v. to cause to move up or away after hitting a surface; to spring back

synonym: bound, leap, spring

#### grammar

 the set of structural constraints on speakers' or writers' composition of clauses, phrases, and words

synonym: syntax, elements

# principle

 a fundamental law or truth that explains or controls how something happens or works

synonym: rule, creed, code

# pronounce

v. to say or speak (a word or words) correctly or in a particular way

synonym: articulate, enunciate, voice

# correspond

to match or be similar to something else almost exactly;
 to exchange messages

synonym: match, equate, communicate

(1) **correspond** to a standard, (2) **correspond** with a foreign student

The numbers on the sign **correspond** to points on the map.

# represent

ν. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

# phonetic

adj. of or relating to speech sounds or scientific study of speech sound

synonym: vocal, spoken, phonic

(1) phonetic spelling, (2) phonetic sounds

- v. to put in opposition to show or emphasize differences synonym: differ, vary, counterpoint
- (1) **contrast** with a decade ago, (2) **contrast** two things It's intriguing to compare and **contrast** the two authors.

#### resist

v. to refuse to accept something and attempt to prevent it from happening

synonym: fight, defy, revolt

(1) resist temptation, (2) resist being kissedI chose to resist cancer by trying every possible treatment.

#### absent

adj. not present in a particular place at a particular time synonym: missing, away, not present

#### decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering optionssynonym: choose, determine, settle

#### decision

 the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

synonym: choice, determination, judgment

(1) **decision** authority, (2) a selfish **decision**She was struggling to make a **decision** between two job offers.

# etymology

the study of the origin and history of words, including changes in meaning and form over time; the history of a particular word or phrase (1) **etymology** dictionary, (2) the **etymology** of a word The study of **etymology** helps us to understand the origins of words.

#### silent

adj. without any or little sound synonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) silent reading, (2) give silent consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

# contrary

- n. acting in opposition to what is expected or desiredsynonym: opposing, contradictory, conflicting
- (1) the clear **contrary**, (2) **contrary** evidence The two sides argued their points, but the judge ultimately sided with the **contrary** viewpoint.

#### differentiate

 to recognize or establish as being distinct; to distinguish between things that are compared; to calculate a derivative

synonym: discern, distinguish, separate

# aspiration

 a strong desire to achieve something; the action or process of drawing breath

synonym: ambition, inhalation, intake

- a polite or formal term used to refer to a man,
   particularly one who is gentle or refined in manners or behavior; short for a gentleman

#### nowhere

adv. not in, at, or to any place; not anywhere

(1) **nowhere** else to go, (2) come out of **nowhere** I've been thinking all day and getting **nowhere**.

#### invest

v. to put money, effort, time, etc. into something to make a profit or achieve a result

synonym: fund, sponsor, support

(1) **invest** in stocks, (2) **invest** capital

The government should view children as national assets and actively **invest** in them.

# pliant

adj. easily bent, flexible, or adaptable; easily influenced or manipulated; willing to comply or acquiesce

*synonym*: flexible, adaptable, supple

The **pliant** branches of the willow tree swayed gently in the breeze.

#### childlike

adj. resembling or characteristic of a child, particularly in being innocent, trusting, or naive

synonym: innocent, naive, trusting

#### brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

(1) basic **brain** function, (2) permanent **brain** damage X-rays revealed a small tumor in his **brain**.

#### dictate

v. to state or give order with total authority; to say or read aloud for somebody else to write down or to be recorded

synonym: read out, prescribe, order

(1) dictate a letter to secretary, (2) dictate to the associate

The allies **dictated** the terms of surrender to the country.

#### memorize

v. to learn something carefully so that you will remember it exactly

*synonym*: learn, remember, remind

(1) **memorize** musical scores, (2) try hard to **memorize** the lines

Lawyers need to **memorize** even the most minor provisions of the law.

#### nevertheless

adv. in spite of that; yet

synonym: nonetheless, yet, still

(1) keep working **nevertheless**, (2) **nevertheless**, she persevered

She was tired and hungry, but **nevertheless**, she persevered.

# implicit

adj. suggested but not directly expressed

synonym: implied, unstated, hinted

(1) implicit bias, (2) give implicit consent

The **implicit** meaning behind his words was clear, even though he did not explicitly say it.

