#### precede

v. to happen or go before something or someone in time or space

#### suspect

- v. to consider anything to be actual or probable
- synonym: assume, distrust, surmise

## spider

 a small, eight-legged creature that spins webs to catch insects as food; a computer program that systematically browses the World Wide Web for purposes of web indexing

synonym: arachnid, wanderer

(1) spider venom, (2) web spider

The **spider** spun an intricate web in the corner of the room.

#### combination

a collection of things that have been combined; an assemblage of separate parts or qualities

synonym: blend, hybrid, compounding

(1) genic **combinations**, (2) **combination** number The **combination** to the safe was a secret.

#### chart

 a visual display of information such as a diagram, lists of figures, etc.; a map designed to assist navigation by air or sea

synonym: diagram, graph, map

(1) a weather **chart**, (2) a statistical **chart** 

This pie **chart** represents our market share.

## inspiration

 something that motivates or encourages someone to create or achieve something, or a feeling of excitement or creativity

synonym: motivation, drive, encouragement

(1) source of inspiration, (2) get inspiration from nature

He found **inspiration** in the works of his favorite authors.

## magnitude

- *n.* the extent, level, importance, or amount of something *synonym*: size, extent, level
- (1) a star of the first **magnitude**, (2) the **magnitude** of the disaster

The **magnitude** of the earthquake was measured at 7.8 on the Richter scale.

#### numerous

adj. amounting to a large indefinite number synonym: many, considerable, countless

(1) **numerous** countries, (2) as **numerous** as the sand These descriptions are based on a number of **numerous** assumptions.

## discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important discovery.

#### reuse

- v. to use something again or more than once synonym: reprocess, recycle, rehash
- (1) **reuse** the materials, (2) **reuse** existing knowledge The supermarket encourages shoppers to **reuse** plastic bags.

#### kitten

n. a young cat

synonym: catling, kitling, puss

(1) kitten formula, (2) newborn kitten

The **kitten's** fur was so fluffy that it looked like it was always moving.

#### essential

adj. indispensable; fundamental

synonym: critical, crucial, basic

(1) **essential** amino acid, (2) **essential** commodities of life Trial and error is an **essential** part of education.

#### estimate

v. to guess or calculate the cost, size, value, etc. of something

synonym: calculate, gauge, evaluate

(1) **estimate** a fair value, (2) **estimate** this chicken to weigh three pounds

We **estimated** the season's total trade deficit at \$50 billion.

## pollinator

n. an animal or insect, such as bees, butterflies, birds, etc., that carries pollen from a male part of a flower to a female part of a flower, fertilizing it and allowing it to produce seeds

*synonym*: fertilizer, pollenizer, pollen carrier

(1) pollinator species, (2) beneficial pollinator

Bees are important **pollinators** for many crops and plants.

#### **fundamental**

adj. forming an essential base or core from which everything else develops or is affected

synonym: basic, essential, entire

(1) **fundamental** education, (2) **fundamental** rights Human behavior has **fundamental** characteristics.

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

*synonym*: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

#### nervous

adj. worried and anxious about something; relating to the nerves

synonym: neural, anxious, uneasy

(1) development of the **nervous** system, (2) get **nervous** He suffers from **nervous** breakdowns.

## animosity

 strong hostility or hatred towards someone or something, often resulting in conflict or ill-will

synonym: enmity, hostility, bitterness

(1) personal **animosity**, (2) deep-seated **animosity**The **animosity** between the two political parties has only grown stronger over the years.

## illuminating

adj. making something clear or easy to understand; providing light

synonym: enlightening, informative, clarifying

#### nowhere

adv. not in, at, or to any place; not anywhere

#### consume

v. to spend something, especially fuel, energy, or time, in a large amount

*synonym*: absorb, ingest, use up

(1) **consume** a large of alcohol, (2) **consume** electricity A smaller car will **consume** less fuel.

#### maintain

v. to continue to uphold or sustain; to keep in a particular state or condition; to assert or declare something to be true

synonym: preserve, uphold, sustain

(1) **maintain** order, (2) **maintain** good health I need to **maintain** my car regularly to prevent any major mechanical issues.

