#### shockwave

n. a wave or series of waves produced by a sudden disturbance, such as an explosion or a supersonic flow, capable of producing significant changes in pressure, temperature, and density of the medium through which it travels

#### translate

#### context

#### simultaneous

### develop

#### instantaneous

# microphone

# expand