# explicit

adj. stated clearly and in detail, leaving no room for confusion or doubt

synonym: clear, unambiguous, unequivocal

(1) **explicit** content, (2) **explicit** instructions

The movie had an **explicit** sex scene that some viewers might find offensive.

#### **fundamental**

adj. forming an essential base or core from which everything else develops or is affected

synonym: basic, essential, entire

(1) **fundamental** education, (2) **fundamental** rights Human behavior has **fundamental** characteristics.

# upbringing

 the conditions and experiences in which a child is cared for and taught, especially in relation to their moral and social development

synonym: childhood, background, nurturing

(1) Catholic **upbringing**, (2) family **upbringing**His strict **upbringing** instilled in him a strong sense of responsibility.

#### stake

 a share or financial investment in something such as a business; a wooden or metal post set up to mark something

synonym: share, interest, post

(1) execution by burning at a **stake**, (2) buy the company's **stake** 

The **stake** of the company is too high nowadays.

# aspect

- n. one part or feature of a situation, problem, subject, etc.synonym: characteristic, element, factor
- (1) nontechnical **aspects** of the job, (2) **aspects** of social, political, and economic life

His professional experience includes all **aspects** of media production.

# punctuate

- v. to insert punctuation marks (= comma, period, colon, etc.) in the text; to interrupt periodically
- *synonym*: emphasize, accent, mark
- (1) **punctuate** a sentence, (2) **punctuate** his talk Strikes had also **punctuated** the preceding weeks.

# individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
  As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

#### involve

 to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else synonym: implicate, include, engage

(1) **involve** a lot of paperwork, (2) **involve** a high degree of risk

The investigation **involves** several government agencies and is expected to take several months.

# phrase

a group of words that mean something specific when used together

*synonym*: expression, idiom, term

ready-made phrases, (2) noun phrase
 We bought a Spanish phrase book.

# impose

 to officially force a new law, tax, duty, etc. to be obeyed or received

synonym: charge, levy, foist

(1) **impose** harsher sanctions, (2) **impose** tariffs
The problem with achievement tests is the narrowness they **impose** on students.

# rhythm

 a strong regular repeated pattern of sounds, words, or musical notes that are used in music, poetry, and dancing

synonym: beat, cadence, tempo

(1) in samba **rhythm**, (2) irregular heart **rhythm** He beat out a jazz **rhythm** on the cajones.

#### conform

v. to act in accordance with a set of rules, standards, or expectations; to comply with the norms or customs of a particular group

synonym: comply, follow, adhere

(1) **conform** to standards, (2) **conform** in all its aspects The school requires students to **conform** to a strict dress code.

#### devote

v. to commit or dedicate oneself or one's time, effort, or energy to a particular task or purpose

synonym: commit, dedicate, apply

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(1) devote all of my energies, (2) devote my own life He **devoted** himself to studying the history of ancient civilizations.

# complexity

the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

#### deserve

to be worthy of or entitled to something, especially something good or valuable

synonym: merit, earn, justify

(1) **deserve** respect, (2) **deserve** this prize The employee **deserved** the promotion for their hard work and dedication.

# propose

- to make a proposal, declare a plan for something synonym: suggest, offer, recommend
- (1) **propose** the amendment, (2) **propose** changes I want to **propose** a toast in honor of our longstanding relationship.

#### abolish

- to do away with completely; to put an end to synonym: cancel, repeal, annul
- (1) abolish slavery, (2) abolish censorship The government voted to **abolish** the outdated law.

- (plural of criterion) standards or conditions by which something may be judged or decided synonym: bars, benchmarks, standards
- (1) criteria for action, (2) consistency criteria He didn't meet all the **criteria**, but he was hired anyway.

#### criteria

# suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

# absolutely

*adv.* without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly *synonym*: completely, utterly, definitely

(1) **absolutely** against, (2) **absolutely** obsessed with the girl

I am **absolutely** opposed to his idea because of morality.

# convention

 a large formal assembly of people who do a particular job or have a similar interest or of a political party; something regarded as a normative example

synonym: meeting, conference, congress

convention center, (2) political convention
 They met at biennial conventions.

# mention

- v. to speak or write about something or someone briefly synonym: reference, allude, cite
- (1) **mention** name, (2) **mention** in a report I **mentioned** to him that I had seen his sister at the grocery store earlier that day.

