rainforest

medicinal

indigenous

adj. someone or something that is native to or occurring naturally in a particular place

synonym: domestic, endemic, primitive

disappear

v. to cease to exist or be visible

synonym: fade, evaporate, vanish

(1) **disappear** without a trace, (2) **disappear** after a week

They watched the train **disappear** into the distance.

endangered

adj. at risk of extinction because it is facing significant threats

synonym: at risk, threatened, vulnerable

(1) **endangered** species, (2) **endangered** ecosystem The government has implemented policies to protect the habitat of **endangered** animals.

jaguar

 a large animal of the cat family that has a yellowish-brown coat with black spots, mainly found in parts of Central and South America

synonym: cat, feline, panther

(1) a wild jaguar, (2) a female jaguar

Humans have developed the **jaguar's** habitat over several decades.

harpy

- n. a mythological creature in Greek and Roman mythology with the head of a woman and the body of a vulture or bird of prey, also used to describe a predatory or aggressive woman

The angry wife screamed like a **harpy** at her husband for coming home late.

eagle

 a large predatory bird with a hooked beak and broad wings, known for its keen eyesight and powerful flight; a symbol of strength and freedom in many cultures

synonym: bird of prey, raptor

The bald **eagle** symbolizes freedom and strength in the United States.

isolate

v. to physically or socially separate someone or something from other people or things

synonym: separate, sequester, insulate

(1) **isolate** a compound, (2) **isolate** a patient

You should not **isolate** them from the community.

tribe

 a social group made up of members who live together, sharing the same language, culture, religion, etc., especially those who do not live in towns or cities

synonym: family, clan, kinsfolk

(1) aboriginal tribe, (2) mountain tribe

The **tribe** had distinctly defined gender roles.

injury

 n. harm done to a person's or an animal's body caused by an accident or an attack

synonym: wound, damage, hurt

(1) without **injury**, (2) a fatal **injury**

My accidental injury got better right away.

accident

an unfortunate event, especially one causing damage or injury

synonym: calamity, casualty, chance

(1) cause an **accident**, (2) injury in a car **accident** The **accident** partially destroyed my vehicle.

aspirin

a drug used to reduce pain, fever, and inflammation

(1) prescribe **aspirin**, (2) **aspirin** sensitivity

She took a tablet of **aspirin** to soothe the fever.

narcotic

n. a drug or substance that dulls the senses and induces a state of lethargy or sleep; a drug that is illegal or highly regulated for medical use due to its ability to cause addiction or harm

synonym: drug, sedative, opiate

The doctor prescribed a **narcotic** painkiller to alleviate her chronic pain.

painkiller

- n. medicine used to relieve physical painsynonym: anesthetic, anodyne, analgesic
- (1) a strong **painkiller**, (2) take a **painkiller** beforehand Over-the-counter **painkillers** are less effective for patients who have taken many in the past.

inflammation

 a physical condition in which a part of the body becomes red, painful, hot, and often swollen, especially as a reaction to infection or injury

synonym: rash, hives, irritation

(1) reduce **inflammation** and pain, (2) **inflammation** of the lungs

The medicine soothes the pain of chronic inflammation.

cortisone

- n. a hormone naturally produced by the adrenal glands or a synthetic version of this hormone, commonly used as an anti-inflammatory medication to treat various conditions, such as allergies, skin diseases, arthritis, and asthma
- (1) **cortisone** treatment, (2) topical **cortisone**The athlete received a **cortisone** injection to reduce inflammation in the injured knee.

sever

 to break or separate something by cutting, especially suddenly and forcibly

shaman

limp

machete

a large, heavy knife with a broad blade used for cutting vegetation or, in some cultures, as a weapon

The farmer used a steel **machete** to clear away the dense underbrush in the field.

palm

the inner surface of the hand from the wrist to the base of the fingers; any plant of the family Palmae having an unbranched trunk crowned by large pinnate or palmate leaves

synonym: hand, fist

- (1) the **palm** side of the forearm, (2) coconut **palm** trees This high-performance camera is compact enough to fit in the palm of your hand.
- to create something by cutting wood or stone; to turn sharply

synonym: sculpt, engrave, cut

(1) carve a statue, (2) carve my name on the plate This statue is **carved** from a single tree trunk.

carve

fern

 a non-flowering plant with long, feathery fronds that reproduce by spores rather than seeds

synonym: greenery, foliage, bracken

(1) fern leaves, (2) tropical ferns

The garden was filled with various plants, including a beautiful maidenhair **fern**.

healing

 the process of becoming or making somebody or something well again

synonym: recovery, recuperation, convalescence

(1) natural **healing** ability, (2) part of the **healing** process Each ancient tribe has its **healing** traditions.

devise

v. to come up with an idea, plan, theory, etc., using your intelligence or imagination

synonym: create, concoct, invent

(1) devise a plan, (2) devise a literary plot

They had to **devise** a system that did not depend on fossil fuels.

