### globe

the earth or world, mainly used to emphasize its vastness

synonym: Earth, world, sphere

### spinning

n. the act of rotating rapidly around an axis; in the context of textiles, the process of twisting fibers together to form thread or yarn

synonym: whirling, rotating, spinning wheel

#### coordinated

adj. effectively arranged or organized so that all the parts work smoothly or systematically together

synonym: collective, unified, cooperative

#### bomb

 a weapon that explodes and is used to kill or injure people or to cause damage to something

#### subway

tectonic

adj. relating to the structure of the Earth's crust and the large-scale processes that occur as a result of movements within it

synonym: seismic, geologic, geological

- n. a slight transition in position, direction, or trendsynonym: transition, change, modification

### ideology

 a set of beliefs or philosophies that an economic or political system is based on

synonym: credo, doctrine, principles

(1) the **ideology** of the left, (2) political **ideology**Racial equality is an integral part of democratic **ideology**.

### religion

 a deep conviction in a supernatural power that controls human destiny

synonym: faith, creed, belief

(1) **religion** sociology, (2) freedom of **religion**Their **religion** strictly prohibits them from drinking or gambling.

### precarious

adj. not securely held or in position; dangerously unstable or uncertain; dependent on chance or uncertain conditionssynonym: precariousness, instability, uncertainty

(1) **precarious** job, (2) **precarious** financial situation She had a **precarious** hold on the ladder and was afraid to move.

### principle

*n.* a fundamental law or truth that explains or controls how something happens or works

synonym: rule, creed, code

#### battlefield

n. a place where a battle or conflict is foughtsynonym: warzone, front line, combat area

### landscape

an expanse of scenery that can be seen in a single view;
 a large area of land, especially in the country and relating to its appearance

Recent electoral shocks have shaken the political **landscape** in Europe.

#### committed

adj. willing to put in a lot of effort, time, and energy into something; firmly believing in something

synonym: devoted, faithful, attached

Our company is strongly **committed** to meeting customers' needs.

#### horrible

adj. extremely unpleasant or bad; causing fear or disgust synonym: dreadful, terrible, awful

### atrocity

- n. brutal act; an extremely wicked or cruel actsynonym: evil, horror, iniquity

#### extremism

n. the holding of extreme political or religious views;
 actions or beliefs that fall outside of what is considered acceptable or reasonable

synonym: fanaticism, radicalism, zealotry

The rise of far-right **extremism** has sparked concern among many civil rights organizations.

#### hostile

adj. unfriendly or aggressively opposedsynonym: unfriendly, aggressive, antagonistic

#### relate

v. to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

He tried to **relate** his experience to the group, but they couldn't understand.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

#### utter

adj. complete, total, or absolute; said, done, or experienced without any exceptions or qualifications; spoken aloud or enunciated very clearly and distinctly; (verb) to speak or articulate words, sounds, or a voice

synonym: absolute, complete, total

(1) utter nonsense, (2) utter a big sigh

The **utter** chaos of the concert crowd made it seem like a wild animal was in the room.

### trigger

- v. to make something happen suddenly; to cause something such as a device, machine, etc. to functionsynonym: activate, spark, drive
- (1) **trigger** a biochemical response, (2) **trigger** inflation The incident **triggered** a political controversy.

#### detonate

 to explode or cause to explode; to set off a sudden or dramatic series of events

synonym: explode, blow up, ignite

(1) detonate a missile, (2) detonate a plan

The bomb squad had to **detonate** the suspicious package found at the train station.

#### eyebrow

n. the hair arc over each eye in humans

synonym: brow, supercilium

(1) raise her **eyebrows**, (2) **eyebrow** cosmetics

She raised an inquiring **eyebrow** towards me.

#### decide

v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options

synonym: choose, determine, settle

(1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

#### abortion

 the intentional termination of a pregnancy at an early stage

synonym: miscarriage

(1) **abortion** doctor, (2) the highly charged issue of **abortion** 

We strongly oppose the abortion ban.

#### **Christ**

 the man that Christians believe is the prophet and the son of God, and whose life and sermons form the basis for Christianity

synonym: Savior, Jesus Christ, Jesus

(1) teaching of **Christ**, (2) before **Christ** 

**Christmas** is the day to celebrate the birth of Christ.

#### extremist

 a person who holds extreme political or religious views and who is willing to use violent or illegal methods to promote those views

synonym: radical, fanatic, zealot

(1) **extremist** political views, (2) radical **extremist**The **extremist** group planned a series of violent attacks to push its agenda.

#### murder

n. the crime of killing somebody intentionally

synonym: slaying, killing

(1) murder in the second degree, (2) attempted murder

This intriguing **murder** mystery remains unsolved.

