#### committee

 a group of people appointed or elected to perform a specific function or manage a particular task, often within a larger organization

#### horrific

### investigate

 to conduct a systematic or formal inquiry to identify and evaluate the facts of a crime, problem, statement, etc. to establish the truth

*synonym*: examine, analyze, look into

(1) **investigate** the matter, (2) **investigate** a data leak The committee **investigated** several apparent inconsistencies.

#### harassment

n. the act of repeatedly annoying, tormenting, or persecuting someone in a way that is threatening or unwelcome, often relating to issues of race, gender, or other identities

synonym: bullying, persecution, intimidation

(1) sexual **harassment**, (2) emotional **harassment**The company has a zero-tolerance policy for **harassment** in the workplace.

### epidemic

 the widespread outbreak of a particular disease in a large number of people at the same time

synonym: outbreak, contagion, plague

(1) a worldwide **epidemic**, (2) health **epidemic**The disease is now reaching **epidemic** proportions in our country.

### horrify

v. to shock or disgust greatly

synonym: shock, dismay, terrify

(1) horrify audience, (2) horrify victims

The series of terrorist attacks **horrify** the entire nation.

### discriminate

v. to treat a person or particular group of people worse or better than another, especially in an unfair way; to

recognize or perceive the difference between people or things

synonym: show prejudice, segregate, differentiate

You should not **discriminate** against minorities.

#### scrub

 to clean something thoroughly, typically with a brush and soap or detergent

synonym: clean, wash, sanitize

- a feeling of tiredness or weariness, especially as a result of physical or mental exertion; the reduction in the strength or efficiency of a material or structure due to repeated use or stress

### democracy

### independence

- n. freedom from another's or others' control or influencesynonym: freedom, liberty, autonomy
- (1) financial **independence**, (2) **independence** ceremony There is nothing more valuable than **independence** and freedom.

#### military

adj. relating to or characteristic of members of the armed forces; of or relating to war or warfare

synonym: armed, martial, warlike

#### assistant

n. someone who helps or supports someone else to do a job

synonym: aide, helper, associate

an unwilling assistant,

 assistant director administers each branch.

### engineer

 a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software

synonym: architect, creator, builder

(1) a civil **engineer**, (2) **engineer** shortage

The **engineer** will repair my telephone tomorrow morning.

### journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

*synonym*: reporter, newsperson, press

(1) a China-based **journalist**, (2) **journalist** on a magazine Foreign TV crews and **journalists** can go as they please in various locations during the Olympics.

### encourage

v. to give someone support, confidence, or hope; to persuade someone to do or continue to do something by making it easier for them and making them believe it is a good thing to do

synonym: facilitate, persuade, stimulate

(1) **encourage** a sense of affinity, (2) **encourage** antisocial behavior

They **encouraged** customers with a premium for loyal patronage.

cliff

 a steep rock face, especially one at the edge of the sea or a river

synonym: crag, escarpment, precipice

(1) a bold cliff, (2) cliff diving

He stood at the edge of the **cliff** and looked out to sea.

scary

adj. causing fear or fright; frightening; intimidating synonym: terrifying, frightening, alarming

excruciating

adj. extremely painful, intense, or distressing; causing great physical or emotional suffering

synonym: agonizing, unbearable, torturous

abyss

#### voiceless

adj. without a voice or the ability to speak synonym: mute, silent, speechless

### suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

flee

v. to leave by running away, especially out of fear or danger

synonym: exit, escape, run away

(1) flee their homes, (2) flee abroad

It is a basic instinct to **flee** from a dangerous situation.

#### attendant

 a person who is employed to provide a service or perform tasks, often in a public place, such as a flight attendant, parking attendant, or hospital attendant

synonym: assistant, aide, guide

(1) flight attendant, (2) personal attendant

The **attendant** at the parking lot directed me to an available parking spot

### supervisor

- n. a person who oversees or directs the work of otherssynonym: manager, boss, overseer

### pornography

 materials such as films, photographs, or written descriptions that depict or describe sexual activity graphically or explicitly, often intended to be sexually arousing

*synonym*: obscenity, indecency, smut

(1) **pornography** addiction, (2) violent **pornography** The rise of digital technology has made the sharing of **pornography** easier than ever before.

