#### liberate

v. to set free; to release or rescue from captivity or oppression

synonym: emancipate, release, set free

(1) **liberate** people from oppression, (2) **liberate** potential The prisoners were **liberated** after the war ended.

### anonymous

adj. having no known name, identity, or known source synonym: nameless, unidentified, unnamed

(1) **anonymous** letter, (2) **anonymous** house She received several **anonymous** calls.

### spark

v. to start something or make it grow, especially suddenly; to emit a tiny piece of fire or electricity

synonym: start, inspire, provoke

(1) **spark** his interest, (2) **spark** a chain reaction

The bankruptcy of the giant conglomerate **sparked** turmoil in the stock market.

#### revolution

 a large-scale attempt to overthrow the government of a country, often using violence or war;

*synonym*: coup, innovation, rebellion

(1) beginning of the industrial **revolution**, (2) a political **revolution** 

The **revolution** by the citizen resulted in a redistribution of wealth.

rev

n. a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

synonym: revolution, RPM, speed

(1) low- rev engine, (2) rev up the crowd

He stepped on the gas pedal, and the engine released a loud **rev**.

### exposed

adj. having no protection or shield from something, such as bad weather, attack, or criticism

synonym: endangered, revealed, disclosed

(1) **exposed** to radiation, (2) an **exposed** rock

Tech companies often employ **exposed** ducts and other materials in their office interiors.

### shortcoming

 a lack or deficiency in a particular respect; a fault or defect

*synonym*: deficiency, fault, weakness

(1) have a serious **shortcoming**, (2) the **shortcoming** in the system

The company's main **shortcoming** was a lack of innovation.

### topple

v. to cause to lose balance and fall over, especially by pushing

synonym: overturn, capsize, upset

(1) topple communist rule, (2) topple off a ledge

The statue was old and unstable, so it easily **toppled** over.

#### dictator

 a political leader who has complete power over a country, especially one who has obtained control by force

synonym: autocrat, tyrant, despot

(1) military **dictator**, (2) a **dictator** with enormous powers

A popular uprising led to the overthrow of the **dictator**.

### eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

*synonym*: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

#### flood

a large amount of water flowing beyond its normal limits;
 an overwhelming number or amount

synonym: deluge, downpour, overflow

(1) **flood** advisory, (2) a **flood** of questions

These heavy rains caused flash **floods** on several islands.

### thirst

 a feeling of needing something to drink; a strong desire for something

synonym: craving, desire, appetite

(1) a burning **thirst**, (2) **thirst** for authority

He read books to quench his thirst for knowledge.

### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

### globe

the earth or world, mainly used to emphasize its vastness

synonym: Earth, world, sphere

(1) terrestrial **globe**, (2) around the **globe**. His final goal is to sail around the **globe**.

### frustrate

v. to hinder or prevent efforts, plans, or desires from doing, succeeding, or being fulfilled; to make someone feel upset or annoyed because they are unable to change or achieve something

synonym: hinder, thwart, dishearten

(1) **frustrate** the advancement, (2) **frustrate** other team members

The coach explained a strategy to **frustrate** the opponent's schemes to the players.

### virtual

 adj. being actually such in almost every respect; existing in essence or effect though not in actual fact

*synonym*: practical

(1) a **virtual** image, (2) trading of **virtual** currencies She is the **virtual** president of the company.

#### alternative

- n. one of two or more available possibilities or choice synonym: choice, option
- (1) an **alternative** plan, (2) there is no other **alternative** Doctors are gradually coming around to the idea of using **alternative** medicines.

### apolitical

 adj. not related to or involving politics or political affairs; free from political beliefs, bias, or affiliation

synonym: nonpartisan, impartial, unbiased

(1) **apolitical** stance, (2) **apolitical** organization

The nonprofit organization remains **apolitical** and does not endorse any political candidates.

### aspiring

adj. desiring or striving for recognition or advancement; wanting to be successful in life

synonym: hopeful, ambitious, eager

aspiring prime minister, (2) have aspiring eyes
 He was extremely generous to the aspiring young artist.

#### browse

v. to shop around in a leisurely and casual way; to look through a book, magazine, Internet, etc., casually and randomly, without seeking anything in particular; (of an animal) to feed on plants

synonym: look around, look through, scan

(1) **browse** a website, (2) **browse** through the text We **browsed** in a souvenir shop.

### terrifying

adj. very frightening or intimidatingsynonym: frightening, intimidating, alarming

(1) **terrifying** experience, (2) **terrifying** events Large earthquakes often generate **terrifying** tsunamis.

