curve

lifelike

rehearsal

medical

infant

a baby or very young child

suppose

abdomen

n. the part of the body between the chest and pelvis that contains the stomach, intestines, liver, pancreas, and other organs; the posterior part of an insect's body, typically divided into segments

intestine

 a long, tube-like organ in the digestive system that is responsible for absorbing nutrients from food and eliminating waste products

translucent

adv. now or without delay

surgery

bypass

vessel

stake

 a share or financial investment in something such as a business; a wooden or metal post set up to mark something

scenario

a description of possible actions or events in the future;

basis

 the most important facts, ideas, or events from which something is developed; the way how things are organized or arranged

comfort

 a state of physical ease and freedom from pain or constraint

synonym: ease, solace, coziness

(1) words of comfort, (2) comfort level

He found **comfort** in the warm embrace of his loved ones.

pilot

 a person who flies an aircraft, especially as a job; a person qualified to guide ships through a difficult area of water

synonym: aviator, flyer, chief

(1) a test **pilot**, (2) **pilot** production

The **pilot** exercised great care in landing.

crew

 a group of people who work together, especially on a ship or airplane

synonym: team, group, squad

(1) the film **crew**, (2) the **crew** of a fishing boat
The ship's **crew** worked hard to repair the damaged sails

fuselage

 the main body of an aircraft, including the cockpit, passenger compartments, and cargo holds

synonym: body, frame, chassis

environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

importance

- n. the quality of being important and worthy of notesynonym: significance, primacy, matter

evacuate

 to remove people or things from a place of danger or threat; to leave or abandon a place or situation, often due to fear or risk synonym: empty, clear out, vacate

(1) evacuate the building, (2) evacuate civilians

The town was forced to **evacuate** due to the hurricane approaching.

drill

 a tool or machine used for making round holes or driving fasteners; a training or practice

synonym: exercise, routine, training

dime

- an American or Canadian coin worth one-tenth of a dollar
- (1) dime store, (2) behind a dime

compelling

adj. relating to or supporting development or advancement, especially social or political one

bat

n. a nocturnal animal with wings that flies and feeds at night, similar to a mouse; a piece of wood with a handle used for hitting the ball in sports including baseball, cricket, and table tennis

The cave was a habitat for bats.

cage

 a structure made of metal bars or wire in which birds or animals can be kept

pitch

n. the property of sound that varies with variation in the frequency of vibration; the degree of a slope, especially of a roof; short presentation for selling or sharing something

limber

batter

v. to hit something or someone repeatedly with much force; (noun, baseball) a ballplayer who is batting

synonym: beat, pound, strike

pitcher

 a container with a spout used for pouring liquids, particularly used for serving drinks such as water or juice; a player in baseball who pitches the ball toward the batter

synonym: jug, carafe, decanter

(1) baseball **pitcher**, (2) water **pitcher**

When we ordered iced tea, the waiter brought us a **pitcher** full of the beverage.

enlarge

v. to make something bigger or larger; to become bigger or larger

synonym: broaden, increase, widen

(1) **enlarge** a photograph, (2) **enlarge** my experience Please **enlarge** your new theory.

develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

milestone

 an important event or stage in the development or progress of something; a stone by the side of a road to show distances

synonym: landmark, turning point, touchstone

(1) key **milestone**, (2) **milestone** event Reaching the **milestone** of 1000 subscribers on her SNS channel was a major achievement for her.

neurology

- n. the branch of medicine that deals with the diagnosis and treatment of disorders of the nervous system
- synonym: brain science, nervous system, neuropathology
- (1) cognitive **neurology**, (2) **neurology** department She is studying clinical **neurology** to become a brain surgeon.

hydrocephalus

n. a condition in which cerebrospinal fluid (= a clear, colorless fluid that circulates in and around the brain and spinal cord) accumulates in the ventricles of the brain, causing pressure and enlargement of the head; a congenital condition or one that can develop as a result of injury or illness

synonym: water on the brain, cranial swelling

neurosurgery

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop

cerebrospinal

- adj. relating to the brain and spinal cord

shock

 a strong feeling or physical reaction to a sudden and unexpected event or experience, especially something unpleasant

exchange

v. to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

unfortunately

adv. by bad luck; unluckily

synonym: regrettably, unluckily, alas

traffic

n. the movement of vehicles, people, or goods along a route or through a transport system; the amount of such movement in a particular place or at a particular time

synonym: congestion, jam, flow

(1) traffic jam, (2) heavy traffic

We decided to take a detour to avoid the construction **traffic** on the main road.

jam

 a situation in which something becomes stuck because of a dense crowd of people, vehicles, etc.; a preserve of crushed fruit

synonym: difficulty, mess, preserve

accumulate