### notepad

 n. (also scratchpad) a small pad of paper or a digital device used for taking notes

synonym: notebook, memo pad, scratch pad

### complain

 to say dissatisfaction or annoyance about something or somebody

synonym: gripe, claim, denounce

#### crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angrysynonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

### colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

- adj. highly offensive, unpleasant, or objectionable; morally reprehensible or wicked; characterized by cruelty or

#### violence

synonym: disgusting, repulsive, despicable

(1) vile behavior, (2) vile language

The **vile** smell coming from the dumpster was unbearable.

#### label

 a small piece of paper, fabric, or other material attached to an object and giving information about it; (verb) to assign to a category

synonym: tag, mark, identifier

(1) a mailing **label**, (2) **label** a bag with my name The **label** on the food package lists the ingredients and nutritional information.

#### troublemaker

 a person who intentionally causes difficulties or problems for others, often by disruptive or provocative behavior; a person who tends to create or attract trouble or controversy

synonym: troublemonger, instigator, agitator

(1) **troublemaker** kid, (2) accused **troublemaker**The teacher had to reprimand the **troublemaker** in class constantly.

#### subordinate

adj. of lower rank or importance, often used to describe a person in a position of inferiority or inferior status; serving as a secondary or supporting element to something else

synonym: inferior, secondary, subservient

(1) **subordinate** position, (2) **subordinate** role

The CEO's **subordinate** employees were expected to follow his instructions without question.

### startling

adj. extremely surprising, astonishing, and sometimes worrying

synonym: alarming, astonishing, shocking

#### harass

v. to annoy, torment, or pester persistently; to subject someone to repeated or chronic attacks or unwelcome attention

#### incidence

n. the frequency or rate at which a particular event or condition occurs within a specific population, group, or area; the occurrence or manifestation of something, especially something harmful or unpleasant

synonym: occurrence, frequency, prevalence

(1) **incidence** rate, (2) high **incidence** of disease

The **incidence** of crime has decreased in the neighborhood since the new security measures were put in place.

#### demean

v. to lower or damage someone's dignity, honor, or reputation; to treat someone disrespectfully, often in a way that makes them feel inferior or humiliated

synonym: lower, degrade, humiliate

#### blacklist

 a list of names or entities that are seen as undesirables or perceived as a threat, often compiled by a government or organization and used to restrict access or opportunities

*synonym*: ban, exclusion, proscription

The software uses a robust **blacklist** to prevent access to malicious websites and protect users from online threats.

### profession

an occupation or vocation requiring advanced education or specialized training

synonym: occupation, vocation, trade

#### silent

adj. without any or little soundsynonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) silent reading, (2) give silent consent

The politician remained silent despite intense media scrutiny.

rank

 a position in a hierarchy of status or authority; (verb) to take or have a position relative to others

*synonym*: position, status, standing

(1) rank amateur, (2) high rank

He was promoted to the rank of captain in the military.

#### executive

n. a person or group of people with top-level management responsibility in a business or other organization; the branch that is responsible for implementing, administering, and enforcing laws, as well as running the day-to-day operations

synonym: administrator, manager, director

(1) **executive** editor at the publishing house, (2) **executive** vice president

As the executive director of the non-profit, it's her

responsibility to make sure they're meeting their mission goals.

### lung

- *n.* either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing
- (1) **lung** capacity, (2) do **lung** transplantation He has terminal **lung** cancer.

#### stick

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

### tongue

 a moveable mass of muscle tissue covered with mucous membrane that is in the mouth; a language

#### intent

 a strong determination or attention to do or achieve something; (adjective) having a strong determination to do or achieve something

#### pants

 an item of clothing that covers the lower part of the body and each leg separately, typically with a waistband and two legs

#### crotch

- n. the part of the body between the legs where they join the torso, including the area around the genitalssynonym: groin, loin, genitals

#### confidence

- n. the feeling or attitude that one can trust or rely on the abilities or good qualities of someone or somethingsynonym: self-trust, certainty, belief

#### assault

#### trump

- a playing card with a picture of a trumpeter on it, used in certain card games

### predict

 $\nu$ . to state beforehand that something will happen in the future, mainly based on knowledge or experience

synonym: forecast, anticipate, foresee

(1) **predict** the future, (2) **predict** when she will arrive It's notoriously challenging to **predict** birth rates.

### president

n. the leader of a republic, for example, the US; the person in charge of the organization such as a company, university, club, etc.

synonym: leader, CEO, chairperson

(1) **president** emeritus, (2) vice- **president** for finance The club **president** does not have absolute power.

#### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

### spite

n. feelings of anger and resentment; (in spite of, also despite) a phrase that is used to indicate that something happened or exists even though there is a particular obstacle or difficulty

synonym: malice, ill will, vindictiveness

(1) bear **spite** against him, (2) die in **spite** of intensive care He did it out of **spite**, to annoy me.

#### thereafter

adv. after that; subsequently

synonym: subsequently, afterward, henceforth

(1) not long **thereafter**, (2) for several weeks **thereafter** He was promoted to manager, and **thereafter**, he began to make changes in the company.

#### gig

a performance by a musician or group of musicians,
 especially playing modern or pop music or jazz; a work
 that someone undertakes on a temporary basis

*synonym*: show, concert, engagement

(1) <b>gig</b> economy, (2) have a <b>gig</b> a	at the stadium
We are planning a speaking gig by	a well-known author at a
community center in a neighboring	town.

#### confident

adj. feeling sure about your abilities or qualities or having trust in people, plans, or the future

synonym: certain, sure, convinced

(1) feel **confident**, (2) a **confident** remark I'm not **confident** in our victory.

#### blond

adj. of a light, yellowish-brown or golden color, typically describing hair color; (also spelled "blonde") a female with such hair color

synonym: blonde, light-haired

(1) **blond** fuzz, (2) ash- **blond** ringlet

She is a natural **blond** and doesn't need to dye her hair.

#### brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

(1) basic **brain** function, (2) permanent **brain** damageX-rays revealed a small tumor in his **brain**.

#### rural

adj. of or relating to the countryside

synonym: agrarian, country, rustic

(1) rural accents, (2) people in rural areas

Many **rural** areas are still impoverished.

#### breast

 either of the two round soft parts of a woman's chest which secrete milk after childbirth

*synonym*: bosom, chest, bust

(1) **breast** cancer, (2) the mountain's **breast** 

He grilled the **breast** meat of a chicken.

### microphone

 a device that converts sound into an electrical signal used for recording sounds or making the voice louder

synonym: mic, megaphone, amplifier

### (1) microphone cable, (2) built-in microphone

The interviewer asked him to speak into the **microphone**.

#### downhill

adv. in a direction that is downward or from a higher to a lower point; in a progressively worse or deteriorating manner

*synonym*: downslope

(1) ski downhill, (2) walk downhill to the beach

The family's finances have been going **downhill** since they lost their main source of income.

### bracing

adj. refreshing or invigorating; designed to provide support or stability

synonym: invigorating, refreshing, stimulating

(1) bracing air, (2) bracing walk

The athlete performed some **bracing** exercises to warm up before the game.

### cell-phone

 a portable electronic device used for making and receiving phone calls, sending text messages, and accessing the internet wirelessly

synonym: mobile, smartphone

(1) **cell-phone** signal, (2) **cell-phone** battery

I left my cell-phone at home, and now I feel lost.

### petrify

 $\nu$ . to turn to stone; to make hard and unyielding

synonym: fossilize, mineralize, calcify

(1) petrify with fear, (2) petrify into stone

The thought of public speaking will petrify her.

#### envision

v. to imagine or expect what a situation will be like in the future

synonym: anticipate, foresee, picture

(1) **envision** the future, (2) **envision** the project's success We cannot **envision** her as President.

roll

v. to move in a particular direction by turning over and over or from side to side

synonym: spin, swirl, wheel

(1) roll a ball, (2) roll down his cheeks

He was exhausted and **rolled** into bed as soon as he got home.

mogul

a powerful or influential person, especially in business or industry

*synonym*: big shot, bigwig, executive

(1) real-estate **mogul**, (2) business **mogul** 

He is a media **mogul** and owns several major newspapers.

allegation

an assertion or claim that is made without proof or evidence; a statement that someone has done something wrong or illegal but which has not been proven in a court of law

synonym: claim, assertion, declaration

(1) baseless **allegations**, (2) **allegation** of corruption The **allegation** of fraud against the politician damaged his reputation.

excuse

 a reason or explanation, either true or invented, given to justify a fault or defend your behavior; (verb) to make someone free from blame or clear from guilt

*synonym*: apology, justification, reason

(1) excuse for inaction, (2) perfect excuse

He quickly fabricated an **excuse** for not attending the meeting.

unfortunately

adv. by bad luck; unluckily

synonym: regrettably, unluckily, alas

(1) **unfortunately** caught in a shower, (2) even more **unfortunately** 

The treatments were done but, **unfortunately**, were unsuccessful.

