- synonym: mental health, psychology, psychoanalysis
- (1) **psychiatry** therapy, (2) biological **psychiatry**The field of **psychiatry** is constantly evolving, with new treatments and approaches being developed all the time.

neurosis

- a psychological disorder characterized by excessive anxiety, distress, and irrational thoughts or behaviors, typically less severe than psychosis but can still impact an individual's daily functioning
- synonym: anxiety disorder, mental imbalance, psychological distress
- (1) hysterical **neurosis**, (2) childhood **neurosis**Her perfectionism and obsessive-compulsive tendencies were indicative of an underlying **neurosis**.

penetrate

synonym: pierce, stab, go through

deformity

fluffy

adj. soft and light, often with a texture that resembles feathers or fur

synonym: soft, feathery, puffy

The kitten had **fluffy** fur that was soft to the touch.

trance
