#### **fearless**

adj. having no fear; brave

synonym: brave, courageous, daring

(1) **fearless** attitude, (2) **fearless** bravery

The **fearless** firefighter rushed into the burning building to save a trapped child.

## premed

- (an abbreviation for "pre-medical") a course of study or preparation undertaken by students planning to enter medical school or pursue a career in medicine

  The **premed** student spent hours studying anatomy and physiology to prepare for medical school.

#### dictate

- v. to state or give order with total authority; to say or read aloud for somebody else to write down or to be recorded synonym: read out, prescribe, order

## submerge

v. to put something under water or to go under water; to bury or hide something deeply or completely

synonym: deluge, drench, dunk

The ship was **submerged** in the ocean for many years before it was finally discovered.

## dolphin

 a marine mammal that typically has a beaklike snout, a streamlined body, and flippers and that feeds on fish

## and squid

synonym: porpoise, cetacean, marine mammal

The large group of **dolphins** swam gracefully in the ocean, jumping out of the water now and then.

#### institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

quo

synonym: status, condition, state

## disrupt

synonym: interrupt, disturb, break into
