# sonogram

# anencephaly

#### uterus

a hollow muscular organ in the body of a woman or other female mammal in which a baby or young animal develops before birth

*synonym*: womb

## contraction of the uterus.

#### trimester

 approximately three months, especially one of the three three-month periods into which human pregnancy is traditionally divided; one of three divisions of an academic year

synonym: quarter, three months, 13 weeks

(1) second **trimester** ends, (2) **trimester** system

The first **trimester** of pregnancy is the most crucial for the development of the fetus.

# procure

 to obtain, acquire, or secure something, often by effort or skill

synonym: obtain, acquire, secure

- (1) procure a rare antique, (2) procure servicesI need to procure some supplies for the upcoming project.
- to hold close and lovingly in one's arms, often for comfort or affection; to snuggle or nestle against someone or something

synonym: embrace, snuggle, hug

(1) **cuddle** buddy, (2) **cuddle** up with a book

I love to **cuddle** with my dog on the couch after a long day.

# cornea

- n. the transparent layer at the front of the eye that covers the iris and pupil and helps to focus light onto the retinasynonym: eye membrane, eye lens
- (1) **cornea** transplant, (2) **cornea** damage
  A scratched **cornea** can be very painful and may cause blurry vision.

# retina

- the innermost light-sensitive membrane covering the back wall of the eyeball
- (1) **retinal** cells, (2) **retina** scanner

  Damage to the **retina** may play a role in the development of glaucoma.

#### excite

# jealousy

 a feeling of resentment or bitterness towards someone because they have something that you desire

synonym: envy, covetousness, resentment

(1) **jealousy** feeling towards another person, (2) burn with **jealousy** 

His **jealousy** of his brother's success caused a rift in their relationship.

envy

v. to experience a feeling of jealousy or resentment towards someone because of their possessions, qualities, or achievements; to desire to have something that someone else has; (noun) a feeling of resentment or jealousy towards someone else's perceived advantage or success

synonym: covet, resent, grudge

(1) **envy** his success, (2) feeling **envy** toward him I can't help but **envy** my friend's ability to stay calm in stressful situations.

### retinoblastoma

n. a rare type of malignant tumor that develops in the retina of the eye, primarily affecting young children, characterized by abnormal cell growth and can lead to vision loss or other eye-related complications if left untreated

synonym: ocular cancer, eye tumor

(1) **retinoblastoma** tumor, (2) **retinoblastoma** gene Early detection and treatment of **retinoblastoma** can save both vision and lives.

# indebted

adj. owing money or having financial obligations to another person or organization; feeling grateful or obligated to someone for their help, support, or kindness

synonym: owing, obligated, beholden

(1) **indebted** to creditors, (2) financially **indebted**He felt **indebted** to his parents for all the sacrifices they had made for him.

# bury

- v. to place a dead body in the ground, grave, or tomb synonym: entomb, sink, forget
- (1) **bury** in the earth, (2) **bury** emotion There is plenty of space to **bury** everyone.

## heirloom

n. a valuable object, typically a piece of jewelry, artwork, or household item, that is passed down from generation to generation as a family heirloom; something that has special sentimental or historical value

synonym: heritage, inheritance, legacy

(1) heirloom jewelry, (2) family heirloom
The family recipe for apple pie has become an heirloom tradition.

#### inactivate

v. to make something idle or inoperative; to release from military service or remove from the active list of military service

synonym: assuage, appease, demobilize

(1) inactivate growth factor, (2) inactivate the vaccine

The system for purifying the air uses UV light to **inactivate** microorganisms.

# confer

v. to have a meeting or discussion to come to a decision or agreement or exchange ideas; to bestow something

synonym: consult, meet, discuss

(1) confer degree, (2) confer honor

The leaders of the two countries met to **confer** on the issue.

### intern

v. to put someone in prison, especially for political or military reasons; (noun) a student or trainee who works, sometimes for free, to get work experience or to fulfill qualification criteria

*synonym*: apprentice, trainee, student

The navy **interned** ships of defeated nations.

# gratify

 to give pleasure or satisfaction to; to provide someone with what they want or need; to indulge or satisfy a desire or appetite

synonym: please, satisfy, fulfill

(1) gratify desires, (2) gratify curiosity

I always try to **gratify** my boss by achieving the sales target every month.

### coworker

 a person who works with another in the same company or organization

synonym: colleague, peer, associate

(1) **coworker** relationship, (2) argue with a **coworker** My ex- **coworker** and I had different working styles but managed to get along.

# insignificant

*adj.* of little importance, influence, or power *synonym*: unimportant, trivial, irrelevant

(1) **insignificant** amount, (2) an **insignificant** mistake He made me feel small and **insignificant**.

rev

n. a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

*synonym*: revolution, RPM, speed

(1) low- rev engine, (2) rev up the crowd

# everlasting
