# cyberspace

 the electronic space where computer-mediated communication and interactions occur often used to refer to the internet or virtual reality environments

synonym: Internet, virtual reality, online world

(1) **cyberspace** security, (2) virtual **cyberspace**Hackers are constantly trying to exploit vulnerabilities in **cyberspace** for their gain.

#### homesick

adj. feeling sad or nostalgic for one's home, family, or familiar surroundings, especially when away from them for a significant length of time

synonym: nostalgic, longing, yearning

(1) suffer from **homesick**, (2) **homesick** for home The military personnel stationed overseas often feel **homesick** for their loved ones.

# empathy

n. the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation

synonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

(1) full of empathy, (2) empathy for patientsEmpathy is also necessary to understand history.

#### blockbuster

 a movie, book, or other product that is extremely successful and popular, especially one that makes much money

synonym: hit, success, smash

(1) **blockbuster** movie, (2) international **blockbuster**The new action movie is expected to be a **blockbuster** hit.

brow

- n. the ridge over the eye sockets; the foreheadsynonym: forehead, hilltop, eyebrow
- the **brow** of a hill, (2) furrowed **brow** wiped the sweat from her **brow** after finishing the

#### **furrow**

 a long and narrow groove or trench, typically made in the ground by a plow or a person's fingers; a wrinkle or groove on a person's face

synonym: groove, trench, rut

(1) ploughed furrow, (2) narrow furrow

The farmer plowed deep **furrows** in the field before planting his crops.

# eyebrow

- n. the hair arc over each eye in humans
- synonym: brow, supercilium
- (1) raise her **eyebrows**, (2) **eyebrow** cosmetics She raised an inquiring **eyebrow** towards me.

#### wrinkle

- a small line or fold in something, especially fabric or the skin of the face; a minor difficulty
- synonym: crinkle, fold, crumple
- (1) a fine **wrinkle** on a fabric, (2) a facial **wrinkle** This suit is made of **wrinkle-proof** material.

#### **smirk**

- v. to smile in a way that suggests one is pleased or amused by someone or something, often in a smug or self-satisfied manner
- *synonym*: grin, sneer, simper
- (1) **smirk** confidently, (2) **smirk** after playing a prank He couldn't help but **smirk** when he heard her absurd excuse.

#### poke

- v. to push or prod with a sharp object or the finger synonym: prod, jab, push
- (1) **poke** around the desk, (2) **poke** a fire They **poked** fun at each other's jokes, laughing and teasing.

# frown

 to make an angry or severe expression by bringing your eyebrows together to indicate disapproval, displeasure, or concentration synonym: scowl, glare, disapprove

(1) people with **frown** faces, (2) a worried **frown** Thinking always made him **frown**.

# portray

v. to depict or describe someone or something in a painting, film, book, or other artistic work

synonym: depict, describe, illustrate

(1) **portray** feelings in words, (2) accurately **portray** the condition

We often **portray** political problems as religious issues.

# disgust

- n. a strong feeling of dislike or disapprovalsynonym: nauseate, hate, dislike
- public disgust, (2) show disgust at his actions
   He was filled with disgust and fear for the threat of war.

#### valence

n. (of chemistry and physics) the bonding capacity or electron-attracting power of an atom or molecule; (of psychology and sociology) the emotional value or intensity involved in a particular experience or relationship

synonym: bonding capacity, reactivity

(1) valence electrons, (2) chemical valence

The valence of an atom determines its chemical properties.

#### amass

v. to accumulate or gather a large quantity of something over time; to collect or assemble for future use or reference

synonym: gather, collect, accumulate

(1) **amass** a patent portfolio, (2) **amass** followers She had **amassed** a fortune through wise investments and shrewd business decisions.

quantify

- v. to express or measure something in numerical terms synonym: measure, express, determine
- (1) quantify the results, (2) quantify blood flowHe tried to quantify the amount of product that was needed

to complete the job.

#### emote

 to communicate through facial expressions, gestures, and body language to express strong feelings or emotions

synonym: express, communicate, convey

(1) **emote** salute, (2) **emote** through art

The actor could **emote** a wide range of emotions on screen, earning them critical acclaim.

# empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

# impair

- v. to damage something or make it weaker or worse synonym: degrade, mar, deface
- (1) **impair** my health, (2) **impair** insulin sensitivity The accident made his vision **impaired**.

# app

 n. (abbreviation for application) software designed to run on smartphones and other mobile devices or inside a web browser on a PC

synonym: application, software

(1) killer app, (2) cannot log in to the app

The discovery of a critical bug caused the company to delay the **app's** release.

#### wristwatch

 a small timepiece designed to be worn on the wrist typically comprised of a strap or bracelet and a clock face with hour, minute, and sometimes second hands

synonym: watch, timepiece, wristlet

(1) quartz wristwatch, (2) classic wristwatch

I received a beautiful wristwatch as a graduation gift from

my parents.

# binge

 a period of excessive or uncontrolled consumption, often of food or alcohol; a spree or bout of reckless behavior or indulgence

synonym: spree, overindulgence, splurge

(1) binge on social media, (2) alcohol binge
She stayed up all night binge-watching her favorite TV show.

# outweigh

v. to be heavier, more significant, or more critical than something

synonym: dominate, outrank, overpower

(1) **outweigh** the benefit, (2) **outweigh** our wishes The advantages would undoubtedly **outweigh** the disadvantages.

#### reclaim

v. to take back something previously lost, given, or paid, or ask to have it back

synonym: recoup, regain, retake

(1) **reclaim** a competitive position, (2) **reclaim** land from the sea

You may be entitled to reclaim some tax.

# opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

#### reimagine

v. to imagine or conceive of something in a new or different way

synonym: re-conceptualize, re-envision, re-create
