loudspeaker

 an electronic device that amplifies sound, typically used to address a large audience or to play music or other audio content in public areas

synonym: speaker, loudhailer, megaphone

amplify

scrape

utensil

a tool used in the house

synonym: appliance, equipment, instrument

etiquette

- a set of rules and norms governing polite and proper n. behavior in social situations or professional contexts
- synonym: protocol, manners, decorum
- (1) email etiquette, (2) breach of etiquette It's important to follow proper etiquette when attending a formal dinner.

vigilant

- adj. keeping careful watch for possible danger or difficulties synonym: watchful, attentive, alert
- (1) **vigilant** watch, (2) **vigilant** about hand-washing The guards had to remain vigilant to ensure the safety of the high-security facility.

smudge

a blurry or dirty mark or stain left by rubbing or smearing something; also, a bundle of material, such as sage or incense, that is burned to produce smoke for purification or ritual purposes

synonym: blemish, mark, stain

(1) ink smudge, (2) lipstick smudge

She accidentally left a **smudge** on the newly painted wall.

smear

v. to spread or apply a substance thinly and unevenly over a surface; to slander or accuse someone falsely; (noun) a mark or blot made by smudging, typically a dirty or greasy one

synonym: smudge, spread, daub

(1) **smear** butter on bread, (2) **smear** of blood

The politician tried to **smear** his opponent's reputation with false accusations.

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark

The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

auditory

adj. of or relating to hearing or the ability to hear

synonym: hearing, audible, aural

(1) a good **auditory** memory, (2) **auditory** system

The **auditory** nerve carries sound signals from the ear to the brain.

tact

 skill and sensitivity in dealing with others, particularly in difficult or delicate situations

synonym: diplomacy, politeness, discretion

(1) public speaking **tact**, (2) show great emotional **tact** His diplomatic **tact** helped him to navigate the difficult negotiations.

reclaim

v. to take back something previously lost, given, or paid, or ask to have it back

synonym: recoup, regain, retake

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(1) **reclaim** a competitive position, (2) **reclaim** land from the sea

You may be entitled to **reclaim** some tax.

disempower

- v. to deprive of power, authority, or influence, to make someone or something less powerful or effective
 synonym: disenfranchise, weaken, undermine

The politician's efforts to **disempower** marginalized communities were met with widespread criticism.

empower

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

institutionalize

- to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)
- synonym: formalize, establish, regularize
- (1) **institutionalize** a system, (2) **institutionalize** customary laws

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

oblivion

n. the state of being completely forgotten or unknown; the state of being unconscious or unaware; the condition of being destroyed, wiped out, or erased from existence

synonym: limbo, forgetfulness, unawareness

delve

The actress could **inflect** her voice in a way that captivated the audience.

envision

claw
