### brand

 a type of product, service, etc., made by a particular company and sold under a specific name; identification mark on the skin of livestock, criminals, etc., made by burning

synonym: trademark, label, symbol

#### bravo

#### counterculture

### hippie

The fashion of the **hippie** movement included unconventional clothing such as tie-dye shirts and bell-bottom jeans.

### contemporary

# slightly

adv. in a small degree or extent; a little synonym: barely, narrowly, scarcely

### heuristic

# originality

### device

# spindle

- n. a rotating shaft that serves as axes for larger rotating parts; (biology) tiny fibers that are seen in cell division synonym: shaft, axis, mandrel

#### mutilate

### engineer

### define

### politician

### nation

### arctic

 a significant amount of something; the situation in which there is too much of something

#### obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

### meme

### oversimplify

#### mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

#### indicate

v. to show, point out, or make known something, often through a sign or a symbol; to suggest or imply

something without stating it directly

synonym: hint, suggest, show

### triangle

 a three-sided polygon with three angles; something that has three sides or parts

synonym: trilateral, delta, triad

#### strike

- v. to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact upon synonym: hit, impact, influence

### dinosaur

 a large extinct reptile, often with an armored back, long neck, tail, and bony plates on the skin

# identify

 to recognize someone or something and say or prove who or what they are

# biology

 the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

broad

 n. the removal of too many fish from a body of water, causing a decline in population levels and harm to the ecosystem

### headline


