adj. of or relating to or constituting the nucleus of an atom; deriving destructive energy from the release of atomic energy

synonym: atomic

#### comeback

 a return to popularity, success, or performance after a decline or period of inactivity; a quick, witty response to a criticism or insult

## engineer

 a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software

synonym: architect, creator, builder

#### react

v. to take action in response to something

*synonym*: respond, reply, oppose

melt

v. to turn from something solid into something soft or liquid as a result of heating

synonym: disintegrate, soften, disappear

coal

 a combustible black or brownish-black sedimentary rock that is found below the ground and burnt to produce heat

synonym: ember

dive

- v. to jump into the water with your head and arms going in first, or to move down to a deeper level underwater
- synonym: dip, leap, plunge
- (1) **dive** into anime communities, (2) **dive** off a cliff The sperm whale can **dive** to 1,000 meters.

skeptical

adj. doubting that something is accurate or useful synonym: doubtful, distrustful, suspicious

## electrify

 to make a machine or system work by using electricity;
 to make someone extremely enthusiastic about or interested in something

synonym: wire, amaze, astonish

## percentage

 the number, amount, or rate of something, which is usually the amount per hundred

synonym: rate, ratio, portion

## decline

v. to become gradually smaller, fewer, worse, etc.; to refuse to accept

synonym: descend, drop, deny

(1) **decline** a job offer, (2) **decline** in quality
As people age, their digestive capacity also gradually **declines**.

#### climate

n. the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

synonym: atmosphere, weather, environment

(1) a cold **climate**, (2) effects of **climate** change **Climate** and weather have an impact on every part of our lifestyles.

## opposition

the act of disagreeing or resisting; the state of strong disagreement

*synonym*: resistance, hostility, antagonism

(1) **opposition** campaign, (2) meet with **opposition** The **opposition** party strongly disagreed with the government's proposed legislation.

## equivalent

- n. having the same value, quality, meaning, purpose, etc.synonym: equal, counterpart, match

## canyon

 a large deep valley with very steep sides of rock and usually formed by a river

## topaz

## charcoal

 a black, porous substance made by burning wood or other organic matter in the absence of air, often used for drawing or cooking

synonym: carbon, soot, black

## modern

*adj.* of or belonging to the present time or recent times *synonym*: contemporary, stylish, current

#### absolute

adj. perfect or complete or to the most considerable degree possible

*synonym*: complete, infrangible, indisputable

(1) absolute loyalty, (2) an absolute must

Gandhi had an **absolute** zeal for nonviolence.

#### relative

adj. considered and evaluated through comparison with something else

synonym: comparative, proximate, congeneric

(1) a remote **relative**, (2) **relative** factors

Most countries prohibit sexual activity between certain close relatives.

#### stride

 to walk with long steps in a particular direction; (noun) an important and positive progress synonym: step, walk, march

(1) **stride** across a room, (2) **stride** down a slope She **strides** confidently across the stage to accept her award.

#### combine

- v. to join or merge to form a single thing or group synonym: coalesce, cohere, blend
- (1) **combine** chemically with another substance,
- (2) **combine** augmented reality

Hydrogen and oxygen **combine** to form water.

#### statistics

- n. the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

## premature

adj. occurring or done too early; happening before the appropriate time; born before the end of a full-term pregnancy

## replace

## consequence

 the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

*synonym*: result, impact, outcome

These economic activities had disastrous environmental **consequences**.

## wipe

v. to clean or dry something by rubbing with a piece of cloth or paper or one's hand and removing dirt, food, or liquid

synonym: clean, brush, swab

## emission

- n. the act of production or sending out gas, heat, light, etc. synonym: emanation, radiation, discharge

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

## germ

 a very tiny living that causes the disease; a piece of something such as an organism, concept, etc., capable of growing into a new one or part of one synonym: bacterium, microbe, pathogen

(1) antibiotic-resistant **germ**, (2) a **germ-free** environment The **germ** of his idea came from watching birds flying in flocks.

#### commitment

 a promise or firm decision to do something or to behave in a certain way

*synonym*: burden, obligation, promise

(1) a **commitment** to an alliance, (2) meet his **commitments** 

His business **commitments** took him to the United States.

#### solar

adj. of, from, or relating to the sun

(1) the **solar** system, (2) a **solar** eclipse

**Solar** panels have greatly improved not only in performance but also in durability.

## **battery**

a device that is placed inside a car, gadget, equipment,
 etc. and that provides electrical power to them

synonym: electric cell, array, batch

(1) a dry battery, (2) battery charging

The engine did not start because the battery was flat.

## improve

v. to make or become better

*synonym*: enhance, ameliorate, enrich

(1) **improve** a process, (2) **improve** the test score

We want to **improve** ties between our two countries.