breast

n. either of the two round soft parts of a woman's chest which secrete milk after childbirth

synonym: bosom, chest, bust

(1) **breast** cancer, (2) the mountain's **breast**

He grilled the **breast** meat of a chicken.

cancer

 abnormal growth of cells that can invade and destroy surrounding tissues and organs; a disease characterized by the uncontrolled growth and spread of abnormal cells

synonym: tumor, carcinoma, malignancy

(1) cancer diagnosis, (2) cancer research

Breast **cancer** is the most common type of cancer in women.

schizophrenia

 a severe mental disorder in which a person has a distorted view of reality and may experience hallucinations, delusions, and disordered thinking and behavior synonym: psychosis, disorder, mental illness

(1) **schizophrenia** spectrum disorder, (2) **schizophrenia** treatment

The **schizophrenia** patient was experiencing severe auditory hallucinations.

acid

 sour; water-soluble chemicals with a sour flavor; any of a variety of generally liquid compounds capable of reacting with and occasionally dissolving other materials

synonym: SOUT

(1) an **acid** reaction, (2) good source of essential amino **acids**

During pregnancy, the stomach generates less **acid** than usual.

flux

 the state of constantly changing or flowing; the rate of flow of energy or particles across a particular place

synonym: flow, change, motion

(1) flux density, (2) flux of particles

The town's population was in **flux**, with many people moving in and out.

insomnia

n. the condition of being unable to sleep, usually a chronic one

synonym: sleeplessness, wakefulness, restlessness

(1) medication for **insomnia**, (2) alcohol-dependent **insomnia**

He suffered **insomnia** and loss of appetite after he began taking that medication.

leishmaniasis

n. a parasitic disease caused by the Leishmania parasites, transmitted through the bite of infected sandflies, which can manifest as cutaneous leishmaniasis (= affecting the skin), visceral leishmaniasis (= affecting internal organs), or mucocutaneous leishmaniasis (= affecting mucous membranes)

synonym: kala-azar, black fever, oriental sore

nasty

protozoa

a diverse group of single-celled microorganisms that are classified as eukaryotic, meaning they have a distinct nucleus and other membrane-bound organelles found in a wide range of environments, from soil to water to the bodies of humans and animals

synonym: microorganism, unicellular organism, amoeba

(1) free-living **protozoa**, (2) **protozoa** species

The water in the lake was contaminated with high levels of **protozoa**, making it unsafe for swimming or drinking.

disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

disease prevention, (2) disease control
 The doctor diagnosed him with a rare disease that had no

known cure.

afflict

 to cause pain, suffering, or distress to someone or something

synonym: trouble, distress, bother

(1) **afflict** with the plague, (2) **afflict** the economy The disease can **afflict** both humans and animals.

injection

 the act of introducing a liquid, especially a drug, into the body using a needle and a syringe

synonym: shot, infusion, dose

(1) fuel injection, (2) injection needle

He received an **injection** of antibiotics to treat his infection.

antimony

- a chemical element with the symbol Sb and atomic number 51, often used in alloys, flame retardants, and medicines
- (1) antimony compound, (2) antimony ore

The laboratory used **antimony** chloride in the production of certain chemicals.

magic

 beliefs and actions employed to influence supernatural beings and forces; any art or performance that invokes supernatural powers

synonym: fascination, illusion, wizardry

(1) a magic spell, (2) she is magic

He performed **magic** tricks with sophisticated moves.

colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

collaborate with colleagues,
 former colleague
 decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important **discovery**.

rescue

 to save someone or something from a dangerous or difficult situation

synonym: save, extricate, retrieve

(1) **rescue** a dying dog, (2) **rescue** a company from bankruptcy

The fire department arrived just in time to **rescue** the family from the burning building.

beckon

v. to gesture or signal someone to come nearer or follow; to encourage or entice someone to do something; to seem attractive or desirable

synonym: signal, summon, gesture

(1) **beckon** with a hand, (2) **beckon** a taxi

The warm sun and gentle breeze **beckoned** us to spend the day outside.

lick

v. to pass the tongue over something to moisten, taste, or eat

synonym: taste, moisten, sweep

(1) lick a teaspoon, (2) lick its wounds

She licked the envelope to seal it before mailing it.

hallucinogen

 a substance that produces hallucinations (i.e., perceptions of things that are not present or real), such as LSD, psilocybin, or mescaline

synonym: psychedelic drug, mind-bender

(1) **hallucinogen** effects, (2) take a **hallucinogen** Psilocybin is a type of **hallucinogen** found in some mushrooms.

editorial

adj. relating to the expression of opinions or interpretations in the media

synonym: comment, opinion, critique

(1) gain editorial help, (2) an editorial article

The newspaper published an **editorial** on the current state of the economy.

decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options
- synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

whirl

v. to spin or turn rapidly; to move or be moved quickly in a circular manner; (noun) a spinning or rotating movement, often rapid or chaotic in nature

synonym: spin, rotate, swirl

(1) **whirl** in the washing machine, (2) **whirl** around the dance floor

The leaves began to whirl around in the windy weather.

function

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) function properly, (2) immune function

The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

heap

n. an untidy pile or mass of something; a large number or amount or extent of something

synonym: pile, accumulation, stack

(1) a heap of trash, (2) top of the heap

A **heap** of old clothes was lying in the room.

hammock

 a type of lightweight bed or sling made of canvas, rope, or netting, often suspended between two supports such as trees or poles; a type of vegetation-rich ecosystem found in lowland areas

synonym: cradle, swing

(1) hammock swing, (2) woven hammock

I like to relax in a **hammock** on warm summer days.

chemistry

- the branch of the natural sciences dealing with the composition of substances and their properties and reactions
- (1) professor of **chemistry**, (2) the **chemistry** of soil

He is familiar with **chemistry** and biology.

theological

adj. relating to the study of religion or religious belief; relating to the nature of God or divinity

synonym: religious, divine, spiritual

(1) a theological school, (2) theological virtue

The seminar will explore the **theological** foundations of the Christian faith.

aspect

- n. one part or feature of a situation, problem, subject, etc.synonym: characteristic, element, factor
- (1) nontechnical **aspects** of the job, (2) **aspects** of social, political, and economic life

His professional experience includes all **aspects** of media production.

peptide

- n. a molecule made up of two or more amino acids linked in a chain, found in the structure of proteinssynonym: protein fragment, chain of amino acids
- (1) **peptide** chain, (2) synthesis of **peptide**

The new drug was developed using a **peptide-based** formula that targets specific cells in the body.

resistant

- adj. not affected by something, especially changes or new ideas; of or relating to immunity to disease or infectionsynonym: unsusceptible, immune, invulnerable

staphylococcus

 n. (also staph) a type of bacteria that can cause various types of infections in humans, including skin infections, pneumonia, and food poisoning

synonym: bacteria, microbe, germ

(1) **staphylococcus** aureus, (2) **staphylococcus** bacteria The patient was diagnosed with a **staphylococcus** infection.

aureus

a type of bacteria, particularly the species
 Staphylococcus aureus, that can cause a range of infections in humans and animals, often resistant to antibiotics and can be difficult to treat; (adjective, "golden" or "of gold" in Latin) relating to something that is gold-colored or has properties similar to gold

synonym: (adjective) golden

(1) aureus color, (2) aureus infection

Staphylococcus **aureus** is a type of bacteria that can cause skin infections.

ironic

adj. using words to express something different from and often opposite to their literal or usual meaning, often for humorous or rhetorical effect

synonym: sarcastic, wry, sardonic

(1) **ironic** result, (2) an **ironic** turn of events

It was **ironic** that the heavy rain started just as they set up for an outdoor picnic.

ayahuasca

- n. a psychoactive brew or infusion made from a combination of plant-based ingredients, traditionally used by indigenous people in the Amazon region of South America for spiritual and healing purposes, which contains the psychedelic compound DMT (dimethyltryptamine) and is often consumed as part of a ritual or ceremony
- (1) **ayahuasca** ceremony, (2) **ayahuasca** vine Participants in the ceremony consumed **ayahuasca** to achieve spiritual enlightenment.

ceremony

- n. a formal event or ritual, often religious or solemnsynonym: ritual, rite, observance
- (1) ceremony hall, (2) ceremony location

The wedding **ceremony** was a beautiful and emotional event.

fellow

adj. someone who has the same job or interests as you, or is in the same class, profession, or situation as you

synonym: buddy, mate, affiliate

(1) junior **fellow**, (2) nice **fellow**

He is the kind of **fellow** who only works for his success.

medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

synonym: health, disease, treatment

(1) a **medical** opinion, (2) temporary **medical** treatment The **medical** team worked quickly to save the patient's life.

infection

 a condition in which pathogenic microorganisms or viruses have entered the body

synonym: contagion, disease, transmission

(1) a bacterial **infection**, (2) treat the **infection** with antibiotics

Hospitals must meet various standards to prevent nosocomial **infections**.

affliction

 a condition of physical or mental suffering or distress, often caused by illness, injury, or other adversity; a burden or trouble that causes hardship or grief

synonym: anguish, distress, suffering

(1) mental **affliction**, (2) autoimmune **affliction**Chronic pain can be a debilitating **affliction** that affects every aspect of one's life.

spirit

n. the part of a person which is the seat of their mind, feelings, and character rather than their physical body; the general atmosphere of a place or situation and the effect that it has on people

synonym: soul, attitude, enthusiasm

(1) **spirit** and the letter of the law, (2) an indomitable **spirit** Despite their tragic loss, the family is showing great **spirit**.