#### torture

 the act of causing intense pain or suffering to someone to punish them, extract information from them, or for some other reason

synonym: torment, abuse, mistreatment

(1) a **torture** chamber, (2) an instrument of **torture**The use of **torture** is strictly prohibited under international law.

### decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options
   synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

#### fellow

adj. someone who has the same job or interests as you, or is in the same class, profession, or situation as yousynonym: buddy, mate, affiliate

(1) junior fellow, (2) nice fellow

He is the kind of **fellow** who only works for his success.

#### recruit

- v. to persuade someone to work for a company; to find new members for an organization, the armed forces, etc.synonym: raise, enroll, enlist
- (1) **recruit** a good worker, (2) **recruit** a new hire The colonial government **recruited** militia support when civil war broke out.

#### administrator

 a person or organization responsible for managing and directing the affairs of a business, institution, government agency, or other organization; someone who administers, regulates, or supervises

synonym: manager, executive, supervisor

(1) school **administrator**, (2) network **administrator** The university's **administrator** announced new policies regarding campus safety.

### crowdsourcing

- n. the practice of obtaining needed services, ideas, or content by enlisting the services of a large number of people, either paid or unpaid, typically via the internet
- (1) **crowdsourcing** apps, (2) **crowdsourcing** in climate policy

The company used this **crowdsourcing** platform to gather ideas for its next product.

### engaging

adj. attracting, pleasant, or charmingsynonym: alluring, interesting, engrossing

(1) **engaging** story, (2) an **engaging** smile She was disbarred for her **engaging** in fraud.

### regime

 the organization, a system, or method that is the governing authority of a political unit

synonym: administration, establishment, government

(1) a puppet **regime**, (2) exercise **regime**Totalitarian **regimes** are less likely to innovate because they deprive individuals of economic incentives.

fan

a person who admires and supports a person, group,
 sport, sports team, etc.; a device for creating a current of air by the movement of a surface or surfaces

synonym: lover, devotee, blade

(1) a film **fan**, (2) engine cooling **fan** I'm a big **fan** of French food.

### celebrity

*n.* someone who is well-known, particularly in the entertainment industry

synonym: figure, star, VIP

(1) baseball **celebrity**, (2) **celebrity** known worldwide The popularity of the show made her an instant **celebrity**.

flee

v. to leave by running away, especially out of fear or danger

synonym: exit, escape, run away

(1) **flee** their homes, (2) **flee** abroad

It is a basic instinct to **flee** from a dangerous situation.

mount

v. to increase, go up, or advance gradually or continuously; to prepare and supply with the necessary equipment for execution or performance; to ride on something or someone

synonym: climb, increase, get on

(1) **mount** a hill, (2) **mount** a counterattack

They **mounted** pictures on the paper in preparation for the birthday card.

protest

n. a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

(1) hold a **protest**, (2) a silent **protest** 

He left the party in **protest** at its radical political stance.

corruption

*n.* dishonest, harmful, or illegal behavior, especially of people in positions of power

*synonym*: depravity, bribery, degeneration

(1) **corruption** accusation, (2) federal **corruption** charges Rampant **corruption** led to a loss of trust in the government.

injustice

- n. a violation of the rights of others or the laws of a societysynonym: unfairness, bias, discrimination
- (1) gross injustice, (2) injustice system

The injustice of the court's decision angered many people

mjustice

and led to protests.

#### pose

v. to present a risk, problem, or other issues that must be addressed

synonym: present, put, position

(1) **pose** a significant threat to my company, (2) **pose** a challenge

The chemicals **pose** a massive health risk.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

### invitation

 a spoken or written request to participate or be present or take part in something

synonym: request, asking, proposal

(1) a letter of **invitation**, (2) **invitation** of foreign investment I will be very happy to accept your **invitation**.

#### confirm

v. to support or establish the truth or certainty of something previously believed or suspected to be the case

synonym: affirm, verify, assure

(1) **confirm** the diagnosis, (2) **confirm** a transaction Please write to **confirm** your reservation.

### attendance

n. the act of being present at an event or gathering; the number of people present at an event or gathering

synonym: presence, participation, appearance

(1) attendance sheet, (2) low attendance

**Attendance** at the meeting is mandatory for all employees.

#### crucial

adj. extremely vital or necessary

synonym: essential, pivotal, vital

(1) **crucial** information, (2) a **crucial** issue for women The revitalization of technology companies is **crucial** to the country's growth.

