We knocked over a stack of **dominoes** and watched them fall one by one.

gunshot

 the sound or act of firing a gun or other firearm, usually accompanied by a loud explosion and a projectile that is propelled toward the target

synonym: shot, blast, gunfire

(1) gunshot wound, (2) gunshot residue

The loud **gunshot** startled the wildlife in the nearby forest.

overtake

to catch up to and pass by someone or something that is in front of you, usually about moving vehicles; to come to a point where you become more successful, important, or influential than someone or something else

synonym: surpass, outstrip, catch up with

(1) overtake a rival, (2) overtake a milestone

The race car driver knew he had to **overtake** the other drivers to win the race.

spur

 a thing that encourages someone to do something; any sharply pointed projection; (verb) to incite or stimulate someone or something

synonym: encouragement, motivation, stimulus

The threat of losing his job was the **spur** he needed to work harder.

underestimate

synonym: underrate, misjudge, miscalculate

They frequently **underestimated** their abilities and felt inferior.

determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

dorm

 a residence hall or building that provides living quarters for students or other occupants, typically on a college or university campus

synonym: residence hall, hostel, boarding house

Living in a **dorm** can be a great way to meet new people when you're in college.

barefoot

adj. without shoes or other foot coverings; wearing nothing on the feet

synonym: bare, shoeless, unshod

The **barefoot** hiker enjoyed feeling the earth beneath their feet.

enunciate

v. to say, pronounce, or utter words clearly

synonym: articulate, pronounce, say

instruct

v. to teach someone practical skills or knowledge; to formally order or tell someone to do something

synonym: train, coach, guide

The facility manager **instructed** the security guards to be on high alert.

hallway

- an interior passage or corridor onto which rooms open *synonym*: foyer, corridor, entrance
- (1) the head of a hallway, (2) wax a hallway floor He dashed down a **hallway** to a bathroom.
- a tool with a metal blade that is usually attached to a wooden handle and is used for chopping wood or other materials

synonym: hatchet, chopper, tomahawk

to shout in a sudden and loud way

synonym: shout, scream, cry