#### efficient

adj. performing at the highest level of productivity with the least wasted effort or resources; capable of achieving maximum output with minimum wasted effort, time, or materials

synonym: productive, effective, competent

(1) **efficient** operation, (2) energy- **efficient** appliances
The new washing machine is much more **efficient** than the old one.

#### electrical

adj. relating to electricity

(1) an **electrical** storm, (2) degree in **electrical** engineering Actuators convert **electrical** pulses into motion.

## grid

 a pattern of regularly spaced horizontal and vertical lines; a system of high tension cables by which electrical power is distributed throughout a region

synonym: gridiron, battery grid, power system

(1) a grid design, (2) a wire grid

**Grid** pattern roads often appear in urban areas.

## leak

v. to allow liquid or gas to get in or out from a hole or crack in a pipe or container

synonym: outflow, divulge, disclose

(1) leak data, (2) leak a classified memo

He **leaked** serious accounting irregularities that only people in the company's executive could know.

#### methane

- n. a chemical compound with the chemical formula CH4 with no smell or color, often used as a fuel
- (1) atmospheric **methane**, (2) reduce **methane** emissions The ignition of **methane** gas in the plant killed five employees.

## release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) **release** a prisoner, (2) **release** CO2 into the air The animal rights group worked to **release** the dolphins back into the wild.

#### watt

- a standard unit for measuring electrical power
- (1) 30- watt light bulb, (2) watt per square meter Several hectares of land are needed to generate more than 1-mega watt solar power.

## develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

#### carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
- carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emission
   Trees absorb carbon dioxide and give off oxygen.

## obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

## deploy

- v. to move troops or weapons into a position or military action; to bring into something in an effective waysynonym: set up, expand, launch

## pace

 the speed at which someone or something moves, or the rate at which something happens or changes

synonym: gait, rate, speed

#### consistent

adj. always behaving or happening in the same way, or having the same thoughts, standards, etc.

synonym: coherent, constant, compatible

## crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

*synonym*: concern, problem, emergency

(1) financial **crisis**, (2) **crisis** management

The Chinese word for **crisis** comprises two characters, one for danger and the other for opportunity.

## survey

 an investigation of the opinions, behavior, etc. of a particular group of people, made by asking people questions

synonym: study, examination, poll

(1) a comprehensive **survey**, (2) recent **survey**That **survey** shows that people are accepting the tax increase to some extent.

#### unconscious

adj. in the state of lacking awareness and the capacity for sensory perception, especially as the result of a head injury or illness

synonym: comatose, paralyzed, senseless

(1) **unconscious** bias, (2) a person who is **unconscious** I know his **unconscious** habit that he touches his face when he lies.

## damage

v. to harm or cause injury to something or someone, often resulting in decreased value or functionality; to impair or negatively affect something, such as a reputation or relationship; (noun) harm or injury that is caused to a person, thing, or entity

synonym: harm, impair, injure

(1) **damage** a relationship, (2) **damage** assessment During the surgery, the doctor had to be extremely cautious not to **damage** a blood vessel.

#### association

 a people or groups of people who have joined in a single organization together for a particular purpose; a social or business connection or relationship

synonym: affiliation, collaboration, society

(1) word **associations**, (2) a scholarship **association** His membership in the **association** provided him with numerous benefits.

## technological

adj. based on scientific and industrial progresssynonym: specialized, technical

(1) **technological** advancement, (2) **technological** policy **Technological** advances have disrupted many industries.

#### advance

- v. to go or move forward; to develop in a positive way synonym: progress, boost, come along
- (1) **advance** the technology, (2) **advance** a cooperative relationship

## entrepreneur

 an individual who creates or invests in one or more businesses, especially when this involves taking financial risks

synonym: founder, executive

#### excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate

#### thorium

 a radioactive chemical element with the symbol Th and atomic number 90 that is silvery-white in color and is used as fuel in some nuclear reactors

synonym: Th, radioactive element

Certain isotopes of **thorium** are used in medicine for treating liver cancer.

crank

 a mechanical device that converts rotary motion into linear motion or vice versa; an eccentric or unpredictable person

assembly

 a group of people who have been elected, especially one that meets regularly and makes decisions or laws for a specific region or country

synonym: crowd, gathering, mass

This company's **assembly** plant is an enormous facility.

## smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

exciting

adj. causing a lot of interest or excitement synonym: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

(1) **exciting** football player, (2) **exciting** news
The findings of the experiment were both **exciting** and

unexpected.

bunch

 a grouping of several similar things which are growing or fastened together

synonym: group, assemblage, bundle

(1) a bunch of trees, (2) a bunch of schoolgirls

One bad apple spoils the whole **bunch**.

## timeline

 a series of events arranged in chronological order and displayed along a line, usually drawn left to right or top to bottom

synonym: agenda, timetable, chronology

(1) timeline of science history, (2) lay out a timelineHe imposed a timeline on the project.