#### decentralize

v. to move the power, control, or authority of an organization, government, or system from a single place to several smaller ones

synonym: deconcentrate, disperse, distribute

(1) **decentralize** authority, (2) **decentralize** organizational structure

We need to **decentralize** our data to recover quickly from a disaster.

#### movement

n. a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

(1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

#### barrier

 a fence or other obstruction that makes it hard to move or get in; any condition that makes it difficult to make progress or to achieve an objective

synonym: border, barricade, fence

(1) cost barrier, (2) information barrier

The police placed a **barrier** across the street to halt traffic.

#### announce

v. to make something known or officially inform people about something

synonym: disclose, declare, broadcast

(1) **announce** candidacy, (2) **announce** the award winners. The third season of the anime show has been **announced**.

### consequence

n. the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

(1) unintended **consequences**, (2) the **consequence** of an argument

These economic activities had disastrous environmental consequences.

#### telecom

 n. (a shortened form of telecommunications) the communication of information over long distances through various means such as phones, television, radio, and the internet

synonym: communication, telecommunications, telephony

(1) **telecom** industry, (2) **telecom** service providers The **telecom** company is planning to launch a new smartphone next month.

### midnight

n. the middle point of the night, usually defined as 12:00 AM or the start of a new day

synonym: middle of the night, witching hour

(1) midnight snack, (2) midnight shiftI stayed up until midnight watching my favorite movie.

#### tweet

- n. a short, high sound made by a small bird; a message sent using Twitter, the social media applicationsynonym: peep, chirp, post (on Twitter)
- (1) a chick's **tweet**, (2) his latest **tweets** We could hear the **tweet** of baby birds.

#### pray

- v. to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request synonym: implore, supplicate, entreat
- (1) **pray** devoutly, (2) **pray** for rain
  She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

### government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### massacre

 n. the brutal and indiscriminate killing of a large number of people; a violent and bloody event that typically results in the death of many individuals

synonym: slaughter, bloodbath, butchery

(1) **massacre** in the village, (2) animal **massacre**The **massacre** of innocent civilians in the war zone was a tragic event.

### balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

(1) the **balance** of power, (2) asset on the company's **balance** sheet

Try to keep a balance between work and off.

### surrounding

adj. that is near or around, or closely encircling something synonym: circumferent, encircling, neighboring

(1) **surrounding** areas, (2) a fence **surrounding** a castle The **surrounding** mountains make the city difficult to be invaded.

### paralyze

v. to cause a person or part of the body to become unable to move or feel

synonym: immobilize, disable, numb

(1) paralyze a city, (2) paralyze a person

The venom from the snake bite **paralyzed** his arm.

### kidnapping

 the act of taking somebody away illegally and holding them captive

synonym: abduction, snatch, kidnap

(1) kidnapping attempt, (2) mass kidnapping

She received a year's imprisonment for aggravated kidnapping.

#### handcuff

blindfold

a pair of metal restraints that are designed to lock n. around a person's wrists and prevent them from moving their hands freely; (verb) to restrain or restrict the movement of a person by applying handcuffs, typically as part of an arrest or other security-related process

synonym: shackle, bind, restraint

- (1) handcuff his wrists, (2) break free from handcuffs The police officer put **handcuffs** on the suspect before placing them in the squad car.
- a covering for the eyes used to block out light, particularly one used as a means of sensory deprivation or as a form of punishment or revenge; (verb) to cover someone's eyes with a blindfold or similar material, often as a way of preventing them from seeing something or to make a game or activity more challenging
- (1) **blindfold** game, (2) **blindfold** challenge The doctor administered a **blindfold** test to evaluate the patient's sense of touch.

### terrify

- to frighten someone very much synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify
- (1) **terrify** people, (2) the threats **terrify** him It would be best not to **terrify** your associates into doing complex tasks.

### morgue

a place where dead bodies are kept, particularly in preparation for burial or identification by their relatives or authorities

synonym: mortuary, funeral home, charnel house

(1) clinical **morgue**, (2) overcrowded **morgue** The attendant at the **morgue** was responsible for cataloging the bodies and their respective information.

### disappear

- v. to cease to exist or be visible synonym: fade, evaporate, vanish
- (1) **disappear** without a trace, (2) **disappear** after a week They watched the train **disappear** into the distance.

### colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

(1) collaborate with colleagues,(2) former colleagueI decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

### arrest

v. to take into custodysynonym: capture, detain, imprison

(1) arrest the thief, (2) arrest the progressA police officer has the authority to arrest a criminal.

#### release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) **release** a prisoner, (2) **release** CO2 into the air The animal rights group worked to **release** the dolphins back into the wild.

### inspiring

adj. stimulating and motivating you to want to do somethingsynonym: exhilarating, encouraging, heartening

(1) **inspiring** stories, (2) awe-**inspiring** sight An **inspiring** teacher might spark students' motivation to succeed.

### empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

### utopia

 an ideal and perfect society in which all social and political problems have been solved, and all members live in harmony and prosperity

synonym: paradise, heaven, Arcadia

(1) perfect **utopia**, (2) a **utopia** for an engineer

The concept of **utopia** is often viewed as an impossible or

unrealistic goal, as it goes beyond what is currently possible.

### unfortunately

adv. by bad luck; unluckily

synonym: regrettably, unluckily, alas

(1) **unfortunately** caught in a shower, (2) even more **unfortunately** 

The treatments were done but, **unfortunately**, were unsuccessful.

### punch

v. to strike someone or something with one's fist; to make a hole in something

synonym: hit, strike, slap

(1) **punch** out numbers, (2) **punch** a ticket He **punched** the wall in anger.

gut

n. the long tube in the body of a person or animal through which food passes when it leaves the stomach; the mental strength or bravery required to do something difficult or unpleasant

synonym: belly, abdomen, courage

(1) the blind gut, (2) gut feelings

He told me a gut-wrenching truth about my parent's death.

### euphoria

a feeling of intense happiness, excitement, or delight; a state of extreme joy or pleasure

synonym: elevation, bliss, elation

(1) experience **euphoria**, (2) **euphoria-inducing** drug Winning the lottery brought a feeling of **euphoria** to the lucky winner.

#### fade

- v. to vanish; to fade away; to lose color; to lose freshness synonym: languish, wither
- (1) **fade** away almost completely, (2) **fade** in importance My memory will **fade**, but my heart will live on.

#### consensus

 general agreement or accord in the judgment or opinion reached by a group as a whole

synonym: agreement, accord, harmony

(1) a public **consensus**, (2) **consensus** among scientists The two parties have reached a **consensus**.

### struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

### intense

adj. (especially of a feeling) very strong; extremely sharp or severe

synonym: extreme, fierce, harsh

(1) **intense** heat, (2) develop **intense** itching That statement by the prime minister drew **intense** international criticism.

### polarization

 the division or separation of something into two opposing or contrasting groups or factions; the condition of being polarized or having poles

synonym: polarity, division, separation

polarization effect, (2) dielectric polarization
 The polarization of political views has created a deep divide in the country.

### amplify

- v. to enhance something, particularly sound or brightness synonym: intensify, boost, argument
- (1) amplify a signal, (2) amplify the effect

You might need to **amplify** this point.

#### facilitate

- v. to make something easier or more likely to happen synonym: aid, assist, help
- (1) **facilitate** a smooth transition, (2) **facilitate** the process The company implemented a new software system to **facilitate** employee communication and collaboration.

### misinformation

- information that is false or inaccurate, or the act of giving wrong information, especially deliberately
- synonym: falsity, misreport, misstatement
- (1) **misinformation** about a vaccine, (2) combat **misinformation** on social media

The government called for caution against pseudoscientific **misinformation** about vaccines.

#### rumor

 a piece of unverified information of uncertain origin that is spread by word of mouth

synonym: gossip, whisper, talk

(1) a false rumor, (2) rumor mill

There was a baseless **rumor** that the company was going bankrupt.

### echo

 a sound heard after being reflected off a surface, such as a wall or a cliff

synonym: reverberate, repeat, reflection

the echo of a person's footsteps, (2) sound echo
 thunderous boom echoed throughout the valley.

### chamber

 a large room used for a formal, public, or particular purpose; one of the parts of a parliament

synonym: association, cabin, legislature

(1) a gas **chamber**, (2) the lower **chamber**The surgeon made an incision in the **chambers** of the patient's heart.

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

environment affairs, (2) chaotic environment
 Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's environment.

### purity

 the state of being undiluted or unmixed with anything else; the state of being free from immorality, especially of a sexual nature

synonym: sinlessness, innocence, cleanliness

(1) the degree of **purity**, (2) high **purity** 

Higher **purity** requires additional equipment and energy.

