leash

 a long, flexible cord or chain used to restrain or control a dog (or other animals); a figurative tool used to control or limit someone's behavior or actions

synonym: tether, lead, restraint

(1) dog leash, (2) walk on a leash

Make sure to put the **leash** on your dog before walking.

shove

- v. to push someone or something in a rough way synonym: push, jab, elbow
- (1) **shove** a person aside, (2) **shove** hamburger into my mouth

He forcibly **shoved** the flyer into my bag.

homologous

 adj. having the same or similar structure, position, or function, particularly in different species or organisms; related by common ancestry

synonym: corresponding, analogous, similar

(1) **homologous** genes, (2) **homologous** structures **Homologous** recombination is a process that can occur during DNA repair.

diploid

 adj. relating to a cell or organism with two complete sets of chromosomes (= long, thread-like molecules made of DNA and proteins); (noun) cells that contain two complete sets of chromosomes, one from each parent

synonym: doubled, matched, paired

(1) diploid nuclei, (2) diploid organism

The **diploid** cells contain two sets of chromosomes, one from each parent, allowing for genetic variation.

hijack

v. to seize control of an airplane or other vehicle during an operation, especially with violence

synonym: commandeer, seize, pirate

(1) hijack a helicopter, (2) hijack a phone number
He made a desperate effort to hijack an airliner.

synonym: pollute, contaminate, affect

flashy

drown

to die or cause to die by being unable to breathe underwater