#### defend

v. to protect someone or something from attack, criticism, danger, etc.

*synonym*: protect, guard, support

(1) **defend** my country, (2) **defend** against a threat International law allows each nation to **defend** itself when its rights and interests are illegally violated.

assume

v. to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

(1) **assume** a lousy attitude to his boss, (2) **assume** an important role

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

## reproduce

 to make a copy of something such as a picture, piece of text, music, etc.; to produce offspring through a sexual or asexual process

synonym: duplicate, breed, imitate

- (1) **reproduce** the painting, (2) **reproduce** by myself By dividing and creating copies of themselves, bacteria **reproduce**.
- n. a tiny insect that feeds on the sap of plants and can cause damage or diseases to plants, often found in large colonies

synonym: plant louse, greenfly, blackfly

#### clone

aphid

n. a plant or animal whose genetic information is identical to that of a parent organism from which it was created; an unauthorized copy or imitation

## virgin

 a person who has never had sex; (adjective) being used or worked for the first time

synonym: virtuous, vestal, beginner

#### bush

 a plant growing thickly with many small branches and several stiff stems coming up from the root

*synonym*: copse, scrub, brushwood

(1) trees and **bushes**, (2) a **bush** of hair

I am going to trim this **bush** off.

## sperm

- n. the reproductive cell produced by a man or male animal synonym: seed, semen, seminal fluid
- (1) man with a low **sperm** count, (2) production of **sperm** The male **sperm** fertilizes the female egg.

## compete

 to strive to achieve more success than someone or something

synonym: contend, contest, vie

- (1) **compete** against a friend, (2) **compete** fiercely You must **compete** with others to obtain this position.
- n. a hard, pointed, often curved part that grows on the top
  of the heads of some animals, such as sheep and cows;
  a noisemaker or musical instrument that makes a loud
  noise when you blow through it

synonym: cornet, funnel, alarm

(1) **beetle** brows, (2) a **beetle** larva

#### formidable

#### device

 a piece of equipment, tool, or technology that serves a particular purpose or function, often mechanical or electronic

synonym: gadget, instrument, tool

#### scoop

 a tool for lifting or moving substances in bulk, typically using a concave or spoon-shaped end; a piece of news that is obtained or published before anyone else

*synonym*: ladle, spoon, dipper

(1) a **scoop** of ice cream, (2) **scoop** of news
The company's marketing team worked hard to get the **scoop** on what their target audience wanted.

#### imitate

v. to copy the speech, behavior, appearance, etc. of someone or something

synonym: mimic, emulate, replicate

#### mention

- v. to speak or write about something or someone briefly synonym: reference, allude, cite
- (1) **mention** name, (2) **mention** in a report I **mentioned** to him that I had seen his sister at the grocery store earlier that day.

#### cannibalism

n. the practice of eating the flesh of other people or one's species; a behavior seen in certain animals, especially insects and arachnids, in which one individual consumes another of the same species

synonym: anthropophagy, man-eating

(1) **cannibalism** practice, (2) incidence of **cannibalism** The tribe's religious rituals involved **cannibalism** of their enemies.

#### rampant

 adj. (especially of something bad or unwelcome) flourishing or spreading everywhere in a way that cannot be controlled

*synonym*: prevalent, dense, uncontrolled

(1) **rampant** growth of weeds, (2) **rampant** corruption In an overly protective industry, violations of the ethics rules tend to be **rampant**.

#### dictate

- v. to state or give order with total authority; to say or read aloud for somebody else to write down or to be recorded synonym: read out, prescribe, order
- (1) **dictate** a letter to secretary, (2) **dictate** to the associate The allies **dictated** the terms of surrender to the country.

#### sitcom

 a television or radio program that features a continuing cast of characters in humorous or dramatic situations, typically presented in a half-hour format

synonym: comedy, TV show

(1) <b>sitcom</b> series,	(2) popular <b>sitcom</b>
I love to watch sitc	oms when I need a good laugh.

#### suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

#### dominant

- adj. more important, influential, or easy to notice than anything else of the same type
- synonym: chief, predominant, prevailing
- (1) achieve a **dominant** share, (2) **dominant** force Her company soon won a **dominant** market share.

## aggressive

- adj. behaving in an angry, energetic, or threatening way towards another person; tending to spread quickly
- synonym: assertive, combative, threatening
- (1) an **aggressive** war, (2) an **aggressive** tumor An **aggressive** tide wrecked the ship.

#### coy

- adj. deliberately shy, evasive, or modest, often in a way that is seen as flirtatious or coquettish; unwilling to commit to a course of action or express an opinion
- synonym: bashful, shy, demure
- (1) coy smile, (2) coy behavior

The **coy** mannerisms of the actress only added to her allure on and off the screen.

## katydid

- a giant, green or brown grasshopper-like insect with long antennae and wings, known for its distinctive sound produced by rubbing its legs together
- synonym: bush cricket, long-horned grasshopper
- (1) katydid sound, (2) katydid habitat

The **katydid's** song filled the warm summer night.

#### relative

adj. considered and evaluated through comparison with something else

synonym: comparative, proximate, congeneric

(1) a remote relative, (2) relative factors

Most countries prohibit sexual activity between certain close relatives.

#### cricket

- leaping insect; a game played with a ball and bat by two teams of eleven players
- (1) cricket match, (2) a pine cricket

The sound of the **crickets** chirping filled the air on a warm summer evening.

## grasshopper

 large jumping insect; used to symbolize restlessness or ephemerality

synonym: locust, katydid, cricket

(1) grasshopper mice, (2) grasshopper species

The **grasshopper** leaped from one blade of grass to another.

## picky

adj. overly particular or selective, especially about food or other consumable goods; difficult to please or satisfy because of one's specific tastes or preferences

synonym: fussy, choosy, particular

(1) **picky** personality, (2) **picky** about details

My **picky** eater only likes to eat certain types of vegetables.

#### transfer

v. to move, pass, or change from one person, place, or situation to another

synonym: move, relocate, shift

(1) transfer a file, (2) transfer power

She **transferred** the money from her savings account to her checking account.

adj. relating to a wedding, marriage, or marital union; being used or done as part of a wedding ceremony

synonym: bridal, matrimonial, marital

(1) nuptial vow, (2) nuptial knot

The bride wore a stunning **nuptial** gown on her wedding day.

#### nuptial

### panel

n. a square or rectangular and flat piece of something that forms a distinct section or component of something; a small group of specialists who discuss particular topics or give their advice or opinion about something

*synonym*: board, commission, discussion

(1) panel discussion, (2) cost of solar panels

A **panel** of economic advisers from the United States visited the country to help rebuild its economy.

## appendage

 a part attached to the main body or structure, often with a specific function or purpose; a limb or other body part that projects outward from the main body

*synonym*: extension, limb, attachment

(1) spiny **appendage**, (2) mechanical **appendage** 

The spider's appendage allowed it to climb up the wall easily.

## blob

 a small amount or drop of a thick liquid or sticky substance

synonym: chunk, lump, hunk

(1) a big **blob** of yellow, (2) a **blob** of jelly

A **blob** of ink fell on the floor.

#### manufacture

v. to make goods in large numbers, usually in a factory using machines

synonym: create, fabricate, assemble

(1) **manufacture** an enzyme, (2) **manufacture** a product The majority of synthetic vitamins are **manufactured** from oil.

weigh

v. to have a particular weight; to carefully evaluate things before making a conclusion

synonym: consider, cogitate, count

(1) **weigh** heavily on stock prices, (2) **weigh** a cargo The baby **weighs** 1 pound 3 oz.

#### mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

synonym:

abundance, crowd, mob

(1) a **mass** of molten rock, (2) critical **mass**The **mass** of people who do not own property is politically impotent.

#### pause

 to take a short break from talking or doing something before continuing

*synonym*: halt, break, intermit

(1) **pause** a moment, (2) **pause** for a reaction The man **paused** before opening the door.