# slightly

adv. in a small degree or extent; a little synonym: barely, narrowly, scarcely

(1) increase **slightly**, (2) **slightly** alkaline soils He moved his body **slightly** to the left.

# thoughtless

 adj. lacking consideration for others; inconsiderate; not reflecting on one's actions or words; showing a lack of thought or intelligence

synonym: unthinking, careless, insensitive

(1) thoughtless comment, (2) thoughtless mistake

The **thoughtless** actions of the students caused damage to the school property.

# insistence

*n*. the act or an instance of demanding or saying something clearly; persistence

synonym: persistence, determination, demand

(1) collective **insistence**, (2) rigid **insistence**Despite her **insistence**, he refused to change his mind.

#### pester

v. to trouble or annoy someone by asking them something repeatedly

synonym: disturb, bother, intrude

(1) **pester** her for a date, (2) **pester** him with complaints Please don't **pester** me with phone calls.

#### index

n. a list of items, such as names, subjects, or keywords, that is arranged in a particular order and is usually found at the end of a book or document; a number or symbol that indicates the value or level of something, such as a stock index or a temperature index

synonym: list, directory, indicator

(1) a full-text **index**, (2) health **index** 

The stock market **index** measures the performance of a group of stocks.

# privilege

 a special right or advantage that only one person or group of people has, usually because they are rich and powerful in a society

synonym: benefit, authorization, advantage

(1) a breach of **privilege**, (2) **privilege** of membership In the Middle Ages, the right to hunt in the wild was the **privilege** of royalty and nobility.

# separate

- v. to force, take, or pull apart; mark as different synonym: disunite, isolate, ramify
- (1) **separate** video into chapter, (2) **separate** cream from milk

We need to **separate** the aspect of his personality from the part of his competence when making an investment decision.

#### brute

 a violent, wild, or feral animal; a person who is cruel, uncivilized, or lacking in intelligence or sensitivity; a physical force or power

synonym: beast, savage, animal

(1) brute beasts, (2) brute force

The **brute** behavior of the football players caused the game to be canceled.

#### educated

adj. having received a high standard of educationsynonym: knowledgeable, erudite, enlightened

(1) educated adult, (2) educated speech

Excellent speech is a characteristic of an **educated** man.

# ignorant

 adj. lacking knowledge or awareness in general; uneducated or unsophisticated; unaware of certain facts or information

synonym: uninformed, uneducated, unaware

(1) **ignorant** remark, (2) blissfully **ignorant**He was **ignorant** of the fact that the meeting had been moved to a different location.

# independence

- n. freedom from another's or others' control or influencesynonym: freedom, liberty, autonomy
- (1) financial **independence**, (2) **independence** ceremony There is nothing more valuable than **independence** and freedom.

# ridicule

n. speech or behavior that makes fun of or mocks someone or something; teasing, sarcasm, or scornful remarks that are intended to belittle or humiliate; (verb) to mock, criticize, or make fun of someone or something in a scornful or derisive way

synonym: derision, mockery, satire

(1) public **ridicule**, (2) **ridicule** at his expense

The **ridicule** from his classmates made him feel embarrassed and ashamed.

# misplace

- v. to put something in the wrong place or lose it temporarily synonym: lose, mislay, misfile
- (1) to misplace the figure, (2) misplace documentsI have misplaced my keys again and need help finding them.

#### context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical **context**, (2) legal **context**It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

# dedicate

 to give all of your energy, time, etc., entirely to a specific person, activity, or cause; to set apart for a particular purpose or use

*synonym*: consecrate, devote, commit

(1) **dedicate** a few hours, (2) **dedicate** a chapter to the subject

He dedicated his life to helping others.

# promote

v. to encourage or persuade people to like, buy, use, do, or support something; to raise someone to a higher position or rank

synonym: boost, raise, advertise

(1) **promote** a better relationship, (2) **promote** bad behavior The government should do more to **promote** sustainable agribusiness.

#### reform

 the act of improving or correcting something that is wrong or bad; a change made to correct a flaw or problem

synonym: change, modify, improve

(1) economic **reform**, (2) **reform** movement

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The government is proposing a **reform** to the healthcare system to make it more accessible and affordable for all citizens.

### obstacle

 a thing that blocks one's way or prevents or hinders progress

*synonym*: hindrance, barrier, block

(1) an **obstacle** to progress, (2) **obstacle** avoidance The **obstacle** course was challenging but fun.

