### overwhelm

synonym: conquer, crush, dominate

Too much variety may **overwhelm** and confuse viewers.

#### intern

v. to put someone in prison, especially for political or military reasons; (noun) a student or trainee who works, sometimes for free, to get work experience or to fulfill qualification criteria

synonym: apprentice, trainee, student

(1) intern civilians, (2) medical intern

The navy **interned** ships of defeated nations.

#### bawl

v. to cry or weep loudly and uncontrollably; to shout or yell loudly and angrily

synonym: cry, wail, sob

(1) **bawl** like a baby, (2) **bawl** with laughter

He **bawled** his eyes out when he heard the news.

#### evocative

*adj.* tending to evoke or bring something to mind *synonym*: suggestive, stimulating, provocative

(1) **evocative** memories, (2) **evocative** language The music was **evocative** of a bygone era.

# terrify

v. to frighten someone very much

synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify

(1) terrify people, (2) the threats terrify him

It would be best not to **terrify** your associates into doing complex tasks.

# whisper

v. to speak very quietly to somebody using the breath rather than the voice so that only those close to you can hear you

synonym: murmur, rumor, mutter

(1) answer in a **whisper**, (2) the **whisper** of the leaves He took me aside and **whispered** in my ear.

#### recreate

v. to make something that existed previously happen or appear to exist again

synonym: renovate, vivify, revive

(1) **recreate** a single country, (2) **recreate** the feeling of the 1920s

She **recreated** the atmosphere of the pre-war age with her stage setting.

#### evoke

 to bring or recall a feeling, memory, or image into your mind

synonym: arouse, raise, inspire

evoke a sense of awe, (2) evoke sympathy
 This movie is likely to evoke strong emotions in the viewer.

### tapestry

 a piece of fabric or cloth that is woven with intricate designs or scenes, often depicting historical or mythological events; a complex or intricate story, idea, or situation

synonym: embroidery, hanging, cloth

(1) colorful **tapestry**, (2) intricate **tapestry** design
The **tapestry** on the wall depicted a medieval battle scene.

# storytelling

- n. the act or art of narrating or writing storiessynonym: narrating, relating, recounting
- (1) **storytelling** performance, (2) courtroom **storytelling** She was skilled in **storytelling** techniques, such as using different voices for other characters.

#### curator

 a person whose job is to manage the objects or artworks in a museum, art gallery, etc.

synonym: conservator, custodian, administrator

(1) curator of a library, (2) interim curator

The museum curator conserved the ancient manuscripts.

# outpouring

 a sudden and abundant flow or expression of thoughts, feelings, emotion, or information; an overwhelming amount of something expressed in a short period of time *synonym*: outflow, surge, torrent

(1) artistic **outpouring**, (2) emotional **outpouring**The **outpouring** of support from the community was overwhelming after the tragic event.

#### believable

adj. able to be accepted or easily believed; convincing or plausible

*synonym*: plausible, credible, convincing

(1) believable story, (2) believable excuse

The novel's plot was so well-written that it seemed **believable** and realistic.

#### excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate
- (1) **excite** the crowd, (2) **excite** rebellion The news of her promotion **excited** her.

# empathy

 the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation

*synonym*: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

full of empathy, (2) empathy for patients
 Empathy is also necessary to understand history.

### watchman

 a person who guards or keeps watch over a particular place, property, or group of people, often during the night; a person who is on the lookout for potential dangers or threats

synonym: guard, sentinel, keeper

(1) watchman duty, (2) night watchman

The **watchman's** whistle blew, signaling the start of the night shift.

tenet

 one of the fundamental ideas or beliefs upon which a theory or broader group of views is founded

synonym: dogma, creed, principle

(1) basic **tenets**, (2) a fundamental **tenet** of Judaism

This section explains a central **tenet** of economics.

### deduct

v. to take away an amount or part of the money, points, etc. from a total

synonym: remove, subtract, withdraw

(1) **deduct** the interest, (2) **deduct** \$100 from the price The bank **deducted** the premium amount from his bank account.
