megacity

- a huge city, especially with a population of more than 10 million people

poverty

eliminate

- v. to remove or get rid of someone or something synonym: wipe out, destroy, eradicate

governor

n. the person who holds the highest executive office in a state or province

synonym: administrator, executive, leader

The state **governor** visited the affected areas and promised to aid the victims.

announce

v. to make something known or officially inform people about something

synonym: disclose, declare, broadcast

demolish

v. to completely destroy or tear down a building, structure, or other entity; to ruin or eliminate the effectiveness or power of something

waterfront

n. the area of land along the edge of a body of water, such as a lake, river, or ocean

settlement

demolition

 the act of destroying or tearing down a building or other structure

synonym: destruction, clearance, leveling

homeless

adj. without a home, and therefore typically living on the streets

synonym: destitute, displaced, transient

surname

n. the family name passed down through generations; a person's last name

When filling out a form, include your full **surname**, not just your first name.

blind

adj. unable to see; unable or unwilling to perceive or understand the true nature of something

synonym: sightless, unseeing, random

(1) **blind** to the beauties, (2) **blind** spot

She was nearly **blind** due to severe diabetes.

basil

 an herb with fragrant, green leaves that is used to flavor many different types of food, especially Italian and Thai cuisine

synonym: herb

(1) freshly chopped basil, (2) basil leaves

The **basil** in the garden was ready to be picked for tonight's pasta dish.

drown

v. to die or cause to die by being unable to breathe underwater

synonym: douse, drench, overwhelm

(1) **drown** in a bath, (2) I was **drowned** in work Floods have the potential to **drown** any subsurface animals easily.

presume

v. to suppose or assume something to be true, often without sufficient evidence or proof; to take liberties, behave impolitely, or overstep one's bounds, often due to arrogance or ignorance

synonym: assume, suppose, guess

(1) **presume** innocence, (2) **presume** on his tolerance I **presume** you've already made plans for the weekend since you didn't respond to my invitation.

grab

v. to take hold of something or someone suddenly with a hand, especially in a violent way

synonym: clutch, snatch, grasp

(1) **grab** an audience, (2) **grab** an opportunity Shall we **grab** a bite to eat?

standing

 adj. existing or remaining upright; having a vertical position; (noun) social, financial, or professional status or reputation

synonym: upright, vertical, (noun) position

(1) standing water, (2) his social standing

The **standing** concert was packed with fans.

shelter

 a structure built to protect from poor weather, danger, or attack; (verb) to protect or shield from harm or adversity, particularly relating to environmental conditions or danger

synonym: refuge, hideout, lair

(1) rainproof **shelter**, (2) anti-air raid **shelter**

They need food and **shelter**.

sand

n. finely granulated particles of rock or mineral material typically found along beaches, deserts, or riverbeds; used in construction, landscaping, and other applications requiring drainage or abrasive action

synonym: grit, dust, powder

(1) sand dunes, (2) sand castle

The **sand** on the beach was warm and golden.

ruin

v. to damage, spoil, or demolish something; (noun) an unrecoverable state of devastation and destruction,

synonym: bankrupt, demolish, destroy

(1) **ruin** the plan, (2) **ruin** the reputation

He knocked over the red wine and **ruined** the tablecloth.

primary

adj. first or highest in rank, order, or importance; most fundamental or essential; pertaining to the initial or introductory stage of something, such as a school year or election cycle

synonym: chief, main, fundamental

The **primary** cause of the accident was due to the icy road conditions.

enthusiastically

adv. in a way that shows intense and eager enjoyment, interest, or approval

synonym: fervently, eagerly, passionately

The study participants **enthusiastically** participated in the discussion, showing genuine interest.

resident

 a person who lives in a particular place or has their home in a place

synonym: dweller, inhabitant, inhabitant

Visa renewal for **resident** foreigners in this country is once every five years.

nowhere

adv. not in, at, or to any place; not anywhere

(1) **nowhere** else to go, (2) come out of **nowhere** I've been thinking all day and getting **nowhere**.

personnel

 a group of people who are employed in an organization or one of the armed forces; the department responsible for hiring, training, and placing employees

synonym: workforce, staff, labor force

(1) competent **personnel**, (2) **personnel** evaluation Please forward the resumes to the **personnel** department.

bullet

- n. a metal projectile that is shot from a gun synonym: projectile, slug, shot
- (1) bullet wound, (2) bullet train

The stray **bullet** went through the window and hit the wall.

construct

v. to build or create something; to assemble or combine different parts to form something whole

synonym: build, assemble, create

(1) **construct** a 3D image, (2) **construct** a dam He **constructs** hypotheses that no mathematician has ever imagined before.

crew

 a group of people who work together, especially on a ship or airplane

synonym: team, group, squad

(1) the film **crew**, (2) the **crew** of a fishing boat

The ship's **crew** worked hard to repair the damaged sails before the next storm hit.

afford

- v. to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something
- (1) **afford** to buy a new car, (2) **afford** a high travel cost He cannot **afford** a holiday.

develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

periwinkle

- n. a small creeping evergreen plant with blue, purple, or white flowers; a type of sea snail with a spiral shellsynonym: periwinkle plant, snail, color
- (1) **periwinkle** plant, (2) **periwinkle** blue I picked some **periwinkles** at the beach and used them for decoration.

estate

n. a large piece of land with an impressive house on it, often owned by a wealthy family; all of a person's possessions and assets at the time of their death; an area of land considered as a unit in terms of ownership, use or taxation

synonym: property, domain, land

The wealthy businessman left his entire **estate** to his children

evict

v. to expel someone from a property, especially with the support of the law

absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly synonym: completely, utterly, definitely

I am absolutely opposed to his idea because of morality.

definition

 a concise explanation of the meaning of a word, phrase, or symbol

synonym: description, connotation, meaning

(1) a precise **definition**, (2) the **definition** of a word Parallel lines are, by **definition**, lines on the same plane that never cross.

slum

 a heavily populated urban area characterized by poor, run-down housing and infrastructure, often associated with poverty and social neglect

synonym: shantytown, slumdwellings, ghetto

(1) slum area, (2) slum dwellers

The government needs to invest more in affordable housing options to reduce the number of people living in **slums**.

organic

adj. of or derived from biological substance; producing plants and animals for food and other items without the use of synthetic chemicals

synonym: biological

(1) organic soils, (2) eat organic food

The kidney is an **organic** component of the body.

acute

adj. extremely sharp or severe synonym: sharp, perceptive, keen

(1) acute pain, (2) acute triangle

The patient died from acute alcohol intoxication.

deficit

the total amount by which money spent is greater than money earned in a particular period of time; the property of being an amount by which something, especially an amount of money, is less than expected or required

synonym: insufficiency, deficiency, shortage

(1) federal budget **deficit**, (2) an accumulative **deficit** Exchange rate fluctuations have increased that country's trade **deficit**.

inequality

 the unfairness of a society in which some people have more opportunity, money, etc. than others; (mathematics) relation between two values when they are different

synonym: imbalance, prejudice, unfairness
