health conditions, including depression, anxiety disorders, obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD), and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)

synonym: antidepressant, SSRI, Paxil

(1) **paroxetine** medication, (2) **paroxetine** side effects It is important to gradually reduce the dose of **paroxetine** under medical supervision to avoid withdrawal symptoms.

antidepressant

- any of a class of drugs used to reduce feelings of sadness and worry
- (1) an **antidepressant** drug, (2) **antidepressant** effect She has been taking **antidepressants** since her baby died.

machine-learning

- n. the process through which computers change the way they perform jobs without following explicit instructions by using algorithms and statistical models to analyze and draw inferences from patterns in data

Many software engineers are developing applications to build **machine-learning** algorithms more quickly.

mumbo

pipette

 a slender tube or tube-like instrument used for measuring small quantities of liquid, often with a bulb at one end that can be squeezed to draw liquid inside

synonym: dropper, tube

After handling a toxic substance, she disposed of the contaminated **pipette** in the designated hazardous waste bin.

hyperglycemia

 a condition characterized by an excessively high level of sugar (glucose) in the blood, often associated with diabetes

synonym: high blood sugar, elevated blood glucose