#### transmission

 the act or process of sending something from one person or place to another; the process of broadcasting over the airwaves, as in radio or television

synonym: transportation, communication, broadcast

(1) **transmission** speed, (2) the **transmission** gears of a car

Education is the transmission of civilization.

# spearhead

- v. to lead or initiate an effort or campaign synonym: lead, initiate, begin
- (1) **spearhead** campaign, (2) **spearhead** movement The CEO decided to **spearhead** the new project to ensure its success.

# progression

 the act or process of changing to the next stage or phase or moving forward

synonym: advancement, development, evolution

(1) **progression** of civilization, (2) **progression** of disease The company has made great strides in its **progression** toward sustainability.

#### intimate

adj. having a very close friendship, personalsynonym: close, tight, friendly

(1) my **intimate** affairs, (2) **intimate** relationship He has an **intimate** knowledge of American history.

#### discuss

 to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

synonym: talk about, converse, debate

(1) **discuss** options, (2) **discuss** solutions

We need to **discuss** the next steps for the project during our meeting tomorrow.

# sentimental

adj. connected with or resulting from someone's emotions, rather than reason or realism

synonym: bathetic, drippy, maudlin

(1) in a **sentimental** mood, (2) **sentimental** damage Stop being **sentimental** and always speak the truth.

#### attachment

- n. a feeling of affection for someone or somethingsynonym: adoration, affection, extension
- (1) **attachment** to a formal plan, (2) stand mixer fitted with the paddle **attachment**

I have no attachment to the countryside.

# hassle

- *n.* something inconvenient, annoying, or troublesome; a difficult or irritating experience or situation
- synonym: inconvenience, annoyance, nuisance
- (1) travel **hassle**, (2) **hassle** about money Buying a new car involves a lot of **hassle**, negotiating prices, and trying to get a good deal.

# preference

 a stronger liking or interest for something or someone than another thing or person

synonym: taste, choice, affection

(1) his meal **preferences**, (2) a particular **preference** for Chinese art

Her **preference** is comfortable clothing over fashionable ones.

# argument

 a set of statements or reasons used to support or refute a proposition or theory; a verbal or physical fight or

# dispute

synonym: debate, discourse, discussion

(1) a blazing **argument**, (2) the **argument** against capital punishment

The **argument** between the two sides over the proposed policy was heated.

# giraffe

 a tall African mammal with a very long neck and legs, typically with distinctive brownish-yellow fur and dark patches; an animal often found in zoos and wildlife preserves

synonym: gazelle, okapi, camelopard

(1) giraffe pattern, (2) giraffe exhibit

The **giraffe's** long neck makes reaching leaves high up in the trees easy.

# absolute

adj. perfect or complete or to the most considerable degree possible

synonym: complete, infrangible, indisputable

(1) absolute loyalty, (2) an absolute must

Gandhi had an absolute zeal for nonviolence.

# drastic

adj. radical and extreme; likely to have a significant or far-reaching impact

synonym: extreme, fierce, radical

(1) drastic measures, (2) make drastic revision

The global community is undergoing **drastic** changes at present.

# royal

adj. relating to or belonging to the king or queen or a member of their family

synonym: imperial, noble, aristocratic

(1) a royal palace, (2) prince royal

She is willing to give up her position in the **royal** family to marry him.

# academy

 a school for special training; a type of official organization that aims to encourage and develop standards in its particular field

synonym: school, institute, college

(1) an **academy** of music, (2) a member of the **Academy** Her new documentary earned her an **Academy** Award.

# progressive

adj. relating to or supporting development or advancement, especially social or political one

synonym: advanced, forward-thinking, modern

(1) **progressive** taxation, (2) **progressive** development The **progressive** approach to education emphasizes hands-on learning and student-centered classrooms.

# modify

v. to change something slightly, such as a plan, option, law, etc., especially to make it more suitable for a particular purpose

synonym: adjust, alter, revise

(1) genetically **modify** food, (2) **modify** my behavior We use adverbs to **modify** verbs and adjectives.

#### tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

a tradition of a culture, (2) against tradition
 a tradition in many families to have a big Thanksgiving dinner with all their relatives.

# practical

adj. of or connected with actual use or real situation rather than with theory and ideas

synonym: applicable, functional, realistic

(1) **practical** English, (2) gain **practical** experience Her concept is highly **practical** and helpful.

