 forestry ecologist studied the interactions between the different species in the forest's ecosystem.

#### dishearten

- v. to cause someone to lose hope, confidence, or enthusiasm; to discourage or demoralize
- synonym: discourage, dismay, demoralize
- (1) **dishearten** employees, (2) **dishearten** the hopeful job applicant

The team's loss in the semifinals did not **dishearten** their determination to return stronger next season.

#### parachute

- n. a device used to slow the motion of people or objects through an atmosphere consisting of a large piece of thin cloth that is attached to them and opens out in the air

#### perpetual

synonym: enduring, unchanging, incessant

#### handout

 giving money, food, or clothing to those who are poor or in need

synonym: contribution, aid, brochure

(1) plead for handouts, (2) three-page handout

#### groundbreaking

adj. producing fresh findings; using novel techniques synonym: innovative, revolutionary

#### cape

synonym: shawl, cloak, mantle

#### nurture

synonym: boost, cultivate, enable
