high rank

He was promoted to the **rank** of captain in the military.

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

### hierarchy

 a system in which people or things are organized into different levels of importance from highest to lowest

synonym: ranking, order, scale

(1) top of the **hierarchy**, (2) **hierarchy** of folders

She has taken a step up in the organizational **hierarchy**.

#### peon

 a person of low social status or low-wage worker, often doing menial or unskilled labor; historically, a person in Spanish America held in servitude to work on large estates or in mines

synonym: worker, laborer, serf

(1) entry-level **peon**, (2) **peon** labor

He started his career as a **peon** in the company and worked his way up to an executive position.

### cage

 a structure made of metal bars or wire in which birds or animals can be kept

synonym: enclosure, jail, corral

The trapped bear is running amok in its **cage**.

#### dramatic

adj. very sudden, very excellent, or full of action and excitement

synonym: striking, theatrical, breathtaking

(1) make **dramatic** changes, (2) a **dramatic** rescue at sea The statement had a **dramatic** impact on house prices.

#### disaster

 an unexpected event or series of events that cause widespread damage, destruction, or loss of life

synonym: catastrophe, calamity, tragedy

(1) global disaster, (2) disaster recovery

The **disaster** response team worked around the clock to aid those affected by the earthquake.

### province

*n.* the territory occupied by one of the constituent administrative districts of a nation

synonym: area, section, region

(1) Bengal province, (2) home province

A network of railways has developed over the **province**.

#### electrical

adj. relating to electricity

(1) an **electrical** storm, (2) degree in **electrical** engineering Actuators convert **electrical** pulses into motion.

#### grid

 a pattern of regularly spaced horizontal and vertical lines; a system of high tension cables by which electrical power is distributed throughout a region

synonym: gridiron, battery grid, power system

(1) a grid design, (2) a wire grid

**Grid** pattern roads often appear in urban areas.

### temperature

- n. the degree of hotness or coldness of a thing or placesynonym: climate, warmth, degree
- (1) extreme **temperatures**, (2) the atmospheric **temperature**

Cities around the world set records for highest **temperatures** this summer.

#### minus

adj. subtracting or taking away; having a value less than zero

synonym: without, lacking, negative

(1) minus sign, (2) minus temperature

The recipe calls for four cups of flour **minus** one tablespoon.

### pregnant

- adj. having a baby or young animal developing in the uterus synonym: expectant
- (1) needs of **pregnant** women, (2) a silence **pregnant** with suspense

She vacated the position when she got pregnant.

#### in-law

 a relative by marriage, such as a mother-in-law, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law

synonym: relative by marriage, family connection, affinal

(1) future in-law, (2) meeting in-laws

My sister- **in-law** is a pediatrician who works in a children's hospital.

#### posh

adj. elegant, fashionable, or luxurious, often to an excessive or ostentatious degree; associated with the upper classes or a high level of social status

synonym: elegant, fancy, luxurious

(1) **posh** district, (2) **posh** restaurant

The CEO's office was decorated in a **posh** and elegant style.

#### autism

- a developmental disorder characterized by difficulties in social interaction, verbal and nonverbal communication
- (1) high-functioning **autism**, (2) **autism** spectrum disorder There is no cure for **autism**, but early intervention and therapy can improve outcomes for individuals with the condition.

#### autoimmune

- adj. relating to a condition in which the body's immune system attacks and destroys healthy body tissue, mistaking it for harmful foreign substances
- (1) insulin **autoimmune** syndrome, (2) **autoimmune** disorder

The presence of certain substances triggered the **autoimmune** response.

### rearrange

v. to change the order or position of things already made; to change the time, date, or place of an event already planned

synonym: readjust, reorganize, reconstruct

slave

 a person who is, either legally or illegally, owned by someone; a person entirely dominated by some influence or a person

synonym: captive, bondservant, hard worker

### deprogram

v. to release someone from a restrictive or controlling ideology, belief system, or cult; to disabuse or undo the effects of indoctrination or brainwashing

synonym: rehabilitate, unprogram, free

The organization offered resources to help people

### deprogram from addiction.

#### cancer

 abnormal growth of cells that can invade and destroy surrounding tissues and organs; a disease characterized by the uncontrolled growth and spread of abnormal cells

*synonym*: tumor, carcinoma, malignancy

Breast **cancer** is the most common type of cancer in women.

### cocaine

n. a highly addictive stimulant drug that is derived from the leaves of the coca plant, often used recreationally for its euphoric effects but also used in medicine as a local anesthetic and vasoconstrictor

#### addiction

### recapitulate

cue

 a signal, gesture, or action that provides information or direction for someone else to act or respond; a reminder or prompt for someone to do something

crazy