## pound

- the standard unit of money in the UK; the standard unit of weight equal to 16 ounces
- (1) three-fourths of a **pound**, (2) thousands of **pounds**. The car's front bumper cost fifteen hundred **pounds**.

#### drain

- v. to empty or dry something by removing the liquid from it synonym: draw off, bleed
- (1) **drain** water from the swamp, (2) **drain** excess liquid Push the button and let the water **drain** away.

#### fertilize

- v. to cause an egg, female animal, or plant to develop by joining sperm from the male with them; to add a natural or chemical substance to land to make plants grow well synonym: pollinate, inseminate, enrich
- (1) **fertilize** the soil, (2) **fertilize** the female egg The couple decided to use the non-husband sperm to **fertilize** a wife.

## competitive

- *adj.* involving competition or competitiveness *synonym*: aggressive, ambitious, militant
- (1) a **competitive** price, (2) **competitive** position The mobile application industry is a **competitive** one.

## attempt

*n.* an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

(1) the **attempt** to rescue the hostages, (2) a reckless **attempt** 

The third **attempt** was far more successful.

#### stereotype

- n. a fixed and unvarying idea or image that people have about what someone or something is like, but which is often not true in reality and may cause hurt and offense
- avoid stereotype,
   negative stereotypes
   changing stereotypes about LGBTQ requires considerable effort.

#### wasp

 a flying insect with a narrow waist and a sting, typically feeding on nectar and known for its aggressive behavior towards other insects and animals

synonym: insect, hornet, yellow jacket

(1) wasp nest, (2) wasp sting

A giant wasp flew into the room, and everyone panicked.

#### ant

 a very small insect that lives under the ground or in a mound in highly organized groups

*synonym*: pismire, insect

(1) a white ant, (2) ant bite

We can find many large ant mounds in this area.

#### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
  As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

flit

v. to move quickly and lightly from place to place, often without purpose or direction; to flutter or dart quickly, like a bird or insect

synonym: flutter, dart, skim

(1) flit away into the darkness, (2) flit from place to place

The butterfly would **flit** from flower to flower, collecting nectar.

### millennium

- n. a span of 1000 years, or the 1000th anniversary (plural: millennia)
- (1) past **millennium**, (2) **millennium** bottle of wine Our world is in the third **millennium**.

#### ancient

adj. relating to the long ago, particularly the historical period preceding the fall of the Western Roman Empire; very old

synonym: archaic, age-old, obsolete

(1) pre-Christian **ancient**, (2) **ancient** stories

They have been living near water since **ancient** times.

#### drone

 a low continuous humming noise; someone who takes more time than necessary; a pilot-less aerial vehicle that is operated by remote control

synonym: hum, whirr, idler

(1) drone flight, (2) the speaker's drone

He heard a **drone** of sirens roar from the neighboring town.

## disapprove

v. to have or express an unfavorable opinion or judgment about something or someone

synonym: object, reject, condemn

(1) **disapprove** of the government, (2) publicly **disapprove** I **disapprove** of my friend's decision to drop out of school and pursue a career in music instead.

hive

 a structure for the reception and habitation of bees, either built by people or made by the bees themselves; a place swarming people

synonym: apiary, swarm, pack

(1) honeybees in hives, (2) a hive of activity

Bees were buzzing around the hive

#### flee

v. to leave by running away, especially out of fear or danger

synonym: exit, escape, run away

(1) flee their homes, (2) flee abroad

It is a basic instinct to **flee** from a dangerous situation.

## participate

v. to take part in something

synonym: take part, partake, enter

(1) **participate** fully in conversation, (2) **participate** in the program

The majority of students actively **participated** in the college's intramural sports program.

#### nectar

 a sweet liquid produced by flowers that attracts and provides food for bees and other insects; any sweet liquid that is enjoyed as a drink or used as a flavoring

*synonym*: honey, ambrosia, syrup

(1) **nectar** of the gods, (2) fruit **nectar** 

The **nectar** of the flowers attracted many bees to the garden.

