#### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

#### aim

- v. to try or plan to get or achieve something
- *synonym*: aspire, direct, target

### discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

#### bacteria

n. single-celled or noncellular spherical or spiral or rod-shaped organisms that exist in large numbers in the air, water, and soil, and also in living and dead creatures and plants, and are often a cause of disease

#### viral

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

tick

 a light, sharp, repetitive sound or action; a mark indicating that something is correct or has been done; any of two families of small parasitic arachnids with barbed proboscis

#### bomb

 a weapon that explodes and is used to kill or injure people or to cause damage to something

#### defuse

### destroy

### adaptive

#### immune

#### detect

#### harness

#### **function**

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

### engineer

#### incredible

### employ

### prudent

adj. acting with or showing care and thought for the future;
 exercising good judgment and common sense; sensible
 or wise in making decisions

inject

 to put a liquid such as a drug or other substance into a person's or an animal's body using a needle and syringe (= small tube)

synonym: shoot, infiltrate, insinuate

pluck

v. to pull or draw something, especially with sudden force or effort; to strip of feathers

chromosome

 a long and string-like DNA molecule containing the part or all of the genetic material of an organism that controls what an animal or plant is like

cluster

 a group of similar things or people close together, often forming a distinct mass or unit

synonym: group, aggregation, array

regularly

synonym: repeatedly, routinely, usually

#### interspace

 the space between objects or parts, especially between two closely positioned objects; an interval or gap between two things

synonym: gap, interval, space

### palindrome

n. a word, phrase, or sequence of characters that reads the same backward as forward, such as "racecar" or "level"; (of medicine and genetics) a sequence of DNA or RNA that is the same when read from 5' (five prime, denoting ends of DNA or RNA) to 3' on one strand and from 5' to 3' on the complementary strand

### acronym

#### mechanism

#### exposed

### progeny

 the descendants or offspring of a person, animal, or plant

#### locus

 a central or focal point; a place where something happens or is centered around

### sequence

 a series of related events, actions, numbers, etc., which have a particular order

v. to mentally connect someone or something with someone or something else

synonym: tie in, link, consociate

#### bind

 to tie or fasten someone or something tightly with rope, string, etc. so that they cannot move or are held together strongly

synonym: tie, stick to, adhere

### complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

#### sentinel

 a person or thing that stands guard or keeps watch; a soldier or guard who stands watch to provide security

synonym: guard, watchman, lookout

The security camera acted as a **sentinel**, monitoring the area for suspicious activity.

#### bound

v. to move forward by leaps and bounds; to form the boundary of something

#### cleave

v. to split or divide something into two parts, often with force; to adhere or cling to something closely and cohesively

adj. sharply exact or accurate or delimited

#### helix

 a three-dimensional spiral shape or structure, particularly like that of a spring or a DNA molecule

synonym: coil, spiral, twist

### recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

#### introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something to a wider audience or new market

synonym: initiation, preamble, prologue

(1) **introduction** education, (2) self- **introduction**The **introduction** to the new class was informative and engaging.

### analogous

adj. similar or equivalent in some respects, typically as a result of functioning in a similar way

synonym: similar, comparable, equivalent

(1) analogous fashion, (2) entirely analogous

The human heart is **analogous** to a pump in a plumbing system.

### process

a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym:

### procedure, method, system

(1) process improvement, (2) decision-making process The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

#### typo

- a mistake made in typing or the reproduction of a text synonym: error, mistake, misprint

#### envision

to imagine or expect what a situation will be like in the future

synonym: anticipate, foresee, picture

### trigger

- to make something happen suddenly; to cause something such as a device, machine, etc. to function synonym: activate, spark, drive
- (1) **trigger** a biochemical response, (2) **trigger** inflation The incident **triggered** a political controversy.

### disrupt

to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance

synonym: interrupt, disturb, break into

(1) **disrupt** a well-ordered condition, (2) **disrupt** sleep I'm so sorry to **disrupt** you when you're pretty busy.

### incorporation

the process of including or integrating something into a larger entity, such as a business or organization; the act of forming a corporation or company that is legally recognized as a separate entity, distinct from its owners synonym: integration, consolidation, combination

The **incorporation** of new technology has dramatically improved our efficiency.

#### mutation

 the way in which genes of a person, plant, animal, or other organism change and produce permanent differences

cyst

 a sac, cavity, or abnormal growth in the body that is typically filled with fluid or semisolid material; usually benign but can also be cancerous and require treatment

#### **fibrosis**

synonym: scarring, hardening, fibrotic disease

### develop

### manipulate

v. to influence or control something or someone to your advantage, often in an unfair or dishonest way

#### inefficient

adj. lacking the ability or skill and not making the best use of time, money, energy, etc.

synonym: ineffective, counterproductive, inadequate

### adopt

 to choose to follow something; to legally take a child from another family and care for them as if they were one's own

synonym: accept, assume, take on

(1) adopt a child, (2) adopt a bill

The national assembly has adopted the budget.

### **laboratory**

 a workplace for doing scientific research or teaching science; a lab

synonym: lab, workshop, testing room

(1) **laboratory** accident, (2) anthropology **laboratory**Animal protection groups call for an end to animal testing in a **laboratory**.

#### clinical

adj. of or relating to the examination and treatment of patients rather than theoretical or laboratory studies

synonym: dispassionate, analytic, scientific

#### utilize

v. to use something for a practical purpose in an effective way

#### relative

a tool consisting of a short curved blade with a handle, used for cutting grass or grain; also a symbol associated with harvest or death

synonym: scythe, crescent, cutter