### myth

n. an ancient story or set of stories accepted as history, especially explaining the worldview of a peoplesynonym: fable, legend, lore

(1) the **myth** of an old religion, (2) perpetuate a **myth** With the financial bubble bursting, the **myth** of economic growth in investment banking collapsed.

#### associate

v. to mentally connect someone or something with someone or something else

synonym: tie in, link, consociate

(1) **associate** alcohol with gambling, (2) **associate** with people widely

The majority of consumers associate this brand with quality.

### makeup

 colored substances used on someone's face to improve or change their appearance

synonym: maquillage, composition, cosmetic

- (1) **makeup** artist, (2) take the **makeup** off her face Her beauty resulted from a good night's sleep rather than **makeup**.
- hood n. a covering for the head and neck, especially one attached to a garment

synonym: hoodie, cowl, cloak

(1) hood ornament, (2) a silk hood

He pulled his waterproof **hood** up to protect himself from the rain.

### silicon

- n. a chemical element with the symbol Si that is a hard, brittle crystalline solid with a blue-grey metallic luster and used for the transistors and integrated circuit chips in computers
- silicon wafer, (2) crystalline silicon
   Silicon is the second most abundant element on earth after oxygen.

### valley

a long depression on the surface of the land, which typically contains a river

synonym: canyon, gorge, dale

(1) valley bottom, (2) basin-shaped valley

The **valley** had received a mild snowfall the previous week.

#### provocative

adj. arousing anger, interest, or another strong reaction, especially deliberately

synonym: instigating, provoking, inciting

- (1) provocative questions, (2) a provocative smile His **provocative** style frequently sparked controversies.
- a thing given in acknowledgment of service, hard work, reward achievement, etc.

*synonym*: compensation, gratuity, bonus

(1) the **reward** for good works, (2) shopping **rewards** cards Night fishing has a lot of **rewards**.

claim

to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to **claim** ownership of the abandoned property.

bet

to risk money on the result of an event or a competition, such as a race or game, to get more money; to have faith or confidence in something

synonym: stake, wager, gamble

- (1) bet on a race, (2) bet my future
- I bet that you know it.

swift

- adj. happening, moving, or capable of moving quickly synonym: quick, speedy, brisk
- (1) take **swift** action, (2) a **swift** current of a river Her voice was **swift**, yet ever the last words fell lingeringly.

#### fame

 the condition of being well-known and discussed by a large number of people as a result of one's accomplishments, abilities, and so on

synonym: celebrity, renown, stardom

(1) leap into **fame**, (2) his undying **fame** Good **fame** is better than a good face.

### grope

v. to feel one's way by touching, typically because one cannot see

synonym: fumble, feel, pat

(1) **grope** after the truth, (2) **grope** for an answer He was forced to **grope** in the dark for the light switch.

#### untold

adj. not yet revealed or known; not having been counted or measured

synonym: countless, immeasurable, innumerable

(1) **untold** riches, (2) an **untold** number of people

The **untold** stories of the disaster victims need to be heard to understand the impact fully.

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

(1) **environment** affairs, (2) chaotic **environment**Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's **environment**.

### bystander

 a person who witnesses an event or situation but does not actively participate or intervene

synonym: spectator, observer, witness

innocent bystander, (2) shocked bystander
 The bystander effect is a phenomenon where people are less likely to intervene in an emergency if others are present.

### corporation

 a large company or group of companies that are controlled together by law as a single unit

*synonym*: business, company, enterprise

(1) a public **corporation**, (2) **corporation** assets Four companies were amalgamated into a single **corporation**.

### policy

n. a set of rules, guidelines, principles, or procedures that govern decision-making or action, often used in the context of business or government; a course of action or plan of action adopted or followed by an organization or individual to achieve a goal or objective

synonym: strategy, plan, guideline

(1) health **policy**, (2) foreign **policy** 

The company's new **policy** on remote work has made it a more inclusive workplace.

### overwhelming

adj. very great or intense; so powerful that you cannot fight or react against it

synonym: overpowering, astounding, amazing

(1) **overwhelming** majority, (2) an **overwhelming** victory He has shown signs of uneasiness and **overwhelming** worry.

#### witness

regard

a person who sees something happen, especially a crime or an accident

synonym: onlooker, attestant, bystander

- (1) **witness** of the car accident, (2) a material **witness**The manufacturing industry is **witnessing** fierce competition.
- v. to think about or consider somebody or something in a specified way

synonym: consider, see, reckon

(1) **regard** him as an enemy, (2) **regard** the situation as unfortunate
