pituitary

 a small, pea-sized gland located at the base of the brain that influences the growth and sexual development of the body by producing hormones

synonym: hypophyseal, hypothalamic, anterior lobe

(1) **pituitary** hormone, (2) anterior **pituitary**The **pituitary** gland is responsible for releasing hormones that regulate growth and metabolism.

gland

 a group of cells in an animal's body that produce substances needed by the body and release them through ducts or directly into the bloodstream

follicle

stimming

 a hollow muscular organ in the body of a woman or other female mammal in which a baby or young animal develops before birth

synonym: womb

communicate

v. to share or exchange information with others by speaking, writing, moving your body, or using other signals

synonym: convey, share, transmit

lutein

synonym: organic, biological, nuclear

This factory employs a **cellular** manufacturing system.

shell

 hard outer covering or case of eggs, nuts, some seeds, and some animals

synonym: ammunition, armor, cover

(1) an egg shell, (2) a mollusk shell

The outermost electron **shell** determines the chemical properties of an atom.

protein

- a molecule made up of a long chain of amino acids, which is essential for the structure and function of the body's tissues

zygote

n. the initial stage of development in a fertilized egg,
 resulting from the fusion of a sperm cell and an egg cell in sexual reproduction

progesterone

 a hormone mainly produced in the ovaries of females that helps regulate the menstrual cycle and plays a crucial role in pregnancy

synonym: progestin, gestagen, luteal hormone

(1) **progesterone** receptor, (2) synthetic **progesterone**During pregnancy, **progesterone** levels rise to support the growth of the fetus.

maintain

v. to continue to uphold or sustain; to keep in a particular state or condition; to assert or declare something to be true

synonym: preserve, uphold, sustain

gestation

 the state of being pregnant; the period during which an embryo or fetus develops, usually about 280 days in humans

synonym: pregnancy, carrying, incubation

(1) extrauterine **gestation**, (2) **gestation** time The **gestation** period for elephants is 22 months.

lab

 a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

synonym: workshop, laboratory, research chamber

patient

undergo

 a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic

ultrasound

- n. higher frequency sound than humans can hear

masturbation

 the act of sexually stimulating oneself by touching or rubbing one's genitals, typically resulting in orgasm or sexual release synonym: onanism