#### toxic

*adj.* of or relating to or caused by a poison; poisonous *synonym*: poisonous, harmful, contaminated

(1) **toxic** molecule, (2) exposure to **toxic** chemicals

This chemical compound is a thousand-fold more **toxic**.

### battleground

n. a place where a battle is fought

synonym: arena, field, theater

(1) **battleground** states, (2) the legal **battleground** The city became a **battleground** during the war.

troll

n. a person who makes inflammatory or off-topic posts on the internet; a supernatural creature often portrayed as a giant or dwarf that lives in isolated areas; (verb) to fish by dragging a baited line through the water behind a boat

synonym: provocateur, antagonist, troublemaker

(1) feed a **troll**, (2) copyright **troll** 

He was banned from the online forum for being a **troll** and causing trouble.

peak

 n. the point to which something or someone is at its strongest, best, or most successful; the pointed top of a mountain synonym: summit, vertex, apex

(1) at **peak** hour, (2) the **peak** current in the circuit This measurement aims to reduce traffic at **peak** periods.

### helpless

adj. unable to take care of oneself or to do things without help

synonym: defenseless, powerless, susceptible

(1) **helpless** baby, (2) **helpless** victims I feel so **helpless** without you.

#### oust

v. to force someone out of a position of power, job, place, or competition

synonym: expel, depose, drive out

oust the chairman, (2) oust him from his post
 Higher capacity storage media have ousted floppy disks.

### democracy

 a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

synonym: self-government, republic, commonwealth

(1) **democracy** advocate, (2) principles of **democracy Democracy** often entails inclusive capitalism as well.

#### elect

v. to choose someone for a specific position by voting for them; to decide or choose to do something

*synonym*: select, choose, prefer

(1) **elect** the school board, (2) **elect** death Every five years, the provincial governors are **elected**.

### president

 the leader of a republic, for example, the US; the person in charge of the organization such as a company, university, club, etc.

synonym: leader, CEO, chairperson

president emeritus, (2) vice- president for finance
 The club president does not have absolute power.

### resignation

- n. an act of giving up or resigning from a job or officesynonym: retirement, termination, withdrawal
- (1) **resignation** letters, (2) **resignation** as prime minister The state legislature demanded his **resignation** immediately.

#### decision

 n. the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

synonym: choice, determination, judgment

(1) decision authority, (2) a selfish decision

She was struggling to make a **decision** between two job offers.

#### silent

*adj.* without any or little sound *synonym*: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) silent reading, (2) give silent consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

#### defeat

- v. to win against somebody in a fight, war, or attempt synonym: conquer, beat, overpower
- defeat a global power, (2) defeat body odor
   Despite his best efforts, he was unable to defeat the enemy.

### primarily

adv. mainly

synonym: largely, mainly, mostly

(1) intended **primarily** for young people, (2) **primarily** affect adults

All peaceful cooperation is based primarily on mutual trust.

### magnify

 to make something look bigger than it really is, especially by looking at it through a lens; to make something bigger, stronger, or louder

synonym: enlarge, elaborate, intensify

(1) **magnify** the danger, (2) **magnify** the image for display Terrorists often attempt to **magnify** the economic impact of their acts of destruction.

### ignore

v. to intentionally not listen or pay attention to synonym: neglect, disregard, shun

(1) **ignore** her advice, (2) **ignore** a ban

Since independence, the area has been completely **ignored**.

### impulse

 a sudden strong and unreflective wish or need to do something; the electrical discharge that travels along a nerve fiber

synonym: stimulation, provocation, urge

- (1) a combative **impulse**, (2) profound religious **impulses**Nerve **impulses** cross a synapse through the action of neurotransmitters.
- someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

(1) art critic, (2) severe critic

Advocates for legal reform hear less harsh words from their **critics**.

### bias

critic

 a strong feeling in favor of or against one group of people, an idea, or thing, often not based on fair judgment

synonym: inclination, partiality, predilection

(1) **bias** against a big company, (2) have a **bias** toward socialism

She researched gender bias in politics.

#### communicate

 to share or exchange information with others by speaking, writing, moving your body, or using other signals

synonym: convey, share, transmit

- (1) **communicate** his anxieties to the psychiatrist,
- (2) **communicate** well with my advisor

Dolphins use sound to **communicate** with each other.

#### mute

adj. silent; not speaking or unable to speak; not expressed or articulated

synonym: silent, unspoken, voiceless

(1) mute button, (2) mute sound

The actor played a **mute** character and had to rely on facial expressions to portray his emotions.