### inspire

- v. to make somebody fill with the desire, confidence, or enthusiasm, especially to do something creative
   synonym: boost, encourage, enlighten

### wedge

- a piece of wood, metal, or other material with one thick end and a narrow edge that is driven between two things or parts of objects to secure or separate them

He inserted the **wedge** into a split in the log.

### cynical

adj. believing that people are motivated by self-interest; distrustful of human sincerity or integrity

synonym: skeptical, mistrustful, doubtful

He was very **cynical** and didn't believe anything anyone said unless he saw evidence for himself.

#### subordinate

adj. of lower rank or importance, often used to describe a person in a position of inferiority or inferior status; serving as a secondary or supporting element to something else

synonym: inferior, secondary, subservient

(1) subordinate position, (2) subordinate role

The CEO's **subordinate** employees were expected to follow his instructions without question.

### stigmatize

- to accuse, condemn, or openly or formally consider somebody or something as not deserving respect
   synonym: brand, mark, denounce
- (1) stigmatize the deviant as criminal, (2) stigmatize him

as a swindler

She was **stigmatized** by society because she had a child out of wedlock.

#### racism

prejudice, discrimination, or antagonism directed against a person or people based on their membership in a particular ethnic group, typically one that is a minority or marginalized

synonym: prejudice, discrimination, bias

(1) systemic **racism**, (2) research on anti- **racism**The school's lack of diversity was a clear indication of the **racism** present in the community.

#### **Semitic**

- adj. relating to the group of languages that includes Hebrew, Arabic, and Aramaic, spoken by the peoples of the middle east and north Africa
- (1) anti- **Semitic** movement, (2) **Semitic** culture The **Semitic** languages include Hebrew, Arabic, and Aramaic.

#### faith

 n. complete trust in something or someone's ability or knowledge; a strong belief in religion, divine power, etc.

synonym: belief, trust, confidence

(1) religious **faith**, (2) **faith** in government He kept his robust **faith** in his company.

#### suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

### pernicious

adj. causing harm or destruction, often in a subtle or gradual way

synonym: harmful, malicious, destructive

(1) pernicious effect, (2) pernicious disease

The **pernicious** influence of the corrupt officials had a detrimental effect on the town.

#### trend

 a general direction in which something is changing or developing

*synonym*: direction, movement, tendency

routine

 a usual or habitual way of doing things; a set sequence of steps, part of a larger computer program

synonym: habit, custom, procedure

ism

 a specific doctrine, theory, or ideology; a suffix used to form nouns indicating a practice, doctrine, or theory

synonym: ideology, doctrine, philosophy

#### institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

stick

to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

out.

### paradigm

 a standard or typical example of something; a pattern or model

*synonym*: example, standard, epitome

rote

 repetition of something to the point of memorization, especially of facts, without fully understanding it

synonym: repetition, memorization, drill

### perfunctory

 adj. carried out with minimal effort or interest; done as a routine or duty without enthusiasm, care, or attention to detail; lacking thoroughness or sincerity

 perfunctory apology did not seem sincere at all.

#### devoid

adj. completely lacking or free from something synonym: empty, lacking, void

#### vision

 n. the ability to think about or see the future with imagination and intelligence; the faculty of being able to see

synonym: sight, image, concept

(1) a prodigious **vision**, (2) telescopic **vision** 

Driving is difficult for me because of my poor vision.

### blessing

 a gift or favor from a higher power or force; an act or expression of approval, encouragement, or gratitude; something that brings happiness or good fortune *synonym*: favor, benediction, boon

(1) count your **blessings**, (2) bestowed **blessings**Receiving support from his friends was a great **blessing** in his time of need.

### canopy

 a covering, typically of fabric, supported on poles or suspended above a bed, throne, or other object, used to shelter or screen the person or object below it

*synonym*: cover, top, shade

(1) **canopy** layer, (2) under a **canopy** of smoke The forest's **canopy** provides shade and protection for the plants and animals below.

### proclaim

- v. to announce or state something publicly and forcefully synonym: announce, declare, trumpet
- (1) proclaim victory, (2) proclaim law

The leader **proclaimed** a state of emergency in the country.

### publicly

adv. in a manner accessible to or observable by the public; by the government

synonym: candidly, openly, honestly

(1) **publicly** accessible record, (2) **publicly** financed schools

She **publicly** denounced the government's mishandling of the economic crisis.

### holy

adj. of or related to a god, divine power, or a particular religion

synonym: sacred, religious, divine

(1) a holy man, (2) a holy shrine

They gathered to hear the holy teachings of the guru.

### intensify

v. to increase or make something increase in extent or strength

*synonym*: amplify, boost, strengthen

(1) **intensify** diplomatic efforts, (2) **intensify** a good relationship

Rebels have pledged to **intensify** the armed struggle against the dictatorship.

