## compel

synonym: force, oblige, coerce

(1) **compel** a person to submission, (2) **compel** attention The strict deadlines will **compel** the team to work efficiently.

#### nanoscale

- adj. on a scale that can be measured in nanometres (= one billionth of a meter); on a very small scale
- (1) nanoscale device, (2) things at the nanoscale

This process improves the strength of the metal by controlling the **nanoscale** lattice structure of the metal.

## nanoparticle

- n. a particle of matter that is between 1 and 100 nanometres (nm) in diameter
- (1) aluminum **nanoparticle**, (2) atmospheric **nanoparticle** For some creatures, carbon **nanoparticles** are deadly.

#### confer

- v. to have a meeting or discussion to come to a decision or agreement or exchange ideas; to bestow somethingsynonym: consult, meet, discuss
- (1) confer degree, (2) confer honor

The leaders of the two countries met to **confer** on the issue.

#### toolkit

n. a set of tools, materials, or resources that are designed to be used together for a specific purpose or task; a collection of information or techniques that can be used to address a problem or achieve a goal

synonym: tool set, equipment, utility kit

(1) handy toolkit, (2) digital toolkit

The DIY **toolkit** includes a variety of power and hand tools for home repair.

### empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

## blazing

adj. burning and emitting intense heat and light; powerful and impressive

*synonym*: burning, fiery, scorching

(1) blazing fury, (2) blazing fire

The **blazing** sun beat down on the desert.

#### nanotube

- n. a tube-shaped structure that is composed of very small particles, typically with a diameter of a few nanometers; nanotubes are used in a variety of applications, including electronics and materials science
- nanotube technology, (2) metallic nanotube
   Carbon nanotubes are used in various fields of science and

technology due to their unique properties.

#### medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of diseasesynonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

(1) **medicinal** chemistry, (2) traditional **medicinal**The **medicinal** properties of this herb have been known to help with various ailments.

## double-edged

 adj. having two sharp edges or sides, especially one that can harm or benefit in equal measure; (of sword or blade) having two cutting edges

synonym: two-sided, ambivalent, ambiguous

(1) a **double-edged** compliment, (2) **double-edged** tool

The **double-edged** sword could be used for both offense and defense.

## indefinitely

adv. without any fixed or definite limit; for an unknown or unspecified period of time

synonym: endlessly, permanently, perpetually

(1) postpone a meeting **indefinitely**, (2) **indefinitely** suspended

The construction project has been delayed **indefinitely** due to the pandemic.

## convergent

adj. tending to come together or meet at a point; merging or intersecting; characterized by similarities or commonalities, particularly in different fields or areas of knowledge

synonym: merging, meeting

(1) **convergent** beam, (2) **convergent** thinking The similarities between the two cultures suggest **convergent** evolution.

### compress

 to press or squeeze together to make something take up less space

synonym: condense, constrict, squeeze

(1) **compress** the chest, (2) **compress** gas

She **compressed** the files into a single ZIP archive to save space on her computer.

## smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

#### relentless

adj. persistent and determined; continuing despite difficulties or setbacks

synonym: unyielding, tireless, unremitting

(1) **relentless** attack, (2) face **relentless** pressure The athlete's **relentless** training paid off in the end.

## recognizable

adj. easy to become aware of or identify synonym: noticeable, perceptible, definite

(1) to a **recognizable** degree, (2) **recognizable** landmark His car was easily **recognizable** in the parking lot.

#### innovate

- v. to introduce new methods, ideas, or products synonym: bring in, introduce, found
- (1) **innovate** a new method, (2) **innovate** the quality of his life

Companies developing self-driving cars consistently **innovate** the emerging technologies.

#### conundrum

- n. a confusing and difficult problem or questionsynonym: puzzle, riddle, enigma
- (1) **conundrum** of choice, (2) pose a **conundrum**The group faced a **conundrum** when they couldn't decide whether to go hiking or to the beach.

## undying

- adj. (especially of feelings or beliefs) lasting forever synonym: endless, eternal, immortal
- (1) his **undying** fame, (2) swear **undying** devotion to her He pledged his **undying** love for his wife.

## godfather

n. a male godparent who witnesses a child's baptism and accepts a spiritual responsibility for their upbringing; a trusted mentor or advisor who has significant influence and offers support and guidance in personal or professional matters

*synonym*: sponsor, mentor, protector

(1) political **godfather**, (2) be my **godfather** at my christening

The wealthy businessman acted as a **godfather** to his protege, helping him to succeed in his career.

## betray

- v. to reveal or deliver to an enemy by treachery or disloyalty; to reveal something unintentionally synonym: fail, denounce, display
- (1) **betray** a friend, (2) **betray** confidence He felt **betrayed** when his best friend revealed their secret to the enemy.

## pluck

v. to pull or draw something, especially with sudden force or effort; to strip of feathers

synonym: grab, pull out, pick

(1) **pluck** a gray hair, (2) **pluck** out weeds She **plucked** the flowers off the bush.

#### steer

v. to control the direction or movement of a vehicle; to direct a course of action; to guide or motivate someone

synonym: guide, direct, control

(1) **steer** a steady course, (2) **steer** a conversation The captain told him to **steer** the ship north.
