# sprinkler

 a device that sprays water over a large area used especially for watering crops or gardens or for firefighting

*synonym*: sprayer, irrigation system

# prestige

 respect and admiration felt or shown for someone or something based on a perception of their achievements or quality

synonym: honor, distinction, reputation

national prestige, (2) prestige company
 The university has great prestige in the academic community.

#### laureate

#### alliteration

#### ostensible

#### intellect

#### remake

#### disservice

# masculinity

(1) masculinity norms, (2) toxic masculinity Research has shown that rigid ideas of masculinity can contribute to domestic violence and other forms of abuse.

stifle

# compel

v. to force or require someone to do something; to exert a strong, irresistible force or pressure that makes someone act in a certain way
