punctuate

ν. to insert punctuation marks (= comma, period, colon, etc.) in the text; to interrupt periodically

dieresis

 a mark (") placed above a vowel, typically to indicate that it should be pronounced separately from the preceding vowel, creating a separate syllable

synonym: umlaut

The word "naïve" is an example of a **dieresis** used in English to indicate that the two vowels should be pronounced separately.

dot

naive

expel

string

excess

synonym: exuberance, glut, surplus

advertise

 to draw attention to something such as a product, service, or event in public to encourage people to buy, use, or attend it

synonym: publicize, announce, promote

oversight

 the act of supervising or watching over something; a mistake caused by not paying enough attention to something

synonym: supervision, monitoring, failure

(1) environmental **oversight**, (2) **oversight** committee Due to careless **oversight**, the product was not inspected before it was shipped to the customers.

loyal

adj. giving or remaining firm and constant support to a person, institution, product, etc.;

synonym: dedicated, devoted, faithful

(1) a **loyal** friend, (2) become a **loyal** customer Enemy armies are **loyal** to their monarch.

divulge

v. to reveal or make known something that was previously secret or confidential; to disclose information that was previously concealed or hidden

synonym: reveal, disclose, expose

reputation

 the general opinion that people have about someone or something, especially when this is based on their previous experiences or behaviors

stern

dock

a structure or platform that extends from the shoreline into a body of water, used for loading and unloading ships or boats; an enclosed area of water used as a basin for shipping or pleasure boats; a place where a ship can be repaired or maintained

synonym: harbor, pier, quay

slope

a surface with one end or side that is higher than the other

lean

yore

decide

- to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

confer

- to have a meeting or discussion to come to a decision or agreement or exchange ideas; to bestow something synonym: consult, meet, discuss

synonym: fairness, equity, impartiality

damage

to harm or cause injury to something or someone, often resulting in decreased value or functionality; to impair or negatively affect something, such as a reputation or relationship; (noun) harm or injury that is caused to a person, thing, or entity

preposition
