## starvation

 a severe lack of food that leads to malnutrition and, ultimately, death

synonym: hunger, malnutrition, emaciation

## physicist

- n. a scientist who specializes in the field of physics
- (1) talented **physicist**, (2) theoretical **physicist**Einstein was an outstanding and famous **physicist** of the 20th century.

## lorn

synonym: desolate, forsaken, abandoned

## formidable

## thorium

 a radioactive chemical element with the symbol Th and atomic number 90 that is silvery-white in color and is used as fuel in some nuclear reactors

*synonym*: Th, radioactive element

Certain isotopes of **thorium** are used in medicine for treating liver cancer.

## disprove

## pitchblende

 a brown to black mineral that is the main source of uranium and radium typically found in veins associated with certain types of radioactive ores

synonym: uraninite, uranium ore, uranophane

## polonium

n. a highly radioactive chemical element with the symbol Po and atomic number 84 that belongs to the group of rare heavy metals, known for its high toxicity and is typically produced in nuclear reactors

*synonym*: Po

The traces of **polonium** in the environment usually come from the decay of natural radioactive elements.

#### radium

 a radioactive chemical element with the symbol Ra and atomic number 88, often used in the treatment of some diseases such as cancer

synonym: Ra, radioactive material

## nominate
