synonym: occupation, profession, career

#### excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate

#### mound

a raised area of ground or dirt, often used for burial,
 construction, or as a fortification; a large, rounded pile or
 heap

synonym: hill, knoll, rise

(1) mound of dirt, (2) burial mound

The team discovered a hidden **mound** in the desert.

#### discontinue

v. to cease or stop doing something; to interrupt or terminate something that is already ongoing or in progress

synonym: halt, end, cease

(1) **discontinue** a service, (2) **discontinue** a project The company has decided to **discontinue** the production of its unpopular product line.

kettle

 a metal container with a lid and handle, used for boiling water or other liquids over a heat source, commonly used for making tea or cooking pasta or soup

synonym: pot, cauldron, timpani

(1) electric kettle, (2) whistle kettle

The **kettle** on the stove started to whistle, signaling that the water was boiling.

stink

v. to emit a strong, unpleasant odor; to have a strong offensive smell; to be corrupt or unethical

synonym: reek, smell, odor

(1) stink up the place, (2) stink badly

The garbage in the alley began to **stink** after a few hot days.

reimagine

v. to imagine or conceive of something in a new or different way

synonym: re-conceptualize, re-envision, re-create

- (1) **reimagine** the future, (2) **reimagine** the possibilities The company is trying to **reimagine** its business model to stay competitive.
- Stay Competitive
  - v. to raise something from a lower to a higher position; to give a promotion to or assign to a higher positionsynonym: lift, heighten, promote
  - (1) **elevate** educational standards, (2) **elevate** a close relationship

Eating food in a hurry elevates blood glucose levels.

elevate

# blight

v. to have a detrimental effect on something, typically causing it to deteriorate or fail; (noun) any plant disease resulting in withering without rotting

synonym: devastate, ruin, decimate

(1) blight his life, (2) blight a crop

The abandoned factory was **blighted** by vandalism and graffiti.

# reshape

- v. to change the form or structure of something synonym: alter, adjust, modify
- (1) **reshape** education policy, (2) **reshape** my thoughts The advent of the Internet completely **reshaped** the manufacturing industry.

### broom

 a cleaning tool that typically consists of a long handle with a bundle of stiff bristles or fibers at one end, used for sweeping or cleaning floors or other surfaces

synonym: sweeper, brush

(1) **broom** closet, (2) **broom** handle

Could you please grab the **broom** and sweep the crumbs on the floor?

## opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

#### outgrow

- v. to grow too large for something; to grow taller or faster than another person
- (1) **outgrow** my coat, (2) **outgrow** its usefulness Bamboo will soon **outgrow** the other plants.

#### rumor

n. a piece of unverified information of uncertain origin that is spread by word of mouth

synonym: gossip, whisper, talk

(1) a false rumor, (2) rumor mill

There was a baseless **rumor** that the company was going bankrupt.

#### degrade

v. to make something worse, especially in quality; to show or treat someone in a way that makes them seem no value and do not have the respect or reasonable opinion of others

synonym: demean, disgrace, impair

(1) **degrade** his public image, (2) **degrade** environmental quality

You should not **degrade** yourself by allowing them to use you.

nod

v. to lower and raise one's head, sometimes several times, as to show approval, agreement, greeting, or confirmation

synonym: respond, acknowledge, greet

nod at each other, (2) nod courteously
 She nodded quietly in response to the question.

rehabilitate

v. to restore to good health or physical condition; to help someone return to a normal life, especially after a period of illness, addiction, or imprisonment

synonym: reform, restore, renovate

(1) **rehabilitate** prisoners, (2) **rehabilitate** wildlife
The organization works to **rehabilitate** drug addicts and help them rebuild their lives.

# playbook

 a set of strategies or tactics used in a particular situation, often in a business or political context; a guidebook or manual that outlines a specific plan of action

synonym: strategy, game plan, manual

(1) **playbook** strategy, (2) political **playbook** The coach's **playbook** helped the team win the championship.

## synergy

slog

 n. the interaction of elements that, when combined, produce a total effect that is greater than the sum of the individual elements

synonym: cooperation, collaboration, partnership

- (1) **synergy** collaboration, (2) **synergy** between businesses The new software program was designed to increase productivity by promoting employee **synergy**.
- v. to work hard or make slow, laborious progress towards a goal; to walk heavily or with difficulty, especially through mud or over rough terrain

synonym: trudge, plod, toil

(1) **slog** up a hill, (2) **slog** my way I had to **slog** through the mud to get to the top of the mountain.

## energize

 to give energy or vitality to someone or something; to invigorate

synonym: invigorate, animate, electrify

(1) **energize** the body, (2) **energize** a team

The motivational speaker **energized** the crowd with their words.

#### curate

n. a clergyman who is in charge of a parish; a person in charge of a museum, gallery, or church, responsible for the care and display of its collections and exhibitions; (verb) to carefully select, organize, and maintain items in a collection, exhibition, or presentation

synonym: minister, caretaker, (verb) arrange

(1) perpetual **curate**, (2) **curate** an art website The art museum has hired a **curate** to select and display pieces from its collection.

outdo

- v. to do better than someone; to surpass synonym: excel, surpass, outshine
- (1) **outdo** him in trickery, (2) **outdo** the competition He tried to **outdo** his rival by breaking the world record.

## splashy

adj. characterized by or tending to create a dramatic or attention-grabbing impression; showy, flamboyant, or ostentatious in appearance or behavior; attracting immediate attention or interest

*synonym*: flashy, showy, vibrant

(1) make a **splashy** entrance, (2) **splashy** graphics The **splashy** advertisement caught everyone's attention during the Super Bowl.

#### stabilize

motto

v. to become or cause to become steady or unlikely to give way

synonym: brace, steady, secure

- (1) **stabilize** prices, (2) **stabilize** blood sugar levels

  The raising of interest rates **stabilizes** the inflation rate.
- a phrase or slogan that expresses a guiding principle or goal

synonym: slogan, catchphrase, phrase

(1) the **motto** for safe traffic, (2) company **motto**The company's **motto** is "Innovation and Service," which is reflected in its products and customer support.

# watchdog

n. a person or an organization that monitors or keeps a close watch on a particular activity, situation, or group, especially to ensure that the ethical or legal standards are met; a component or feature designed to monitor and ensure the proper functioning of the system

synonym: guardian, sentinel, protector

(1) watchdog timer, (2) financial watchdog
The watchdog group helped expose corruption in the local government.

#### underresourced

 adj. lacking sufficient resources, especially financial or material support, to carry out a particular task, project, or mission

*synonym*: underfunded, deprived, resource-poor

(1) underresourced community, (2) underresourced
