#### robotic

## emissary

a person sent on a mission or as a representative of an organization or country

synonym: envoy, ambassador, representative

## recharge

v. to restore the energy or power of something by supplying it with more energy or power; to refresh or renew oneself by rest or sleep

*synonym*: renew, refresh, replenish

## synchronize

#### confuse

#### rove
