#### disturb

#### matchmake

rev

#### uncover

#### shoal

#### agile

rowdy

## disperse

#### archipelago

 a group of islands, often located in a specific area or region

synonym: group of islands, island chain

(1) tropical **archipelago**, (2) volcanic **archipelago**The Philippines is an **archipelago** made up of over 7,000 islands.

#### stormy

adj. marked by strong winds, heavy rain, thunder, and lightning; characterized by tumultuous or rough emotions, particularly in a relationship or situation

synonym: tempestuous, turbulent, choppy

The city council meeting was **stormy**, as people argued about a controversial new policy.

#### monsoon

 a seasonal wind system that brings heavy rainfall to a region, typically occurring in tropical areas

#### manta

 a large, flat-bodied fish related to rays found in warm ocean waters around the world

#### speck

n. a very small spot, piece, or amount

#### atoll

 a ring-shaped coral reef or a chain of coral islands and reefs surrounding a central lagoon, typically formed by the subsidence of a volcanic island over time, leaving only the coral reefs visible above the water surface *synonym*: coral reef, islet, cay

#### crustacean

#### gobble
