# poverty

- *n.* the condition of being extremely poor *synonym*: deprivation, destitution, poorness

# inequality

*n*. the unfairness of a society in which some people have more opportunity, money, etc. than others;

# unemployed

adj. not having a job, although able to work

synonym: idle, inactive, jobless

# violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

# addiction

 the inability to stop using or doing something as a habit, especially something harmful

*synonym*: dependence

(1) alcohol addiction, (2) addiction to foreign oil

# playground

 an area where many people go for recreation, especially at a school or in a park

synonym: park, garden, sandbox

(1) a well-equipped **playground**, (2) a **playground** on the roof

#### desolate

adj. deserted, barren, or lonely; causing a feeling of sadness or hopelessness

synonym: barren, stark, uninhabited

# palpable

adj. able to be felt or touched; easily perceivable or noticeable; tangible

#### volume

- *n.* the amount of space occupied by an object or substance; the magnitude of sound

#### constant

- adj. happening repeatedly or all the time
- synonym: ceaseless, stable, unchanging
- (1) a constant wind, (2) a constant temperature

**Constant** dropping wears away the stone.

#### stream

- a small, narrow river; a continuous flow of something, such as liquid, gas, people, vehicles, etc.
- synonym: flow, current, brook
- (1) the **stream** of time, (2) an endless **stream** of cars

  Jet **streams** are the common name for air currents that form high in the atmosphere.

#### abuse

- n. the use of something in an incorrect or harmful mannersynonym: misuse, misconduct, vilification
- (1) the problem of drug **abuse**, (2) victim of sexual **abuse** Our company has an audit team that monitors directors for **abuse** of authority.

### strain

 a force or pressure that stretches or pulls something, sometimes causing damage; (biology) a group of organisms within a species that differ in trivial ways from similar groups

synonym: pressure, tension, breed

(1) **strain** our eyes, (2) a **strain** of bacillus Dictators of the past often had the erroneous idea of a pure racial **strain**.

#### stick

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

*synonym*: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) **stick** a key in a lock, (2) fire **stick** 

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

#### crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

*synonym*: concern, problem, emergency

(1) financial **crisis**, (2) **crisis** management

The Chinese word for **crisis** comprises two characters, one for danger and the other for opportunity.

### abusive

 adj. involving or characterized by harmful or offensive treatment, language, or behavior; using physical, emotional, or verbal force to control or harm someone else

synonym: cruel, oppressive, hurtful

(1) abusive behavior, (2) abusive parent

The teacher's **abusive** language towards the students was unacceptable.

tragic

adj. causing great sadness or suffering; very unfortunate synonym: calamitous, disastrous, catastrophic

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

argument

 a set of statements or reasons used to support or refute a proposition or theory; a verbal or physical fight or dispute

# basis

 the most important facts, ideas, or events from which something is developed; the way how things are organized or arranged

synonym: foundation, base, ground

# government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

# struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the iob

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

# economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

# deprivation

 a state of not having something, such as food or money, that you need for a pleasant life

synonym: poverty, destitution, forfeiture

# quarter

- n. one of four equal parts; a fourth part or portionsynonym: fourth, one-fourth

# pound

- the standard unit of money in the UK; the standard unit of weight equal to 16 ounces

# underlying

synonym: fundamental, latent, basic

# institutionalize

# gyroscope

a device consisting of a spinning wheel or disk mounted in such a way that it can rotate freely in any direction, used to maintain balance, stability, or orientation in navigation, aerospace, or other systems

# export

# contemporary