## molten

adj. in a liquid state as a result of being heated synonym: melted, liquefied, fused

(1) a molten image, (2) molten lavaThe molten metal was poured into the mold.

## excuse

 a reason or explanation, either true or invented, given to justify a fault or defend your behavior; (verb) to make someone free from blame or clear from guilt

synonym: apology, justification, reason

(1) **excuse** for inaction, (2) perfect **excuse**He quickly fabricated an **excuse** for not attending the meeting.

## polluted

*adj.* contaminated with harmful or poisonous substances *synonym*: contaminated, poisoned, unclean

(1) polluted air, (2) cadmium- polluted area
The river was polluted with chemicals, causing harm to the wildlife.

## depart

- v. to go away or leave, especially to start a journeysynonym: go away, leave, vacate
- (1) arrive and **depart** on time, (2) **depart** from the faith We **departed** before the temperature fell below zero.

## forthcoming

adj. likely to happen or be available soon synonym: imminent, upcoming, anticipated

(1) in the **forthcoming** week, (2) **forthcoming** book The **forthcoming** election is causing a lot of tension and uncertainty.

#### demonstrate

v. to display something or give an exhibition to an interested audience

*synonym*: show, illustrate, display

(1) **demonstrate** a difference, (2) **demonstrate** mastery How can you **demonstrate** that the earth is a sphere?

## skip

v. to move along lightly and quickly, making a step from one foot to the other with a hop or bounce; to intentionally fail to do something which would normally do

*synonym*: bounce, spring, neglect

(1) **skip** across the country, (2) **skip** breakfast We **skipped** the topic because it was too complicated.

## commercialize

 to make something available for sale or use on a large scale

synonym: monetize, capitalize, marketize

(1) **commercialize** my patents, (2) **commercialize** idea The company is trying to **commercialize** its new product.

## temperature

- n. the degree of hotness or coldness of a thing or placesynonym: climate, warmth, degree
- (1) extreme **temperatures**, (2) the atmospheric **temperature**

Cities around the world set records for highest **temperatures** this summer.

## bulky

adj. taking up much space or being difficult to move because of its size or weight; large and unwieldy

synonym: large, cumbersome, unwieldy

(1) **bulky** material, (2) **bulky** packaging

The **bulky** furniture made it difficult to move around the small room.

## process

 a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process**The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

## complicated

adj. involving a lot of different things or parts in a way that is difficult to understand or analyze

*synonym*: complex, convoluted, intricate

(1) a **complicated** process, (2) become increasingly **complicated** 

He did **complicated** pen-and-ink drawings in just a few days.

## government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### internal

*adj.* of or relating to the inside of something *synonym*: interior, inner, domestic

(1) **internal** organs, (2) the **internal** economy

The prime minister canceled visits to other countries to resolve **internal** disputes.

#### lifetime

- n. the duration of someone's life or something's existence;synonym: lifespan, duration
- (1) **lifetime** benefits, (2) **lifetime** ban from the sport She had lived through two world wars in her **lifetime**.

#### mention

- v. to speak or write about something or someone briefly synonym: reference, allude, cite
- (1) mention name, (2) mention in a reportI mentioned to him that I had seen his sister at the grocery

store earlier that day.

#### reduction

- n. a decrease in size, amount, or degreesynonym: diminution, decrease, cutback

## suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume

## offline

- adj. not connected to the internet synonym: disconnected, not connected, unplugged
- offline course, (2) offline mode

## startling

- synonym: alarming, astonishing, shocking

#### medical

- adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine
- *synonym*: health, disease, treatment

## journal

- a newspaper or magazine specialized in a specific topic or profession
- synonym: periodical, diary, bulletin
- (1) scientific journal, (2) journal articles

#### lancet

a sharp, pointed surgical instrument used for making incisions or punctures, typically in medical procedures

synonym: scalpel, blade, surgical instrument

#### reliable

adj. worthy of being relied on; trustworthysynonym: dependable, trustworthy, dedicated

vast

*adj.* enormous in size, number, amount, or quantity *synonym*: expansive, extended, boundless

(1) vast majority, (2) vast desert

A **vast** audience viewed the broadcast.

## panic

 a sudden strong feeling of fear that cannot be controlled and prevents reasonable thought and action

synonym: confusion, hysteria, consternation

(1) a panic reaction, (2) panic buying

The participation of oil-producing countries in the war caused **panic** in the financial markets.

#### radiation

n. the energy that comes from a nuclear reaction in the form of rays, waves, or particles and that can be hazardous to health

synonym: dissemination, emission, irradiation

- (1) exposure to **radiation**, (2) electromagnetic **radiation**He tried every possible treatment, including chemotherapy and **radiation** therapy.
- a pile of something arranged or laid one on top of another; a large tall chimney through which combustion gases and smoke can be evacuated

## poisonous

## pollution

n. the introduction of harmful substances or waste into the natural environment that causes adverse change