#### anniversary

 the annual recurrence of a date marking a notable event; a date on which an event occurred in a previous year

synonym: commemoration, celebration, observance

(1) **anniversary** celebration, (2) a bicentennial **anniversary** They celebrated their 10th **anniversary** with a romantic dinner.

#### reserve

 to keep something for future use or contingency; to obtain or arrange something, such as a meeting, seat, etc., in advance

synonym: keep, hold, preserve

(1) **reserve** the right, (2) **reserve** a concert ticket You can easily **reserve** seats over the telephone.

### pray

- v. to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request synonym: implore, supplicate, entreat
- (1) pray devoutly, (2) pray for rain

She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

#### ritual

any customary observance or practice; any prescribed procedure for conducting religious ceremonies

synonym: tradition, ceremony, routine

(1) a ritual dance, (2) morning ritual

The woman of the house does the holy **ritual** of lighting two candles.

#### rite

 a formal or ceremonial act or set of acts performed in a traditional or prescribed way; a religious or spiritual ceremony or practice synonym: ceremony, ritual, practice

(1) perform the **rite**, (2) **rite** of passage into adulthood The bishop performed the **rite** of consecration for the new church.

### essentially

adv. relating to the essential features or concepts of anything synonym: fundamentally, basically, virtually

(1) **essentially** correct, (2) become **essentially** same **Essentially**, a society is an organism.

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) **function** properly, (2) immune **function**The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

#### remnant

 a small remaining quantity of something, considered separately from what has been lost or destroyed; a surviving piece or fragment of something

synonym: remainder, leftover, residue

(1) **remnant** of the past, (2) **remnants** of fabric The only **remnant** left of the ancient civilization was the crumbling ruins of their temples.

#### sacred

 adj. connected with religion or religious purposes; worthy of respect or dedication because of a connection with a god

synonym: holy, inviolable, hallowed

(1) **sacred** music, (2) the halo of a **sacred** image This space is a private office **sacred** to the President

### revelry

 n. lively and noisy festivities, typically involving drinking, dancing, and general merrymaking; a celebration marked by indulgence and enjoyment

*synonym*: festivity, merrymaking, celebration

(1) **revelry** in the streets, (2) festival **revelry** 

The street was filled with **revelry** on New Year's Eve.

#### encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

synonym: meet, run into, come across

(1) **encounter** a crisis, (2) **encounter** a storm I'm prepared to **encounter** challenges throughout this adventure.

affair

 event, situation, or subject that is significant from a political or public perspective; a secretive or illicit sexual relationship

synonym: matter, incident, fling

(1) current affairs, (2) domestic affairs

Some critics say this exhibition will be a big affair.

#### endless

adj. having no end or conclusion; infinitely very large in size or amount

synonym: infinite, ceaseless, boundless

(1) **endless** possibilities, (2) **endless** hours

He looked out the window at the endless stream of people.

#### mindless

adj. lacking in awareness, thought, or attention; done without thinking or consideration; pointless or empty-headed

*synonym*: senseless, thoughtless, irresponsible

(1) mindless task, (2) mindless entertainment

Mindless scrolling on social media can be a time waster.

### repetition

- n. the act of doing or saying something many timessynonym: duplication, iteration, recurrence
- (1) repetition of the word, (2) habitual repetition

### jealousy

- v. to decrease in size, strength, or intensity synonym: decrease, diminish, fade
- (1) wane over time, (2) wane in popularity

The fragrance of this material wanes over weeks to months.

#### statistics

- *n.* the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) statistics for cancer, (2) official statistics

The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

#### church

 a building or institution dedicated to religious worship or activities; a Christian religious organization or denomination

synonym: chapel, cathedral, synagogue

(1) church bell, (2) small church

The **church** on the corner is hosting a free community meal tonight.

### synagogue

 a Jewish house of worship, typically consisting of a hall for prayer and study and often containing a sanctuary, a social hall, and a collection of administrative offices

synonym: temple, shul, tabernacle

(1) reconstructed **synagogue**, (2) historical **synagogue** We attended services at the local **synagogue** during the High Holidays.

### mosque

- a Muslim place of worship that usually has a minaret (= slender tower with balconies)
- (1) domed **mosque**, (2) the sacred **mosque**Jumeirah **Mosque** is one of the most beautiful buildings in the United Arab Emirates.

### complain

v. to say dissatisfaction or annoyance about something or somebody

synonym: gripe, claim, denounce

maintain

v. to continue to uphold or sustain; to keep in a particular state or condition; to assert or declare something to be true

#### relevance

#### tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

### disgust

n. a strong feeling of dislike or disapproval

#### **lifeless**

adj. without life; dead

synonym: inanimate, inert, motionless

#### concurrent

 adj. happening or existing at the same time; parallel or simultaneous

#### determinant

#### reclaim

#### Jewish

adj. of or relating to people whose traditional religion is Judaism