## pollen

 a fine powder substance consisting of microscopic grains produced by plants that facilitate their reproductive process through the process of pollination

synonym: dust, spores, allergen

(1) **pollen** allergy symptoms, (2) high **pollen** count My allergies flare up during **pollen** season, making it difficult to breathe.

#### confusion

 the state of being mixed up or unclear, or the state of disorder or uncertainty

synonym: disorder, disarray, chaos

(1) administrative **confusion**, (2) in great **confusion**The sudden policy change has caused **confusion** among employees.

#### sting

v. to cause a sharp, painful sensation or injury with a poison, venom, or other substance or by a physical action such as a bite or prick

synonym: bite, prick, poke

(1) **sting** me on the arm, (2) **sting** his face
Bees **sting** as a defense mechanism when they feel threatened.

#### bore

v. to make someone feel weary or uninterested, often by talking at length about uninteresting or mundane topics; to cause someone to feel bored or unengaged; (noun) a hole or tunnel drilled or dug into the ground, either for exploration or extraction of natural resources

synonym: bear, tire, weary

- (1) **bore** diameter, (2) **bore** him with his stories

  The lecture on quantum physics **bored** me to tears.
- v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something elsesynonym: implicate, include, engage
- (1) **involve** a lot of paperwork, (2) **involve** a high degree of risk

The investigation **involves** several government agencies and is expected to take several months.

#### confuse

involve

v. to mistake one thing for another; to make somebody hard to understand

synonym: confound, obscure, disorient

(1) **confuse** the listener, (2) **confuse** fantasy with reality Her remarks **confused** the debate.

### colony

 a country or an area that is governed by a more powerful country that is often far away

*synonym*: settlement, territory, plantation

(1) plant a **colony**, (2) a **colony** of bacteria The **colony** declared its independence and became a republic.

#### conclude

v. to come to an end or close; to reach a judgment or opinion by reasoning

synonym: complete, finish, decide

(1) **conclude** a meeting, (2) **conclude** that he is healthy We **concluded** a cease-fire.

#### far-fetched

adj. (of an idea or story) so exaggerated or ludicrous as to be very difficult to believe

#### instance

## jaw

 either of the two bones at the bottom of the face that moves when you open your mouth; (verb) talk socially without exchanging too much information

synonym: mouth, (verb) chitchat

(1) snatch victory from the **jaws** of defeat, (2) **jaw** muscle He dropped his **jaw** at the unexpected sight.

## portray

 to depict or describe someone or something in a painting, film, book, or other artistic work

synonym: depict, describe, illustrate

(1) **portray** feelings in words, (2) accurately **portray** the condition

We often **portray** political problems as religious issues.

#### fiction

 the type of book or story, especially novels, that describes imaginary events and people; anything made up or imagined that is not true

synonym: fantasy, fable, invention

(1) stuff of science **fiction**, (2) non- **fiction** bestseller Truth is stranger than **fiction**.

## implication

 something that is inferred or indirectly stated; the act or fact of being involved in something

synonym: suggestion, association, conclusion

(1) the **implication** in a crime, (2) the **implication** of a word His poem has a very significant **implication**.

#### medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of disease synonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

(1) **medicinal** chemistry, (2) traditional **medicinal**The **medicinal** properties of this herb have been known to help with various ailments.

#### aspect

- n. one part or feature of a situation, problem, subject, etc. synonym: characteristic, element, factor
- (1) nontechnical **aspects** of the job, (2) **aspects** of social, political, and economic life

#### creature

- n. a living being, especially an animal synonym: being, animal, organism

#### stand-in

 a person or thing that acts as a substitute, replacement, or temporary assistant for someone or something else; a double or understudy for a performer or actor

synonym: substitute, replacement, understudy

(1) **stand-in** teacher, (2) use a **stand-in** in an exam The company hired a **stand-in** for the CEO for the shareholder meeting.

norm

- n. something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standard synonym: criterion, mean, standard
- (1) **norm** of action, (2) cultural **norm**The systems we have developed has accepted as industry **norms**.

variant

 something that is slightly different from others of the same type

synonym: variation, modification, variance