viper

n. venomous snake

synonym: snake, serpent, adder

(1) brood of **vipers**, (2) **viper** poison

The pit **viper** coiled up, ready to strike at its prey.

venom

 a toxic substance produced by an animal, typically a snake or insect, and injected into prey or an enemy by biting or stinging

synonym: poison, toxin, hating

(1) the **venom** of a lizard, (2) injected **venom**The snake's **venom** is highly toxic and can be fatal to humans.

develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

ace

n. a playing card with a single symbol or mark that is typically the highest in value or rank in a particular card game; a person who is very skilled or successful in a specific activity or field

synonym: expert, master, champion

(1) tennis ace, (2) ace in the hole

He was an **ace** at playing poker and often won the game.

inhibitor

 a substance or agent that slows down or prevents a chemical reaction or biological process from occurring at normal rates, often used in medicine or industrial applications to control or regulate various functions or reactions

synonym: hinderer, suppressor, blocker

(1) inhibitor protein, (2) chemical inhibitor

The virus uses an enzyme **inhibitor** to block the immune system's response.

frontline

adj. in the most critical or dangerous position; in the military line or part of an army closest to the enemy

synonym: battlefront, cutting edge

(1) **frontline** health workers, (2) at the **frontline** of the war Within days, the new aircraft was in **frontline** service.

hypertension

 a medical condition characterized by abnormally high blood pressure in the arteries, often leading to an increased risk of heart disease, stroke, and other health problems

synonym: high blood pressure

(1) **hypertension** rate, (2) arterial **hypertension**To lower **hypertension**, it is important to maintain a healthy diet and exercise regularly.

planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

synonym: earth, world, globe

(1) **planet** like the Earth, (2) save the **planet** Mercury is the closest **planet** to the sun.

industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort synonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

nickel

 a silver-white metallic element with the symbol Ni, used in many alloys and as a coin; a United States coin worth one-twentieth of a dollar

synonym: metal, coin, alloy

(1) nickel ore, (2) nickel plate

The nickel in my pocket jingled as I walked.

reserve

v. to keep something for future use or contingency; to obtain or arrange something, such as a meeting, seat,

etc., in advance

synonym: keep, hold, preserve

(1) **reserve** the right, (2) **reserve** a concert ticket

You can easily **reserve** seats over the telephone.

bunch

 a grouping of several similar things which are growing or fastened together

synonym: group, assemblage, bundle

(1) a **bunch** of trees, (2) a **bunch** of schoolgirls

One bad apple spoils the whole **bunch**.

skinny

adj. having a very thin or slim body; referring to clothing that is tightly fitting and reveals the shape of the body; referring to information or details that are kept secret or confidential

synonym: slender, lean, thin

(1) **skinny** jeans, (2) **skinny** finger

His mom was always concerned about his **skinny** frame and encouraged him to eat more

COW

 a domesticated mammal with characteristic features such as a hump, large udders, and curved horns that is raised for its milk or meat

synonym: bovine, cattle, kine

(1) cow herd, (2) dairy cow

The farmer milked the cows every morning before breakfast.

carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
- (1) carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emission

Trees absorb **carbon** dioxide and give off oxygen.

sequester

v. to take temporary possession of someone's property until a debt is paid.

synonym: isolate, set apart, segregate

(1) **sequester** ten percent of the annual carbon emissions,

belong

v. to be the property of someone or something; to be a member or part of a group; to be in the proper or appropriate place

atmosphere

The spaceship began to burn up as it approached the Earth's atmosphere.

climate

the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

synonym: atmosphere, weather, environment

release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge

- n. the act of causing so much damage to somethingsynonym: devastation, annihilation, ruin
- (1) path of **destruction**, (2) cyclonic **destruction**The extinction of several subspecies has been linked to

mighty

adj. very large, powerful, or strongsynonym: potent, powerful, robust

anteater

n. a mammal that feeds on ants and termites, characterized by a long snout and a sticky tongue synonym: antbear, numbat, echidna

(1) anteater habitat, (2) giant anteater

The **anteater's** long, sticky tongue is perfectly adapted to catching ants and insects.

tip

n. the top or extreme point of something slender or tapering, usually a mountain or hill; a piece of advice about something practical; a small amount of money given for services

pound

- the standard unit of money in the UK; the standard unit of weight equal to 16 ounces

goliath

 a biblical figure and legendary giant warrior whom the young shepherd David defeated; a symbol of great strength or size

spider

 a small, eight-legged creature that spins webs to catch insects as food; a computer program that systematically browses the World Wide Web for purposes of web indexing

synonym: arachnid, wanderer

The **spider** spun an intricate web in the corner of the room.

wingspan
