devolve

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

interpersonal

adj. connected with relationships between people synonym: social

kindergarten

 a school or class for young children, usually between the ages of four and six

synonym: preschool, nursery school, daycare

plumber

 a person who installs and repairs the pipes and fixtures of a water supply, heating system, or drainage system

disagree

advance

- v. to go or move forward; to develop in a positive way synonym: progress, boost, come along
- (1) **advance** the technology, (2) **advance** a cooperative relationship

Scientific knowledge will **advance** significantly with the power of AI.

nod

v. to lower and raise one's head, sometimes several times, as to show approval, agreement, greeting, or confirmation

synonym: respond, acknowledge, greet

(1) **nod** at each other, (2) **nod** courteously

She **nodded** quietly in response to the question.

summarize

v. to give a brief statement of the most important facts or ideas about something

synonym: recap, outline, digest

(1) **summarizes** the main ideas, (2) **summarize** text Each chapter **summarizes** the most critical issues.

bore

v. to make someone feel weary or uninterested, often by talking at length about uninteresting or mundane topics; to cause someone to feel bored or unengaged; (noun) a hole or tunnel drilled or dug into the ground, either for exploration or extraction of natural resources

synonym: bear, tire, weary

- bore diameter, (2) bore him with his stories
 The lecture on quantum physics bored me to tears.
- v. to cause someone to feel upset, angry, or annoyed synonym: insult, hurt, anger
- (1) **offend** his sensibilities, (2) **offend** a customer His rude comments **offended** many people at the party.

engage

offend

- v. to attract and keep someone's attention and interest; to participate in or obtain services of somethingsynonym: confront, employ, amuse
- (1) **engage** in environmental protection activities,
- (2) engage a new employee

Many multinational companies are **engaged** in the reconstruction of that country.

inspire

interaction

multitasking

tablet

pundit

boring

adj. lacking interest or excitement; tedious or dull synonym: dull, tedious, monotonous

abortion

the intentional termination of a pregnancy at an early stage

synonym: miscarriage

(1) **abortion** doctor, (2) the highly charged issue of **abortion**

We strongly oppose the abortion ban.

corporation

 a large company or group of companies that are controlled together by law as a single unit

synonym: business, company, enterprise

(1) a public **corporation**, (2) **corporation** assets Four companies were amalgamated into a single **corporation**.

predictable

adj. capable of being known, seen or declared in advance synonym: foreseeable, expectable, likely

(1) **predictable** pattern, (2) in a **predictable** manner The economy becomes more volatile and less **predictable**.

assume

to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

(1) **assume** a lousy attitude to his boss, (2) **assume** an important role

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

fame

the condition of being well-known and discussed by a large number of people as a result of one's accomplishments, abilities, and so on

synonym: celebrity, renown, stardom

therapy

the act of caring for someone through medication, n. remedial training, etc.

synonym: antidote, medicine, treatment

peck

to strike or bite someone or something repeatedly, usually with the beak or bill; to give a quick, small kiss or nibble

vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

recess

a period of time when the members of a parliament,
 committee, etc., are adjourned; a short break in a trial in court

synonym: break, interval, pause

(1) a court recess, (2) during noon recess

The company decided to take a **recess** and reconvene the meeting later that day.

open-ended

 adj. without any limits or restrictions; allowing for a spontaneous response

synonym: unlimited, unrestricted, flexible

Most people who saw the film were dissatisfied with the **open-ended** ending.

cue

 a signal, gesture, or action that provides information or direction for someone else to act or respond; a reminder or prompt for someone to do something

synonym: signal, sign, hint

journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

synonym: reporter, newsperson, press

(1) a China-based **journalist**, (2) **journalist** on a magazine Foreign TV crews and **journalists** can go as they please in various locations during the Olympics.

complicated

adj. involving a lot of different things or parts in a way that is difficult to understand or analyze

synonym: complex, convoluted, intricate

(1) a **complicated** process, (2) become increasingly **complicated**

He did complicated pen-and-ink drawings in just a few days.

terrify

- v. to frighten someone very much
- synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify
- (1) terrify people, (2) the threats terrify him

It would be best not to **terrify** your associates into doing complex tasks.

nowhere

bound

adv. not in, at, or to any place; not anywhere

- (1) **nowhere** else to go, (2) come out of **nowhere** I've been thinking all day and getting **nowhere**.

v. to move forward by leaps and bounds; to form the boundary of something

synonym: jump, bounce, leap

(1) **bounded** with delight, (2) **bound** up a staircase Canada **bounds** on the United States.

determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

claim

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to claim ownership of the abandoned property.

err

v. to make a mistake or error; to stray from accuracy or

correctness; to be mistaken or incorrect

synonym: mistake, blunder, slip

(1) err in decision-making, (2) err on the side of caution

He did not want to **err** in his judgment, so he double-checked all the facts before making a decision.

caution

 great care and attention that you take to avoid danger or mistakes; a warning against certain acts

synonym: carefulness, warming, notice

(1) extreme caution, (2) act with caution

He gave a stern **caution** to the naughty student.

equate

v. to consider or describe one thing as similar, equal, or analogous

synonym: associate, liken, relate

(1) **equate** mistakes with failure, (2) **equate** to legal responsibility

It isn't very reasonable to **equate** money with happiness.

individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
 As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

(1) **amazing** advances, (2) the most **amazing** feeling The golfer recorded an **amazing** distance.

suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

hawk

 a bird of prey typically having short rounded wings and a long tail; an advocate of an aggressive policy on foreign relations

synonym: militarist, jingo, aggressor

(1) cast off a **hawk**, (2) congressional **hawk**

That team signed a center forward who was a ball- hawk.

brag

v. to say something in a boastful manner, to impress others, or make oneself feel superior

synonym: boast, swagger, vaunt

promote

v. to encourage or persuade people to like, buy, use, do, or support something; to raise someone to a higher position or rank

condescending

adj. having or showing a feeling of superiority; patronizing *synonym*: patronizing, superior, haughty

rephrase

v. to express or state something in a different or alternative way, usually to make it clearer, easier to understand, or more appropriate for a particular context or audience

- a wild plant growing where it is not wanted and in competition with cultivated plants

weed

synonym: plant, grass, shrub

frank

adj. honest and sincere; open and candid in expression synonym: candid, direct, freehearted

(1) **frank** and open discussion, (2) make a **frank** apology Full involvement means **frank** and prompt responses.

struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

develop

paraphrase

He **paraphrased** the article in his own words to avoid being accused of plagiarism.

bolster

v. to support or strengthen, often by adding extra assistance or resources

identity

distracted
