hallucinate

- v. to experience a seemingly real perception of something that does not actually exist, usually as a result of a mental illness or drug use

introspect

v. to look inward and examine one's thoughts, feelings, or motives; to engage in self-reflection

platonic

adj. (of relationship or emotion) friendly or affectionate but not sexual

synonym: nonphysical, nonsexual, spiritual

introspective

 adj. characterized by a tendency to reflect on one's thoughts, feelings, and actions, often with a deep or philosophical level of analysis and introspection

synonym: thoughtful, reflective, contemplative

(1) **introspective** thoughts, (2) **introspective** personality His poetry was deeply **introspective**, exploring themes of identity, loss, and the human condition.

logarithm

 a mathematical function that indicates the power to which a fixed number (the base) must be raised to produce another given number expressed as an

exponent

synonym: mathematical function, exponent, power

To solve this equation, you must take both sides' logarithms.

astronomical

 adj. relating to astronomy or the study of celestial bodies and phenomena; very large or immense in scale or magnitude

synonym: huge, vast, enormous

trajectory

the curved path followed by an object moving through space

synonym: course, curve, orbit

synonym: instinct, gut feeling, sixth sense