# geography

 a field of science devoted to the study of the lands, features, inhabitants, and phenomena of the Earth synonym: landscape, terrain, topography

(1) **geography** class, (2) economic **geography** She did well on her **geography** exam.

#### historic

adj. famous or significant in history, or potentially so synonym: memorable, momentous, historical

(1) **historic** accomplishment, (2) achieve the **historic** feat The Chinese people have accomplished several **historic** feats.

#### mod

 a modification or alteration, typically one made to improve something or increase its functionality; a British teenager or young adult in the 1960s, noted for their clothes consciousness and opposition to the rockers

synonym: alteration, modification, tweak

(1) **mod** culture, (2) a house with **mod** cons The **mod** for the video game added new features and improved gameplay.

# symbol

something visible that is used to represent something else

synonym: mark, character, insignia

(1) **symbol** color, (2) **symbol** for happiness The dragon is considered a **symbol** of bravery.

#### stealth

n. the quality of remaining hidden or undetected; the ability to move or act with great secrecy and subtlety

*synonym*: sneakiness, secrecy, furtiveness

(1) stealth technology, (2) stealth bomber

The thief moved with **stealth**, careful not to make any noise and alert anyone to his presence.

# dictionary

 a reference book containing an alphabetical list of words and their definitions, as well as information about their origins, usage, and pronunciation

synonym: lexicon, glossary, vocabulary

(1) dictionary definition, (2) online dictionary

I need to purchase a new English dictionary.

# appropriate

adj. suitable or proper in the circumstances; fitting synonym: fitting, suitable, proper

(1) **appropriate** behavior, (2) an **appropriate** time It would be **appropriate** to dress nicely for the wedding.

# spontaneously

adv. in a way that is natural, not planned or forced, and often sudden

synonym: impromptu, automatically, immediately

(1) recover **spontaneously** after five days, (2) this shift occurs **spontaneously** 

The electrical cord **spontaneously** combusted.

# incorporate

- v. to include something as a part of a larger entity synonym: contain, integrate, amalgamate
- (1) **incorporate** the current trends, (2) **incorporate** technology into daily life

We will attempt to **incorporate** some of your suggestions into our future strategy.

# introductory

adj. intended as an introduction or preliminary; serving as a base or starting point

synonym: beginning, preliminary, initial

(1) **introductory** biology text, (2) product **introductory** sale The **introductory** class was designed to give students a basic understanding of the subject.

# ministry

 a department of government responsible for a particular area of public service

synonym: department, agency, bureau

(1) ministry officials, (2) enter the ministry

The **ministry** of education is responsible for managing the schools in the country.

#### lexicon

 all the words and phrases of a particular language or branch of knowledge, such as nautical or medical

synonym: glossary, dictionary, vocabulary

(1) Greek-English **lexicon**, (2) **lexicon** of business phrases This bilingual **lexicon** was essential for his language improvement.

#### institutionalize

 to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

#### restricted

adj. limited in extent, number, scope, or action, especially by official rules, laws, etc.

synonym: limited, determinate, fixed

# revolutionary

adj. relating to or characterized by a complete or dramatic change

synonym: radical, innovative, groundbreaking

(1) **revolutionary** change, (2) enforce **revolutionary** justice The **revolutionary** leader inspired others to join the fight for freedom and democracy.

#### innovative

adj. introducing or using new methods, ideas, etc.

synonym: creative, ingenious, inventive

(1) use of **innovative** technology, (2) stylistically **innovative** works

The Prime Minister stressed the need to create **innovative** industries.

# impeccable

adj. without flaw or fault; perfect or flawless; incapable of doing wrong or making mistakes; of the highest quality or standards

synonym: flawless, perfect, ideal

(1) **impeccable** reputation, (2) **impeccable** taste His **impeccable** manners and appearance made him stand out from the rest of the guests.

#### slack

 adj. lacking in tension or firmness; loose or not tight; having a relaxed or lazy attitude

synonym: loose, lax, floppy

(1) a slack rope, (2) slack performance

The team's **slack** attitude towards deadlines caused the project to fall behind schedule.

# prioritize

v. to assign a higher level of importance to something compared to other things

synonym: rank, order, arrange

#### communicate

 to share or exchange information with others by speaking, writing, moving your body, or using other signals

synonym: convey, share, transmit
