## injury

#### decision

 the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

#### visa

n. an endorsement or authorization placed in a passport or travel document that allows the holder to enter or leave a particular country for a specific period of time; the process of applying for and obtaining such authorization

## complicated

## smuggle

 the last day of the world when Christians believe that God will judge everyone; an unpleasant or disastrous event

synonym: Day of Judgment, Last Judgement

pump

motor

## whistle

adj. afraid or frightened

jetty

n. a structure built out into the water from a shore or riverbank, typically using wooden or stone pilings, to provide a landing place or to protect a harbor or shoreline from erosion; a walkway or platform over the water, often used for recreational or fishing purposes

synonym: pier, dock, breakwater

(1) wooden jetty, (2) fishing jetty

coconut

- the large, hard-shelled seed of a tropical palm, which has a fibrous husk surrounding a single-seeded nut

hail
