### quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

(1) easy quitter, (2) serial quitter

He was labeled as a **quitter** after he abandoned the project halfway.

#### firsthand

adv. from the source; directly; (adjective) received directly from a source

synonym: direct

(1) hear customer's voices **firsthand**, (2) conduct **firsthand** research

The manager tried to hear customers' voices firsthand.

#### **kudos**

n. praise, honor, or recognition for an achievement or accomplishment

synonym: acclaim, praise, congratulations

(1) gain kudos, (2) kudos to the team

She received **kudos** from her boss for her exceptional work on the project.

#### innovate

- v. to introduce new methods, ideas, or products synonym: bring in, introduce, found
- (1) **innovate** a new method, (2) **innovate** the quality of his life

Companies developing self-driving cars consistently **innovate** the emerging technologies.

#### contender

n. the contestant you hope to defeat synonym: rival, competitor, challenger

(1) championship **contender**, (2) presidential **contender** 

We were looking at a severe **contender** indeed.

## humility

the quality or condition of being humble; a low estimate of one's self

synonym: humbleness, modesty, unpretentiousness

(1) develop an attitude of **humility**, (2) lack of **humility** We were filled with **humility** at the sight of the Queen.

# proportionate

 adj. having a proper or suitable balance in size, amount, or degree; corresponding or in proportion to something else

synonym: proportional, commensurate, balanced

(1) **proportionate** response, (2) **proportionate** representation

The judge ruled that the punishment be **proportionate** to the crime committed.

#### resilient

adj. able to withstand or recover quickly from difficult conditions

*synonym*: robust, sturdy, tough

(1) a hard and **resilient** steel, (2) **resilient** population
She is a **resilient** person and has always bounced back from setbacks.

### perseverance

 steadfastness in doing something despite difficulty or delay in achieving success

synonym: persistence, tenacity, determination

(1) unwavering **perseverance**, (2) dogged **perseverance**Despite facing numerous setbacks and obstacles, his **perseverance** and determination led him to success.

### intuition

 the ability to understand or know something without reasoning or evidence; a feeling that guides a person to do or believe something without fully understanding why

synonym: instinct, gut feeling, sixth sense

(1) creative **intuition**, (2) **intuition** research
Some studies suggest that people's **intuitions** can be

influenced by their experiences and biases.

### nourish

 to provide a person, an animal, or plant with food to make them grow and stay healthy

synonym: feed, sustain, nurture

#### standstill

 a complete halt in movement or activity, especially due to an obstruction or lack of resources

synonym: halt, deadlock, impasse
